- **ADMISSION CAMPAIGNING AND AWARENESS ON CHEMISTRY COMBINATION COURSES**

The department of chemistry faculty are actively involving in admission campaigning every year and giving awareness on chemistry combination courses and careers with chemistry to increase student enrollment.

- **BRIDGE COURSE**

A bridge course in chemistry for newly admitted students is conducted every year before the commencement of first semester classes. The main objective of the course is to fill the subject gap between intermediate level and ug level and preparing the students to easily understand UG syllabus. Many of the students joining in BZC & DZC are coming from vocational courses are not having sufficient subject knowledge to follow up UG syllabus. So we are offering bridge course 1st sem students before starting regular course for 10 days.

- **REMADIAL COACHING**

Remedial classes are carried out after regular classes support the academically slower learners to catch up difficult topics. The sole purpose of these classes is to strengthen the concepts of the students who may not be able to grasp them during the regular teaching course. We have conducted remedial classes to the students who performed poor in the internal examination semester exams for 10 days on difficult and important topics in the examination point of view.

- **Certificate course**

We are conducting certificate courses to improve subject related technical skills, to improve employability skills of students and to handle environmental related problems. During the year 2020-21 we have conducted blended mode certificate course on water quality assessment for 30hrs.
