

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

### Between

DEPARTMENT OF TELUGU  
TARA GOVERNMENT COLLEGE(AUTONOMOUS)  
SANGAREDDY

And

DEPARTMENT OF TELUGU  
GOVERNMENT DEGREE COLLEGE  
PATANCHERU  
(AFFILIATED TO OSMANIA UNIVERSITY, HYDERABAD)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of 01-06-2020 (Effective Date) to establish an affiliation by and between

The Department of Telugu, Government Degree College, Patancheru(Affiliated to Osmania University , Hyderabad) First Part

And

The Department of Telugu, Tara Government College (Autonomous) Sangareddy the Second Part, for the purpose of exchange of faculty, staff and students.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes.

### Preamble

Whereas, The Department of Telugu, Government Degree College, Patancheru(Affiliated to Osmania University, Hyderabad) and The Department of Telugu, Tara Government College (Autonomous) Sangareddy have many areas of common interest in Telugu curriculum teaching to UG Students considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education .

Now therefore, the Department of Telugu, Government Degree College, Patancheru(Affiliated to Osmania University, Hyderabad) and The Department of Telugu, Tara Government College (Autonomous) Sangareddy have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which

defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions set out in various areas

Both Institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

#### Faculty/ Staff Exchanges

- The exchange of faculty to the mutual benefit of Both institutions.
- Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and Consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.
- The exchange of academic materials and publications.
- Conducting lectures.
- Attachment of staff for purposes of curriculum development and review, attendance of courses, upgrading of teaching and research skills.
- Participating in seminars, symposiums, and other types of academic discussions.
- Co-supervising post-graduate students.
- Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment or such exchange with free of cost.

#### Student Exchange

The Department of Telugu, Government Degree College, Patancheru (Affiliated to Osmania University) and The Department of Telugu, Tara Government College (Autonomous) Sangareddy mutually agreed that student exchange will be guided by principles listed below A home institution refers to the institution where a student is a full-time student, and from where he/she is expected to graduate. A host institution refers to an institution that receives a student for a brief period of time to undertake a pre-determined programme of study or research.

- a) Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.
- b) An exchange student will continue to be treated as full-time student at his/her home institution.
- c) An exchange student will be considered as full-time "exchange" student at the host institution.

d) His/her programme of study at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor identified by the host institution.

e) The host institution will evaluate an exchange student's performance in each course or module, award a letter grade or marks, and issue a letter to that effect.

f) The home institution may award to the exchange student credits earned at a host institution, but only after the home institution has established correspondence between courses taken at the host institution vis-a-vis those offered at the home institution.

g) If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research, and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research carried out.

h) If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the home institution will take note of the performance evaluation and the technical report, and take steps in accordance with its own procedures.

i) The Department of Telugu, Government Degree College, Patancheru (Affiliated to Osmania University) and The Department of Telugu, Tara Government College (Autonomous) Sangareddy agree to provide suitable accommodation for student exchange.

- to organize jointly seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
- to propose and engage jointly in research or training programs sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein,
- to exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students at Undergraduate, Graduate and Doctoral levels for limited periods of time for purpose of education and /or research,
- the provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff and students of both institutes,
- to use laboratory facilities in specific cases for a limited period,
- To permit students, staff and faculty members to use library facility.

The Department of Telugu , Government Degree College, Patancheru (Affiliated to Osmania University) and The Department of Telugu, Tara Government College (Autonomous) Sangareddy agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

## COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of The Department of Telugu, Government Degree College, Patancheru (Affiliated to Osmania University) and a programme coordinator from the side of The Department of Telugu, Tara Government College (Autonomous) Sangareddy, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

## VALIDITY

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of THREE years commencing from effective date. (i.e., 2020-21 to 2022-23 Academic years) Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

## TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of six months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither The Department of Telugu, Government Degree College, Patancheru (Affiliated to Osmania University) nor The Department of Telugu, Tara Government College (Autonomous) Sangareddy will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, The Department of Telugu, Government Degree College, Patancheru (Affiliated to Osmania University) and Tara Government College (Autonomous) Sangareddy will ensure that the provisions of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the institutes. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

## DISPUTE RESOLUTION


In case, there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation Both HoDs of Telugu, Government Degree College, Patancheru (Affiliated to Osmania University), and Tara Government College (Autonomous) Sangareddy resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.

The Department of Telugu, Government Degree College, Patancheru (Affiliated to Osmania University) and The Department of Telugu, Tara Government College (Autonomous) Sangareddy welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for cooperation and jointly agree to the provisions as set out above.
