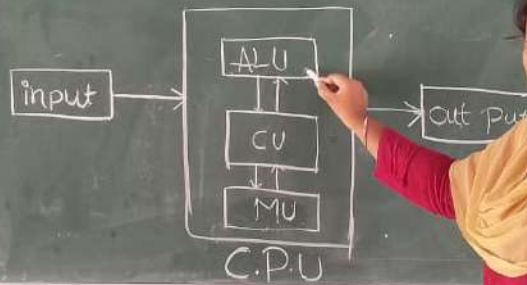

Boost for IT in Khammam

Giving a stimulus to the growth of Information Technology (IT) in the district, the State government on Tuesday accorded administrative approval for setting up a second IT Hub in Khammam.

It may be recalled that following a request made by Transport Minister Purnala Ajay Kumar, IT and Industries Minister K. T. Rama Rao had sanctioned the second phase of IT Hub on December 7 last. Though the IT Minister sanctioned Rs 30 crore for the second phase of IT Hub on Dec 7, the budget allocated for the facility was enhanced as the government has given administrative approval for Rs 45 crore to set up IT Tower-2 keeping in mind the long term perspective and to support the additional demand.

The IT Tower-2 would have a built-up space of 15,000 square feet with a 275 seat capacity, said IT&I Department Principal Secretary Jayesh Ranjan, in a letter to T&I Vice Chairman and MD.

The new facility would come up next to the existing IT Hub which has a seating capacity of 450 seats at Tel-

lanch circle in the Khammapuram Havali area. T&I has been asked to prepare a detailed project report and send the proposal to the government for budgetary sanction.

Meanwhile, the Municipal Administration and Urban Development also accorded administrative sanction for release of Rs 45 crore towards various development works under Khammam Municipal Corporation.

The government released GO No 207 sanctioning the funds. The funds were released under Chief Minister's Special Assistance wherein Rs 200 crore has

been sanctioned and several development works were underway in Khammam worth Rs 100 crore already released.

Speaking to Telangana Today, Minister Ajay Kumar thanked Chief Minister K Chandrababhan Rao and IT Minister K. T. Rama Rao for accorded administrative approval with increased budgetary allocations.

The move would help meet future demands and help Khammam push secure jobs locally, he said, adding that the release of Rs 45 crore would speed up the development works and help transform Khammam.
