Admission notification of ITEP BA B.Ed

About the College

The Govt. Degree College, Luxettipet located in the Mancherial district of Telangana, was established in 2008 to cater the educational needs of the socially and economically unprivileged students hailing from remote areas surrounding the region. In 2015, the college was identified under Model Degree College scheme by RUSA, New Delhi and Rs.12 Crores were sanctioned for the construction of Administrative Block, Men and Women hostel.

The Government Degree College, Luxettipet, fourth Model Degree College in the state and the first one in the northern part of Telangana was digitally inaugurated by Honourable Prime Minister of India, Sri. Narendra Modiji in Feb 2019. In the academic year 2019-20, the institution shifted to its own permanent New Model College Building attached with Men and Womens Hostel with all modern infrastructure and academic amenities.

The institute is committed to provide quality education to rural students in an ambient atmosphere and efforts are being made to mould this institution as a prestigious landmark in the entire region. The institution with its committed and hard working team of staff members blended with pleasant campus is aspiring to become an Institution with Potential for Excellence. The institution is NAAC accredited and ISO certified.

The institution is offering a number of Conventional, Professional and Vocational UG courses under CBCS and three PG courses. The institute is one among the 42 institutes selected by the NCTE, New Delhi for launching the prestigious Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) from 2023-24 academic year.

About the Course

The four years Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP), a dual-major holistic bachelor's degree offering course is one of the major mandates of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 related to Teacher Education. As per the NEP 2020, teacher recruitment from the year 2030 onwards will be only through ITEP. On pilot mode, the NCTE, Ministry of Education has initially launched this programme from 2023-24 in selected 42 multidisciplinary prestigious institutions across the country. This integrated course will benefit students since they will save one year by finishing it in four years rather than the customary five years required by the present B.Ed course.

Broad Structure of the Course: The ITEP is of four years duration across eight semesters of study. It is a dual-major bachelor's degree programme, with one major in Education and the other in a disciplinary/interdisciplinary branch of knowledge. In addition, the programme seeks to develop among student-teachers an ethic of social engagement, and capacities such as problem

solving, critical thinking, creative thinking, communication skills, ethical and moral reasoning etc. that are necessary for preparing competent teachers.

The prospective teachers passing out this course through a multi-disciplinary environment grounded in Indian values and traditions will be instilled with the needs of 21st century on global standards, and hence will be largely helpful in shaping the future of New India. The four-year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) envisions the creation of passionate, motivated, qualified, professionally trained, and well-equipped teachers capable of designing and implementing developmentally appropriate learning experiences for students at different stages of school education. The ITEP seeks to ensure that the prospective teachers are given the highest quality education in content, pedagogy, values, and practice.

Stage Specific Specialization: The reconfiguration of the curricular and pedagogical structure of school education involving a 5 + 3 + 3 + 4 design as recommended by NEP 2020 makes it imperative that the ITEP makes available accomplished teachers with the knowledge, capacities, and values and dispositions required for developing and improving the practice of teaching at a particular Stage of school education, i.e. Foundational Stage or Preparatory Stage or Middle Stage or Secondary Stage. The ITEP seeks to create a pool of competent teachers capable of designing developmentally appropriate teaching-learning-assessment practices that are responsive to the learning needs and interests of children at different stages of their development. Each student-teacher shall specialize in one of the following Stages of school education which will qualify them to become a teacher for that Stage. *Government Degree College, Luxettipet is offering the BA B.Ed course of Secondary Stage.*

ITEP with Secondary Stage Specialization: The Secondary Stage includes Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12. It comprises of “four years of multidisciplinary study, building on the subject oriented pedagogical and curricular style of the Middle Stage, but with greater depth, greater critical thinking, greater attention to life aspirations, and greater flexibility and student choice of subjects” (NEP 2020, 4.2). “Holistic development and a wide choice of subjects and courses year to year will be the new distinguishing feature of secondary school education” [Para 4.9, NEP 2020]. In Grades 9 and 10, students would engage with eight curricular areas to ensure breadth of study, building on the learning achieved in the Middle Stage. The curriculum includes study of three languages, Arts Education, Physical Education, Vocational Education, Social Sciences & Humanities, Interdisciplinary Areas, Mathematics and Computational Thinking, and Sciences. More subject choices are available to students in Grades 11 & 12. Choice-based courses which would enable depth of learning across a range of human knowledge are offered in Grades 11 & 12. To address the requirement of breadth of study, students are required to choose subjects from amongst at least two out of the three groups of curricular areas such as: i) the Group comprising Arts Education, Physical Education and Vocational Education; b) Group Comprising Social Sciences & Humanities, and Interdisciplinary Areas; and c) 7 CURRICULUM FRAMEWORK Mathematics and Sciences. The requirements to choose subjects from at least two groups help meet the requirement of breadth of study by students in Grades 11 & 12. The curricular

requirements in Grades 11 & 12 include: i) the study of two languages, one of them being a Language that is native to India; and ii) the study of at least four subjects chosen from two of the three groups of curricular areas mentioned above. The curriculum structure allows a student to take up an optional fifth subject. To ensure depth of study/learning, while choosing an academic Discipline, students will be required to take up four courses relating to that Discipline.

Multiple Entry and Exit, and Re-entry Options: The ITEP envisages multiple entry and exit points and re-entry options, with appropriate certifications. Student-teachers who wish to exit after completion of one year (two semesters) of study will be given a Certificate indicating the credits accrued for the courses pursued. Student-teachers who wish to exit after completion of two years (four semesters) will be given a Diploma indicating the credits accrued for the courses completed. Student-teachers who wish to exit after successful completion of three years (six semesters) will be awarded a Bachelor's Degree in the chosen Major area of study upon securing a minimum of 120 credits and satisfying the minimum credit requirements of 48 credits for the Major. Student-teachers who successfully complete four years (eight semesters) of study will be awarded a dual-major bachelor's degree B.A B.Ed upon securing a minimum of 160 credits, including a minimum of 80 credits for the first major (i.e. in education), and a minimum of 48 credits for the second major (i.e., in a disciplinary/interdisciplinary area relating to one of the curricular areas in school education).

Nomenclature of Degree Awarded: As the ITEP being a Dual-Major programme with School Stage specialization, it will lead to the award of one of the following Degrees, depending on the chosen discipline of study and Stage Specific specialization as **BA B.Ed (Secondary Stage with major in**)

Vertical Mobility Opportunities: Student-teachers who successfully complete the four-year ITEP and want to pursue higher studies will be eligible to pursue master's degree programme in education as well as in the Major discipline chosen for study during the ITEP

General instructions of admissions

- Students should have, in general, obtained their educational qualification from a recognized board under 10+2 system, i.e., the candidate should have studied for 12 years to obtain his/ her/ educational qualification to apply for admission to the U.G. programme.
- Candidate must be qualified NCET CBT conducted by NTA. Notification for National Common Entrance Test 2024 is already issued and the last date for application is 30-04-2024. For more details check out information bulletin in NOTIFICATION tab of our institute website.
- Candidates awaiting their results are also eligible to apply. Such candidates, however, must produce the mark sheet / certificate as the proof of fulfilling the prescribed

eligibility criteria on or before the date notified by the University failing which provisional admission, if granted, will be cancelled.

- Eligibility marks will not be rounded off. For example 49.99% will not be rounded off to 50% for the purpose of admission.
- Students are instructed not to miss classes, since 70% of attendance is required to appear for the examination.
- All admissions are provisional, subject to verification of required documents, as per prescribed norms. If any certificate is found incorrect the admission will be cancelled.
- Students are instructed to pay the registration fee of Rs. 300/- before filling up registration form. Bank details for payment of registration fee and registration form link are given below.

Criteria for resolving tie in the entrance exam marks:

(a) First criterion: 12th standard or equivalent marks

(b) Second criterion: Age of the candidates (in days).

(c) Third criterion: In cases of ties that remain unresolved after applying the above two criteria, the criteria evolved by the University as deemed fit would be applied for resolution of the tie.

Reservation Policy

Seats will be reserved as per the Telangana state government reservation policy.
