ABOUT THE SEMINAR

This conference is intended to encourage interdisciplinary research among the students and teachers. It aims to mark a significant turning point in our understanding about the bases and dimensions of gender inequity at various levels and in different areas. It sets the benchmark for women's empowerment towards increasing visibility of women in decision making.

When considering women's participation in public life, empowerment must also consider women's access and mobilization within formal and informal spaces. Empowerment is a process of internal change, or power within, enhancement of capabilities. The conference reflects a very wide area of women intellectual involvement, which figure outs the dynamics of women participation in policy making, decision making and other political processes.

This conference aims to highlight and synthesize information on the issues of discrimination against women in different spheres of public life. It examines constraints on women's equality and empowerment in relation to their status as full and equal citizens in the process of policy formulation and implementation.

ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

Pingle Govt. College for Women owes its existence to the generosity of the Pingle family backed by their donation of the land and building. The donors include late Sri Pingle Venkatrama Reddy, the Dy. Prime Minister of the State of Nizam y and his two brothers late Sri Pingle Krishna Reddy and late Sri Pingle Ranga Reddy. The building was handed over on 16-08-1965 to the Government for establishing an institution of higher learning to be named after Pingle family. All of us owe deep gratitude to the donor family.

The Collegewhich started with 67 students and 11 members of faculty & staff, witnessed continuous and allround development over the years. In 1966-67 the college saw the introduction of the degree courses in B.A. (H.P.P), B.A. (E.P.P.) and B.Sc. (B.Z.C) in both English and Telugu media with affiliation to Osmania University, Hyderabad. In 1978 the college was reaffiliated to Kakatiya University. In 1991 the Institution evolved into a multi-faculty institution. This College is the oldest Government Women's College in the State of Telangana. It presently has a strength of 1467 UG and 539 PG students. In the year 2021 college was sanctioned autonomous status by the UGC.

The historic city of Warangal is a composite of three separate cities of Kazipet, Hanamkonda and Warangal which over a period of time has become one continuous city of Greater Municipal Corporation of Warangal.
