CIRCULAR

Sub: Collegiate Education- State Functions- Organizing “Swathantra Bharatha Vajrotsavalu” in the State of Telangana in the context of the 75years of India’s Independence - 8th to 22nd August, 2022-Celebrations and conducting scheduled Activities and Competitions in Government Degree Colleges in Telangana State- Instructions- Issued.

In the context of the 75 years of India’s Independence, the Government of Telangana has decided to celebrate “Swathantra Bharatha Vajrotsavalu” in the State of Telangana in a grand manner. As part of “Swathantra Bharatha Vajrotsavalu” of 2022, the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana has directed all the Principals of Government, Private Aided and Unaided Degree Colleges in the State to conduct the following activities.

A. Arrangements to be made by every College:

- (1) Decoration of Colleges:** On 10th of August all the Government Degree Colleges shall be decorated with colour papers, Mango leaves, Rangoli etc. to mark the beginning of Swatantra Bharatha Vajrotsava Celebrations at college. The premises shall be adorned with Rangoli every day. This festive decoration and atmosphere shall continue till the 22nd August, 2022.
- (2) Arrangements:** Public Address System shall be arranged in all colleges for conduct of activities, related to this program

B. Every day Activities in all GDCs:

- 1. Playing One Patriotic Song in the every Morning:** In addition to the Vandemataram prayer song, one patriotic song from the list of songs annexed may be played every morning using public address system (Mic set). The list of 13 Patriotic songs is herewith enclosed at **Annexure -III.**
- 2. Viewing of ‘Gandhi’ Movie:** The Principals shall arrange screening of movies like ‘Gandhi’ or any other patriotic movies in the College

Seminar/Conference hall and/or shall arrange free shows in coordination with the respective District Collectors in a convenient schedule to all the students with their own transportation facilities.

Day wise Activities:

(1) 10.August, 2022:

- i. **Vajrotsava Vanamahotsavam:** At least 75 plants shall be planted in every college by the students and staff.
- ii. Singing Competition of patriotic songs.

(2) 11th August 2022: Essay Writing Competition shall be held in all schools on topics mentioned in **Annexure-II**

(3) 12th August 2022: Freedom Cup Sports and Games competitions shall be conducted at College level.

(4) 15^h August, 2022:

- i. Prabhata Bheri: All students and staff shall participate in a procession to be taken up in the area in which the college is located with slogans related to Independence Day, playing drums and holding placards. The Prabhata Bheri shall be completed early in the morning.
- ii. Flag Hoisting: The National Flag shall be hoisted in the presence of all students, parents, villagers and other officials.
- iii. Conduct of program/meeting on Swathantra Bharatha Vajrotsavam, including cultural activities.

(5) 16th August 2022:

- i. **Saamuhika Jaateeya Geetalapana:** On 16th August, throughout the State of Telangana, there shall be synchronized singing of the National Anthem (*Jana gana mana*) at a scheduled time which will be communicated.
- ii. Elocution competition shall be held in the topics enlisted in **Annexure-II.**

- (6) **17th August 2022:** Painting competitions as per topics enlisted in **Annexure-II** shall be held.
- (7) **18th August 2022:** Mono action competition reflecting the Spirit of the Nation
- (8) **19th August 2022:**
- i. Rangoli Competitions reflecting the Spirit of the Nation.
 - ii. Freedom Cup Sports and Games competitions at District Level.
 - iii. Poetry Writing Competitions for college lecturers at District level, as per topics enlisted in **Annexure-II**.
- (9) **22nd August 2022:** Awarding of Prizes: At school level, Closing Ceremony shall be held with Cultural activities and prize distribution with pomp and gaiety. The students who secure 1st and 2nd position in all the competitions mentioned below, shall be awarded prizes and certificates on 22nd of August in the respective colleges. All events/ prizes/mementos shall be named with a pre-fix of the word, "Freedom", e.g., Freedom Cup.

C. Precautions to be taken during the Celebrations:

- The Principals shall ensure that proper care is taken for smooth conduct of the celebrations at college level in a systematic manner.
- Due care shall be taken that students are not made to wait/stand for long time during any activity.
- The Principals shall see that the sports & games are conducted as per schedule by ensuring required safety & precautionary measures.
- Sensitivity towards the young students and their comfort shall be ensured by all the staff members at all times.
