

## Faculty Forum on "Inclusive Growth"




Chairman of the programme Dr. N. Srinivas delivered opening remarks and asserted that everyone should know about "Inclusive growth" in the subject Economics


## Faculty Forum on "Significance of Fundamental Rights"



Chairman of the programme Dr. T. Srinivas delivered opening remarks and asserted that everyone should know that "Significance of Fundamental Rights".




Later Dr. N. Ramadevi, Asst. Prof. of Political Science delivered keynote on "Significance of Fundamental Rights". The main points of this topic are




- \* Fundamental Rights have a special significance in our daily life
