

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Heartfulness Education Trust, Hyderabad, Telangana

And

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana State, Hyderabad, Telangana

Whereas, Heartfulness Education Trust at Hyderabad of Telangana State in India (hereinafter referred to as HET) is a non-profit organization fully engaged in conducting trainings, workshops, orientations to Education fraternity that includes Students, Teachers and other stake holders to effect change from within through Meditation.

Whereas, Commissioneerate of College Education, Hyderabad, Telangana (hereinafter referred to as CCETS). The Department is created to promote Collegiate Education, giving special attention to the areas located in Backward and Rural areas, to strengthen Women education at undergraduate and post-graduate levels to create educational opportunities for weaker sections of the society and to introduce need-based vocational courses replacing the conventional courses in a phased manner.

Now therefore HET and CCETS enter into a Memorandum of Understanding to establish a program of exchange and collaboration in the areas that benefit both the institutions.

I.

The purpose of the cooperation between HET and CCETS is as follows:

- To promote Faculty training programmes such as faculty development, teacher training, etc

II.

To achieve this goal, HET proposes to conduct training programmes on various aspects of Wellness, Happy Living, and Human Excellence.

HET: Is primarily responsible for designing and implementing the training sessions as and when it is required. HET will also take the responsibility of coordination, arranging meetings, discussions and any further collaborations regarding training activities.

CCETS: Will take the responsibility of preparing training schedules and communicating the same to the internal stakeholders.

III.

Each party designates the following persons to serve as its primary contact and liaison to arrange the initial resources needed to facilitate the partnership, review, evaluate, report program activities, and address any concerns or disputes that may arise relating to the terms and conditions of the Agreement.

For HET: Dr. Shaik Kamruddin, Regional Coordinator, HET, Hyderabad

For CCETS: Training coordinator, CCETS

IV.

This Memorandum of Understanding will be identified as the parent document of any program agreement executed between the parties. No modification, alteration or amendment of this Agreement will be effective unless in writing and signed by the Parties.

Further agreements concerning any program will provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and will not become effective until they have been put down in writing and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties. The scope of the activities under this agreement will be determined by the funds regularly available at both the institutions. The financial assistance may be obtained from the institution's internal funds or from the external funding sources, but the training expenses might be borne by the CCETS. However, this will be negotiated and might be agreed based on the nature of the training

V.

This Memorandum of Understanding is not a contract. This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as a statement of the general intention of the Parties and is not intended to be legally binding nor to be construed as an agreement on any matters mentioned. No oral agreement or conduct of the Parties (including partial performance) in respect of matters stated in this Memorandum shall be deemed to impose any obligation or liability on either Party.

This Memorandum of Understanding is not intended to constitute, create, give effect to, or otherwise form a joint venture, or other business entity of any kind. Neither Party shall act as an agent for, or partner of, the other Party. There are neither any rights nor obligations of the Parties established under this Memorandum of Understanding.

VI.

Although the intention of this Memorandum of Understanding is to discuss and negotiate issues with respect to a possible definitive agreement between the Parties, the relationship is non-exclusive, and the Parties shall have the ability to form similar or different relationships with other institutions or entities of their choice.

The parties agree to comply with all applicable federal, state, and municipal laws; ordinances, rules, and regulations; all applicable requirements of any accreditation authority, and to certify such compliance upon request.

The Parties agree to comply with all national, state, and local rules, regulations, executive orders, laws, and policies forbidding unlawful discrimination to which Institution is subject.

VIII

The Parties intend to discuss with each other in connection with this Memorandum of Understanding prior to publication of any press release.


IX

Upon approval by each institution, this Memorandum of Understanding will remain in effect for a period of three (3) years unless terminated earlier by either institution. Such termination by one institution shall be effected by giving the other institution at least three (3) months advance written notice of its intention to terminate. If such notice is given, this Agreement shall terminate: (a) at the end of such six (3) months; or (b) when all trainings enrolled in the Program at the time such notice is given have completed, whichever event occurs last. Termination will be without penalty.

Notwithstanding the above, the period of this cooperation will, if necessary, be extended with consent in writing from the Parties.

EXECUTED by HET and CCETS in duplicate copies, each of which will be deemed an original.


