In continuation with Jignasa-State Level Presentation and Selection of Student Study Projects programme, a Prize distribution ceremony for the winners of Jignasa 2021-22 is planned on **23<sup>rd</sup>, May, 2022** at the **Potti Sreeramulu Telugu University, Hyderabad** from 9:00 AM to 1:30 PM

The following instructions have to be followed by the Prize Winning Colleges for the prize distribution ceremony:

- 1. The Principals are informed to make arrangements for the Winners of Jignasa - Student Study Projects to attend the Prize Distribution Function along with their Supervisor/Mentor at 9:00 AM on 23<sup>rd</sup>, May, 2022.**
- 2. The Projects selected for First Prize shall be awarded with Rs.25,000/-**

cash prize for the group and Rs.5,000/- for the Mentor/Supervisor. The Projects selected for Second Prize shall be awarded with Rs.18,000/- cash prize for the group and Rs.3,000/- for the Mentor/Supervisor.
