The members of Board of Studies met to the Dept. of Biotechnology and discussed and resolved the following:-

The syllabus of I, II, & III yr. has been framed into Semesters. The pattern of study has been discussed and finalized as follows.

1. It is discussed and resolved to reapprove the syllabus for B.Sc. Iyr & B.Sc. Iyr^(III yr) with little modifications i.e. syllabus is divided into four units instead of three units which is approved earlier without changes in the content.

2. It is resolved to approve the syllabus for B.Sc. III Yrs i.e. Semester V & VI according to the choice based credit system (CBCS) to V (Core, Elective I & II) and VI (Core, Elective, Elective - Skill based) both for theory and practicals.

3. It is resolved to approve the model question paper for Core V and VI consisting of

Section A: Essay type questions for 40 marks

B: Short answer type questions for 25m.

C: Very Short answer type questions for 10m.

Total marks have been raised to 75 for internal exams and 25 marks for internal exams (100 marks)

4. The Committee approved the division of syllabus into four 'Units' in each core semester.

5. It is also approved the model question papers of all Semesters.

6. The Committee approved the implementation of the proposed pattern of syllabus and modified B.Sc III yr. model paper from this academic year 2016-2017.

7. It is resolved to implement the Scheme as per the UGC for 2016-17 for B.Sc. Pys.
