IQAC conveys a meeting at the end of every academic year with all the in-charges of the Departments under the Chairmanship of the Principal to bring the feedback analysis collected from all the stakeholders in to their notice with a request to find out the possibility for effecting changes in the courses offered by their respective departments and also to improve the academic environment and other aspects concerned to their departments. The in-charges of the departments in turn have conducted a meeting in their departments and explored the possibility of changes in the syllabi and introduction of certificate courses and skill development courses having focus on employability in accordance with the demands of the stakeholders. Subsequently, few departments have come up with a plan to introduce Certificate Courses having focus on employability and skill development. A separate meeting held by IQAC with the Principal and the members of the specific Departments which introduced Trans-Disciplinary Courses with more employability/skill development have been approved.
