- Sexual Harassment complaints and procedures at St. Ann's college, Medhipatnam, Hyderabad on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2004
- 2. Sexual Harassment at the workplace, at Hyderabad Central University on 28<sup>th</sup> February 2005
- 3. Photo exhibition of *Womanscape* on 28<sup>th</sup> November at RBVRR women's college, Hyderabad.
- 4. Legal perspectives on Early Marriage at St. Ann's college on 8<sup>th</sup> November 2005
- 5. Dowry and Class distinction at St Francis College, Begumpet on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2007.

In the colleges there are many young girls on the threshold of adulthood, who may face various forms of violence. Our effort through the sessions, in the colleges, is to strengthen their understanding of rights and discrimination so that they are better able to deal with their lives.

We would like to focus on issues relating to gender, legislation against child marriages, eve teasing of young girls, sexual harassment, violence against women and various legislations concerning women's rights.
