Human Values and Professional Ethics (HVPE): To enable the students to imbibe and internalize the Values and Ethical Behaviour in their personal and professional lives, a course on HV&PE is offered.

The students will understand the importance of Values and Ethics in their personal lives and professional careers in case study method & relate to their personal experience.

Gender Sensitization: There is a great need to sensitize students on gender issues so that there would be no discrimination on the basis of gender. Hence a two credit course “Towards the world of Equals” is offered to first year students

Business Ethics: A course on Business ethics is Introduced for the students of B.B.A from the academic year 2019-20 and students learn business ethics or professional ethics that examine ethical principles and moral or ethical problems that arise in a business environment.
