

Section-B: Four questions. Long Answer type. One compulsory from each Unit. $4 \times 10 = 40$ M.



Minutes of Meeting


The following resolutions are taken in the meeting

The College has implemented the CBCS System from the year 2014-15, for all three years following the CBCS system

1. The practical examinations would be conducted at the end of each semester.
2. A project work Unit will be in the sixth semester with TWO credits for evaluation.
3. For the final year students it is mandatory to do project work in any subject , it carries 50 marks and two credits are allotted for this project work.
4. The practical's of I,III,V odd semesters, evaluation is done by internal examiners and the practicals of II,IV, VI, even semesters evaluation is done by external examiners.
5. The details of syllabus, credits allotted and examination pattern are enclosed.
7. In B.Sc III Year syllabus (DSE-Elective-I) paper VI-A –Instrumental Methods of Analysis & (DSE-Elective-II) paper VIII-A –Medicinal Chemistry are introduced.
8. Pattern of evaluation and examination was discussed and resolved with two internals in each semester and average of the two internals would be taken for the semester marks computation.
9. For III year students the internals would be of 25 marks and the end semester exam would be for 75 marks. 50 marks are allotted for the practical examination and internal question paper will be of 15 marks, two 5 marks questions with internal choice, 8 two marks questions, out of which 5 have to be answered. 5 marks for assignment, 5 marks for seminar.
10. The academic council of our college has resolved to change the evaluation pattern of the examinations with effect from academic year 2019-20.
The scheme of the examination has been changed from 25 marks internal and 75 marks external to 40 marks for internal and 60 marks for external examinations.
Division of 40 marks is as follows:
 - i. 20 marks internal assessment in the form of descriptive exam, where two internals will be conducted and average of two is considered.
 - ii. Unit wise test in the form of 40 objective questions, each unit for 10 questions and average of 4 unit marks. Half mark for each question and a total value of 10 marks.
 - iii. 5 marks for seminar/ quiz/ group discussion and 5 marks for assignments.
11. I and II Sem of I year practical syllabus has been added. (Inorganic preparations)
12. III and IV semester of II year syllabus has been added in theory.

Internal Assessment for III year

- Total internal marks 25 for III year. 15 marks for written internal exam of each time (internal exam conducts 2 times). Average of the two internals is considered for Computation of marks. 5 marks for assignment and 5 marks for seminar.
- Internals shall be held at the end of every 9th week and 14th week of each semester
- The duration for the internal shall be 60 minutes.
- Internal exam consists of 15 marks, (5 marks 2 long questions given, in which one question need to answer and 8 short questions given, in which 5 questions need to answer. Each carries 2 marks)

Semester Examination for III Year - Semester exams will be conducted in October and April of every year

75 marks are allotted for each paper per semester.

- Section -A: 8 three marks questions out of which 5 have to be answered ($5 \times 3 = 15$ marks)
- Section-B: 4 fifteen marks questions with internal choice have to be answered ($4 \times 15 = 60$ marks)


Internal Assessment for I & II year


- Total internal marks 40 for I & II year. 20 marks for written internal exam of each time (internal exam conducts 2 times). Average of the two internals is considered for Computation of marks.
- Unit wise test in the form of 40 objective questions, each unit for 10 questions and average of 4 unit marks. Half mark for each question and a total value of 10 marks. 5 marks for assignment and 5 marks for seminar.
- Internals shall be held at the end of every 9th week and 14th week of each semester
- The duration for the internal shall be 60 minutes.
- Internal exam consists of 20 marks, (10 marks 2 long questions given, in which one question need to answer and 4 short questions given, in which 2 questions need to answer. Each question carries 5 marks)

1. It is resolved to continue Sanskrit, second language as 4 Credit course for I & II Semesters and 3 Credit course for II & IV Semesters following UGC guidelines for allocation of Credits as per the teaching hours per week.
2. It is resolved to introduce the syllabus of Sanskrit i.e. the text "**Saraswati sushama-1**" prescribed by Osmania University for B.A., B.Sc, B.com. - I year, adopting CBCS system of Grading as per the rules of CCE, being implemented from the year 2014. It is adopted for I, II, III & IV semesters. It is resolved to add 20% of syllabus apart from the prescribed text book. Hence Baladharsha has been included for all 4 semesters.
3. It is resolved to continue same syllabus for Semester - I with 4 lessons and grammar (**Mudabhishektum varada tvamarhasi + Himalayo nama nagadhirajah + Kritaghne nasti nishkritih + Dharmabaddho douvarikah + Shabdarupani + Sandhis + Baladharsha lessons from 6th to 9th**).

It is resolved to continue same Syllabus for Semester II with 4 lessons and grammar (**Saktuprasthanya mahatvam + Buddhasya vairagyodayah + Na**

gangadatto punareti kupam + Vaijnanika (Brihat) Samhita + Dhaturupani + Samasas+ Baladharsha lessons from 10th to 14th).

4. It is resolved to continue the syllabus of Sanskrit i.e. the text "Saraswati sushama -2" prescribed by Osmania University for B.A., B.Sc, B.com.II year and the syllabus for Semester - III - 5 lessons and grammar (1.Abhijnanashakuntalam – Pravartatam prakriti hitaya parthivah 2. Navaratnani 3.Shudrakavaishampayanayoh sambhashanam, 4.Ramadasah 4. Mahakavi (Bharavi, Magha, Sriharsha) 5.Halantashabdarupani+

5. It is resolved to continue Syllabus for Semester IV with 5 lessons and grammar (1.Uttararamacharitam – Chitrapathadarshanam, 2.Vivekanandavijayem Ashtamonkah, 3.Dhruvopakhyanam, and 4. Vishruta charitam 5.Mahakavi 6.Kridantarupani)

6. The pattern of evaluation and examination was discussed and resolved to conduct two internals in each semester and to take the average of the two for computation in marks memo. It is resolved to set the question paper of the main exam for 60marks and the internal Exam for 40marks for I, II, III and IV semesters.

7. The pattern of evaluation and examination was discussed and it is resolved to conduct two internals for 20 marks in descriptive method and online exam with Mcq's for 10 marks. It is resolved to give assignment for 5 marks and for another 5 marks for Slip tests/ quiz/ seminar/book review.
