# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is entered into this on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2018 by and between

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana State, Vidya Bhavan, Nampally, (hereinafter referred to as "CCETS" which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executors, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) as FIRST PARTY.

#### AND

Naandi Foundation, a Public Charitable Trust incorporated under the Indian Trusts Act, having its registered office at 502, Trendset Towers, Road No 2, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad - 500 034, Telangana, India represented by Shri. Raj lyer, Chief Youth Employment Officer, through its authorized signatory (hereinafter referred to as "Naandi" which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executors, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) as SECOND PARTY.

(Both Parties are hereinafter jointly referred to as "Parties" and individually as a "Party")

### Introduction

WHEREAS CCETS is a non-profit organization created by Government of Telangana to promote education, giving special attention to the areas located in backward and rural areas. It aims to strengthen education at undergraduate and post graduate level especially for women and underprivileged sections of the society.

WHEREAS Naandi Foundation is an apolitical, autonomous Public Charitable Trust and a not for profit organisation having registration under section 12AA of income tax act, 1961 is tax exempt and is recognised by tax authorities as an organisation established for 'charitable purpose'

WHEREAS Naandi is working with an objective of people centred development through its charitable activities in whole of India, without distinction of caste, creed or religion, etc

WHEREAS Naandi engaged, inter alia, in improving the livelihoods of the underprivileged communities through its various social initiatives, developmental programs, in various states of India. Naandi's activities include, education to underprivileged children with a specific focus on girl child education, improving livelihoods of small and marginal farmers through its farming practices, employable training and skill development programs to underprivileged youth, provision of safe drinking water to communities, etc

WHEREAS Naandi, in furtherance of its objectives and as a part of its skill development program to underprivileged youth, wish to build and enhance the employability skill set of the underprivileged youth/students in colleges under the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education in the State of Telangana.

WHEREAS the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, in the State of Telangana, is desirous of engaging in employability skill building program of the underprivileged youth/students in Government Degree Colleges at undergraduate and post-graduate levels, in the State of Telangana.

WHEREAS both the parties having recognised each other's intention of supporting the underprivileged youth / students, studying in Government Degree colleges in the State of Telangana have decided to work together in the space of employability skill development initiative.

WHEREAS both the parties have decided to reduce the mutually agreed terms and conditions into writing

## NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS UNDER:

## I: The employability skill development program (MPC)

- 1.1 The program shall be carried out in Government Degree and PG Colleges, in the State of Telangana. A list of such colleges/institutes is given in Annexure I enclosed herewith which is a part of this MOU.
- 1.2 The beneficiaries/students shall be the underprivileged students studying in the final semester under this program in Government Degree and PG Colleges, in the State of Ielangana.
- 1.3 The skilling program shall be for a duration of 40 hours or as the case may be decided mutually by the parties.
- 1.4 The program shall include Soft-Skills, Communication Skills, Life Skill and Interview preparations for the beneficiaries under employability skill development program. The

- beneficiaries may be trained in any other skill set, as mutually decided by both the parties, that improves their employable skill and livelihoods.
- 1.5 The first party or the respective college/institute/university shall select the beneficiaries/students for the said program.

## II: Obligations of the First Party

- 1.1 Ensure that the necessary infrastructure like well-equipped class rooms are made available where the program shall be implemented.
- 1.2. Ensure that each of the selected colleges/ Institutes identify one resource person from their faculty to co-ordinate between the beneficiaries/students, the Institute management and the second party. Contact details of such identified resources shall be with the rest of the team.

## III: Activities of the Second Party (Naandi):

- 1.1. Prepare content that will be most effective in training the beneficiaries/students.
- 1.2 Provide the first party a detailed Course Schedule containing curriculum and day wise lesson plans of courses to be conducted
- 1.3 Ensure that well-trained trainers are identified for each Institute to ensure overall success of the Project.
- 1.5 Monitor the program by conducting periodic assessments to ensure that the trainers do a quality job.
- 1.6 At periodic intervals, give a narrative report to the first party with the challenges met, opinion about the program, suggestions for improvement and feedback from the trainees. Similarly, parameter-based impact evaluation report shall be prepared by second party and submitted to first party periodically on completion of trainings for all students. A consolidated impact report shall be submitted on evaluating impact at project intervention level.

### IV. TERM:

The MoU will be effective for a period of twelve months from the date of signing. The MOU may be extended on mutually agreed terms for a further period of one year or for such other period as mutually agreed by parties.

### V. Free of Cost:

The Program is free of cost. Naandi shall not charge any fees on whatsoever account/name either from the students or the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education - Telangana or its affiliated institutions, for conducting the aforesaid program.

### VI. Certification:

Certificates shall be awarded by Naandi to the students on successful completion of the training and clearing of the assessment held post completion of the program.

### VII. General Terms

### Amendments to the MoU:

No amendment or modification of this MoU shall be valid, unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this MoU. The modifications/changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed, unless otherwise agreed to.

### Compliance with laws, statutes, rules and regulations of Government / local authority:

Both the parties shall comply with all laws, statutes and rules & regulations of Central and State Governments or Local authorities that may be applicable from time to time as required under this MoU.

### Termination:

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana State, shall have the right to terminate the MoU, in case if the Naandi fails to fulfil their obligations as mentioned in the MoU, or violates any of the clause mentioned in the MoU.

### Assignment:

Naandi shall not be entitled to assign any of its rights, benefits or obligations under this MoU without written consent of the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana State.

## Relationship:

Nothing contained in this MoU will be construed as creating any agency, partnership, joint enterprise or other similar relationship between the parties. Neither party will have authority to contract for or

bind the other inany manner whatsoever. This MoU confers no rights upon either party except those expressly granted herein, and does not confer any right upon either party to make any representation or commitment on behalf of the other.

### Confidentiality:

The parties shall severally take care to ensure that the information provided by the other party remains confidential and further agree not to use the Confidential Information for any purpose other than the purpose for which it is intended.

The parties shall not disclose any Confidential Information to anyone other than the employees of either organization who need to know the Confidential Information.

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is entered on 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 2022:

Government Degree College for Women - Begumpet, Hyderabad India, represented by Dr. K Padmavathi, Principal, Government Degree College for Women - Begumpet, Hyderabad (hereinafter referred to as "Government Degree College for Women - Begumpet" which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executors, administrators, authorised representatives and permitted assigns) as **FIRST PARTY.** 

### AND

Naandi Foundation, a Public Charitable Trust incorporated under the Indian Trusts Act, 1882, having its registered office at 502, Trend set Towers, Road No 2, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad – 500 034, Telangana, India represented by Ms. Radha Varadarajan – Chief Skills Officer - Naandi Foundation (hereinafter referred to as "Naandi" which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executors, administrators, authorised representatives and permitted assigns) as SECOND PARTY.

(Both Parties are hereinafter jointly referred to as "Parties" and individually as a "Party")

## INTRODUCTION

WHEREAS the First party, Government Degree College for Women - Begumpet, Hyderabad to build a vibrant and inclusive learning community in a culture of excellence sustained by a sound value system that promotes responsible citizenship and effects social change.

WHEREAS Government Degree College for Women – Begumpet, Hyderabad. is to empower young women to face the challenges of life with courage and commitment, to be builders of a humane and a just society, and to promote a learning community in which all, especially those from less-privileged backgrounds, feel part of the collaborative high quality educational process which is value based and leads to holistic growth.

WHEREAS the Second party - Naandi Foundation is an apolitical, autonomous Public Charitable Trust and a not-for-profit organisation registered under section 12A of the income tax act, 1961 is tax-exempt and is recognised by tax authorities as an organisation established for 'charitable purpose'.

WHEREAS the Second party is working with an objective of people-centred development through its charitable activities in the whole of India, without distinction of caste, creed or religion, etc.

WHEREAS the Second party engaged, inter alia, in improving the livelihoods of the underprivileged communities through its various social initiatives, developmental programs in various states of India. The Second Party's activities include education to disadvantaged children with a specific focus on girl child education, improving livelihoods of small and marginal farmers through its farming practices, employable training and skill development programs to underprivileged youth, provision of safeidrinking water to communities, etc.

WHEREAS the Second Party Naandi Foundation, in furtherance of its objectives, wishes to support socially and economically disadvantaged underprivileged sections of society and provide them employability skills under its program "Mahindra Pride Classroom".

WHEREAS both the parties, having recognised each other's intention of working in the sphere of employability skills, wish to support socially and economically disadvantaged and underprivileged youth with a focus on women that helps in improving their employability skill set and livelihoods.

WHEREAS both the parties have decided to reduce the mutually agreed terms and conditions into writing.

# NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS UNDER:

I.TERM:

Govt. Degree College for Women (Autonomous)

This Memorandum of Understanding will come into effect from 17th May 2022 and shall remain in force till 17<sup>th</sup> May 2025. This MOU may be further extended on terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed by both parties.

II: The Naandi Skills Centre@ Government Degree College for Women – Begumpet, Hyderabad.

- I. The centre's objective is to be a vibrant on-campus space where students have ready access to all facilities to develop skills. The core of the facility is enabling students to have experiential learning in technologies, entrepreneurial ideation, providing tools to build prototypes, and support to take their business ideas to market. The mentoring will also provide a smooth transition from campus to career by providing necessary future-ready capabilities.
- II. The beneficiaries shall be from underprivileged sections of the society without distinction of caste, creed or religion, etc., shall be from the underprivileged youth women (18 years to 35 years) in and around the neighbourhood of the college, including the students studying in the pre-final or final year of graduation in Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad.
- III. The skilling program shall be for a duration of 40 hours or as the case may be decided mutually by the parties for the purpose of competence building and technology-enabled transformation.
- IV. The Program aims to help students:
  - Develop relevant 21st-century skills especially focussed on technology, innovation and entrepreneurship
  - To meet the current requirements of the nation's growing demands, including innovation and design-thinking for out of the box solutions.

- Further guidance in select software languages for interested participants
- Gain mentoring for micro and small businesses with a 360\* support from idea to market
- Keep up with the rapid changes in technologies by awareness on IoT, 3D tech and its applications in existing products in both national and international markets.
- Software coding and tech tools including exposure to free open-source code
- Supplement theoretical subject knowledge provided by formal academics with practical life skills, women centric skills, soft skills and communication skills.
- Acquire timeless nuanced dispositions as new entrants to the job market like goal setting, critical thinking, decision making and teamwork.
- The beneficiaries may be trained in any other skills, as mutually decided by both the parties, that improves their employability skill and livelihoods.

# III: OBLIGATIONS OF THE FIRST PARTY IN THE CAMPUS OF GOVERNMENT DEGREE COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, BEGUMPET, HYDERABAD.

- I. The first party, Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad shall provide the beneficiaries under the said program and shall ensure that they are underprivileged youth from in and around the neighbourhood of the college, including the students studying in the final year course(s) in the college with a special focus on women.
- II. To provide the second party with an enclosed hall or a classroom of 1000 square feet within the college premises, free of cost.
- III. To allow the second party to set up the required infrastructure facility and create a conducive environment in such a 1000 SQ FT hall/classroom at the premises of Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad for conducting the aforementioned skill program.
- IV. The first party hereby agrees that all such infrastructure created and/or provided by the second party (Naandi) is the property of the second party (Naandi). The first party Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad shall not claim any right or title over such infrastructure. The first party Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad, shall allow the second party (Naandi) to keep such infrastructure so provided and the hall or classroom under its safe custody, lock and key. Further, the second party (Naandi) shall have the right to remove such infrastructure provided for the said program from the Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad premises, as mutually agreed upon by the both parties during the period of this MOU or on completion of the program, as it thinks fit.

- V. To provide the necessary infrastructure like restroom facility for faculty and students participating in the training, Electrical connectivity for using devices during sessions & a plain wall for display of student work.
- VI. To ensure the safety and security of the beneficiaries and Naandi's representatives while the classes are being conducted in the college premises.
- VII. Ensure to identify three people as 'resource persons' (hereinafter referred to as POCs Point of Contact, two-person Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad to coordinate between the beneficiaries, premises provider Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad, and the Second Party. Contact details of the POCs shall be shared with the Second party and the rest of the team.
- VIII. POCs should ensure that all the trainees of Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad are given awareness on attending the aforementioned skill training program prior to the training. To ensure that beneficiaries attend the sessions continuously without fail.
- IX. To allow Naandi's employees, representatives and trainers into the college premises, during the sustenance of this MOU, to interact with POC, program-related staff and beneficiaries.
- X. Ensure that the POCs take feedback from the trainees for quality assurance purposes.

# IV: ACTIVITIES OF THE SECOND PARTY (NAANDI):

- I. Prepare content that will be most effective in training the beneficiaries/students.
- II. To impart employability skill set to socially and economically disadvantaged and underprivileged women/girls that helps in improving livelihoods and economic security.
- III. To set up at its own cost, required infrastructure facility and create a conducive environment in the 1000 SQ FT hall/classroom provided by the first party at the premises of Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad. The second party shall maintain a list of such infrastructure so. to identify its property and shall share the same with the first party under proper acknowledgement once the infrastructure details are decided. The first party, Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad hereby agree that it will not claim any right or title over such infrastructure provided by the second party. The second party (Naandi) shall have the right to remove such infrastructure offered for the said program from the premises, as mutually agreed upon by the both parties at any time during the period of this MOU or on completion of the program.

- IV. The second party (Naandi) hereby agrees that the enclosed hall or a classroom of 1000 SQ FT facilitated by Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad campus is the property of Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad, and it will not claim any right or title over such hall or classroom provided.
- V. All Naandi assets, including the hardware/equipment including technical requirements, will be made available for the enrolled students for the duration of the program.
- VI. Ensure that well-trained trainers are identified and engaged to ensure the overall success of the Program.
- VII. Ensure to give an update on employability training program and its importance to the training coordinator of the First Party.
- VIII. Monitor the program by conducting periodic assessments to ensure that the trainers do a quality job.

## V. FREE OF COST:

The socially and economically disadvantaged underprivileged youth focusing on women are provided with technical and employability skill sets under the Mahindra Pride Classroom program to improve their livelihoods and economic security. The Program is free of cost. Therefore, either party shall not charge any fees on whatsoever account/name from the beneficiaries under the program. Further, both the parties agree that either party shall not charge any fees whatsoever from the other party under this MOU/program.

## VI. CERTIFICATION:

The second party shall award certificates to the beneficiaries on successful completion of the training having attendance percentage above 80 and clearing of the assessment held post completion of the program.

## VII. INSURANCE:

- The first party Government Degree College for Women Begumpet, Hyderabad, shall ensure and take the appropriate insurance cover at its own cost of its buildings, structures, and other assets.
- II. The second party (Naandi) shall ensure and take the appropriate insurance cover at its own cost to cover the infrastructure facility created and/or provided in the premises under this MOU.

III. The first party (Government Degree College for Women - Begumpet, Hyderabad) hereby agrees to give any required declaration or document to any insurance company to enable the second party (Naandi) to cover its infrastructure facility/assets under insurance.

# VIII. General Terms:

# Relationship between the parties:

Nothing herein shall be construed to constitute the Parties as principal and agent, employer and employee, partners or joint ventures, nor shall any similar relationship be deemed to exist between the Parties. This Memorandum of Understanding is made on a principal-to-principal basis.

# Representation and Warranties:

Each Party hereby represents to the other that they have been duly incorporated/registered under the applicable laws and has full legal right and authority to execute this memorandum of understanding. Each Party represents that it is also authorised to perform its obligations as herein contemplated; and that neither the performance of the obligations nor execution of this MOU will violate or in violation of any applicable laws for the time being in force.

# Confidentiality:

The parties shall severally take care to ensure that the information provided by the other party remains confidential and further agree not to use the Confidential Information for any purpose other than the purpose for which it is intended. The parties shall not disclose any Confidential Information to anyone other than the employees of either organisation who need to know the Confidential Information. Each Party recognises such information of the other Party as confidential information and agrees not to disclose them to any third party without the prior written consent of the other Party. The restriction contained in this clause shall not be applicable to information which (i) is required to be provided pursuant to any statutory or regulatory obligation; (ii) is lawfully acquired by the disclosing Party from an independent source having no obligation to maintain the confidentiality of such information; and (iii) was lawfully known to the disclosing Party prior to its disclosure under this Agreement.

# **Intellectual Property:**

Each Party acknowledges the intellectual property rights of any kind, including but not limited to the copyright, patent rights, design rights, service marks, trademarks, logos, titles, slogans, property rights and any other rights with and held by the other Party and undertake that neither Party shall claim any right, title and interest in the Intellectual Property Rights of the other Party.

# Dispute Resolution:

If any dispute arises between the Parties, the Parties shall endeavour to resolve them mutually. If such resolution is not possible within a reasonable period, the unresolved dispute shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration Act for the time being in force, conducted by a sole arbitrator to be appointed by the Parties mutually. The arbitration shall be in English and the seat of the arbitration shall be at Hyderabad. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both parties.

# Validity of Clauses:

If any Clause or any part of this Agreement shall for any reason be adjudged by any court or other legal authority of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions contained herein shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby.

# **Entire Agreement:**

This Agreement sets forth the entire agreement between the Parties at the date hereof relating to the Purpose and supersedes any prior agreements or arrangements (whether oral or in writing) between the Parties relating thereto.

**Notices:** 

Govt. Degree College for Women (Autonomous) Begumpet, Hyderabad.

All notices, which either Party is required or may desire to serve upon the other Party, shall be in writing and addressed as specified in the recital of this Agreement. Notices may be served personally or by facsimile, certified mail, express mail, email to a designated employee of the Party or express courier.

### Termination:

Either of the parties is entitled to terminate this MOU by giving a thirty days' notice to the other party in case of breach of any term of this MOU by the other party, provided that before issuing such termination notice, such issues shall be discussed with senior officials of the Parties and if they fail to resolve such issues within a period of fifteen (15) days, then it shall result in termination of this memorandum of understanding.

## Force Majeure:

Neither Party shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective obligations under this MOU due to the exigency of one or more of the Majeure event such as but not limited to acts of God, war, flood, earthquakes, strikes, lockouts, epidemics, pandemic, riots, civil commotion, etc., provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such event the Party effected thereby shall give notice in writing to other Party within one (1) month of such occurrence or cessation. If force majeure continues beyond one (1) month, the parties shall jointly and mutually decide about the future course of action or terminate this MOU with immediate effect.

# Assignment and Delegation:

Neither this Memorandum of Understanding nor any duties or obligations under this Agreement may be assigned or delegated by either party.

# Governing Laws and Jurisdiction:

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be governed by laws of India and shall be subject to the jurisdiction of courts situated at Hyderabad.

# **Rules of Interpretation:**

The headings to clauses are inserted for convenience only and shall not affect the construction or interpretation of this Memorandum of Understanding. In this Memorandum of Understanding, words expressed in any gender shall, where the context so requires or permits, include the other gender. In this MOU, words expressed in the singular shall, where the context so requires or permits, include the plural.

# Counterparts:

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be executed in two counterparts, each of which shall be deemed as original, but all of this together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
