INTRODUCTION

SR&BGNR GASC(A) Khammam was established in 1956, caters to the students hailing from the semi urban and rural areas of mainly Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. The college provides university education to deserving candidates in a secular atmosphere and it is the most sought-after institution in the state. The college helps the students to become truly empowered citizens. The college has completed 65 years and making a remarkable contribution in the field of education.

102 full time teachers are working in the college.

STRENGTH

Total strength of students in UG and PG is 3783.

PROGRAMMES

Total number of programmes is 53 and 363 courses across all the programmes are offered by the college.

AUTONOMY

Recognizing the potential of the college the UGC has conferred autonomous status to the college in the year 2016. As such the first year students admitted into UG will conform to the autonomous pattern of education. The teaching and evaluation are conducted in six semesters at UG level. The college follows the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). The college has applied for Extension of Autonomous status in its second cycle.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The college has 69 rooms and a good Library with a Reference section and a Reading Room, Spacious Playground. Administrative block is under construction. The college has arboretum and History museum. The Computer Center, TSKC Lab, the Health centre, the Gymnasium, the MANA TV (T-SAT Nipuna) and the Audio-Visual Department are the other supporting services provided by the college. The infrastructure in the college is conducive to the multifaceted courses that we offer. Our Library comprises over 50,000 books, a Reading Room with e-corner, Magazines and Newspapers. We firmly believe that education alone can take the society to dizzy heights.

NAAC ACCREDITATION

The College is gearing up for the 4th cycle of NAAC Accreditation. During the academic year 2016-2017, the college was assessed and re-accredited by NAAC with B++.
