AUTONOMY

Recognizing the potential of the college the UGC has conferred autonomous status to the college in the year 2016. As such the first year students admitted into UG will conform to the autonomous pattern of education. The teaching and evaluation are conducted in six semesters at UG level. The college follows the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). The college has applied for Extension of Autonomous status in its second cycle.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The colloege has 69 rooms and a good Library with a Reference section and a Reading Room, Spacious Playground. The college has arboretum and History museum. The Computer Center, TSKC Lab, the Health centre, the Gymnasium, the MANA TV (T-SAT Nipuna) and the Audio-Visual Department are the other supporting services provided by the college. The infrastructure in the college is conducive to the multifaceted courses that we offer. Our Library comprises over 50,000 books, a Reading Room with e-corner, Magazines and Newspapers.
