In this regard, the Principals of the Prize Winning GDCs are instructed to follow the instructions:

1. The Projects selected for the First Prize shall be awarded with Rs.25,000/- cash prize for the group and Rs.5,000/- for the Faculty Supervisor/Mentor. The Projects selected for the Second Prize shall be awarded with Rs.18,000/- cash prize for the group and Rs.3,000/- for the Faculty Supervisor/Mentor. The projects selected for the Third Prize shall be awarded with Rs. 10,000/ and Rs.2,000/- for the Faculty Supervisor/Mentor.
2. The Cash prize for the Prize Winners shall be issued in favour of the Principal of the concerned College. The Principals are therefore requested to distribute the amount equally among the winning students of the team through a crossed cheque and acquire a stamped receipt from the students concerned. The acquaintance along

with the compliance report shall be made available to O/o CCE on the day of prize distribution ceremony.

3. The Principals shall bring with them the cheques at the time of the Prize Distribution Ceremony programme in favour of the Faculty Supervisor/Mentor and the students of the first, second and third prize winners neatly placing each cheque in a transparent cover and hand it over to the Jignasa State Coordinators on the day of prize distribution ceremony.
4. The Faculty Supervisors/mentors are instructed to mail to Jignasa-ce@telangana.gov.in a one page (A4 Size) brief synopsis of the project covering aspects like Aim and Objectives of the project, Research Methodology, Analysis of Data, Findings, Conclusions and Suggestions for publishing in the Jignasa Magazine on or before 27th April, 2024. The format for the synopsis is as follows:
