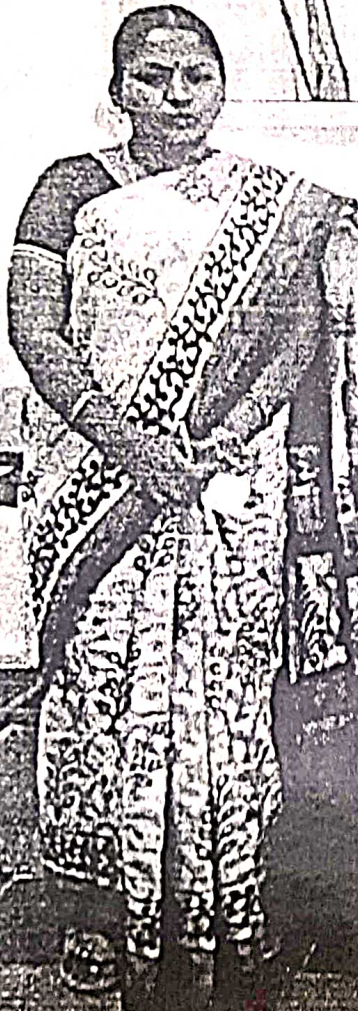

Kalaji Narayana Rao :- "9 September 1914 - 13 November 2002" was an Indian poet, freedom fighter, anti-fascist and political activist of Telangana. He was awarded the Padma Vibhushan in 1992. The Telangana government honored Kalaji's birthday as Telangana Language Day.

Kalaji Narayana Rao.

- Born - 9 September 1914 Rattihalli, Bijapur (Karnataka), India.
- Died - 13 November 2002 (aged 88).  
(now Telangana), India.
- Other names - Kalanna, Praja Kavi.
- Known for - Political activist, poet.

Education and activism :- Kalaji was born on

September 9, 1914 in Rattihalli village in Bijapur district, Karnataka. His mother Ramabaiamma

hailing from Karnataka. Father, Kalosi Rameshwara Rao, an Urdu poet, played a vital role in shaping his personality. Kalosi completed his primary education in Wazangal and Hyderabad. Kalosi is a polyglot. Although he studied in Marathi, Kannada, Hindi and Urdu. Kalosi married Aukmini Bai in 1940.

During his student days, he was deeply influenced by and participated in popular movements of the time. Like the Arya Samaj Movement, especially in the domain of civil rights. He has also involved in Andhra Maha Sabha activities since its formation in 1934, and part of the Satyagraha, Osmania University Vandemataram, State Congress, Andhra Mahasabha (Telugana) and Liberty movements. Considered by many to be a freedom fighter, (according to whom) he was part of the freedom movement of Hyderabad state and underwent imprisonment under the

His commitment to human rights made him an active member of the Taxkunda committee. Although opposed to power and the trapping of office kalaji looked upon elections as a democratic exercise. He contested thrice and got elected once as a member of the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Council.

His most significant dispute was against Talagam vengal Rao, then chief minister of Andhra Pradesh, in 1977.

Government and administration.

Structure :- The Governor is the constitutional head and the chief minister is head. The executive legislative powers lie with and are appointed by the chief minister and his council of ministers, who are appointed by the Governor. The Governors of the states and territories of India have similar powers and

States and territories of India President of only Indian citizens above 36-years of age eligible for appointment.

Governors discharge all constitutional functions such as the appointment of the chief minister, sending to issues relating to the assent to bill passed by legislature, exercise or their own opinion.

Elkadu Srinivasan Lakshmi Narasimhan was the governor on September 1, 2019.

The Governor enjoys many different types of powers:




1. Executive Powers :- related to administration - appointments and removals.
