In a move aimed at motivating students to join the prestigious institutions in the country, an awareness programme on JAM (Joint Admission Test for MSc) - 2019 was conducted by the Department of Chemistry, Kakatiya Government College, Hanamkonda here on Saturday.

"If a student gets a MSc seat in institutes such as IITs or NITs, they will get better exposure and will enjoy better facilities. Post graduates from such institutes get better pay packages when compared to pass outs from a State university," he said addressing the students at the valedictory programme of the 40-day free coaching programme for IIT-Jam (Joint Admission Test for M Sc) 2019, organised by the Department of Chemistry, Kakatiya Government College, Hanamkonda, on Friday.

Vice-Principal and in-charge Department of

Chemistry B Suresh Babu said if a student from a Government college bags a seat in any Central organisation, Commissioner of Collegiate Education awards Rs 1 lakh to the student. He said all areas of syllabus including Organic Chemistry, Physical Chemistry and Inorganic Chemistry had been covered by the faculty.

A 40-day free coaching programme for IIT, 'JAM (Joint Admission Test for MSc) 2019' was organised by the department of Chemistry, Kakatiya Government College, Hanamkonda.

Speaking at the concluding day, principal Dr P Venkateshwarlu hoped that many students would bag M.Sc. seats in the IITs/NITs, because they would get better exposure. A post-graduate from such an institute would be offered a good salary package compared to someone who passed out of a state university, he said.

Vice-principal and in-charge department of Chemistry, Dr B. Suresh Babu, said that if any student from a Government college bagged a seat in any central institute, the commissioner of collegiate education would award ₹1 lakh.

He said that the complete syllabus including Organic Chemistry, Physical Chemis-

try and Inorganic Chemistry were covered by the faculty.
