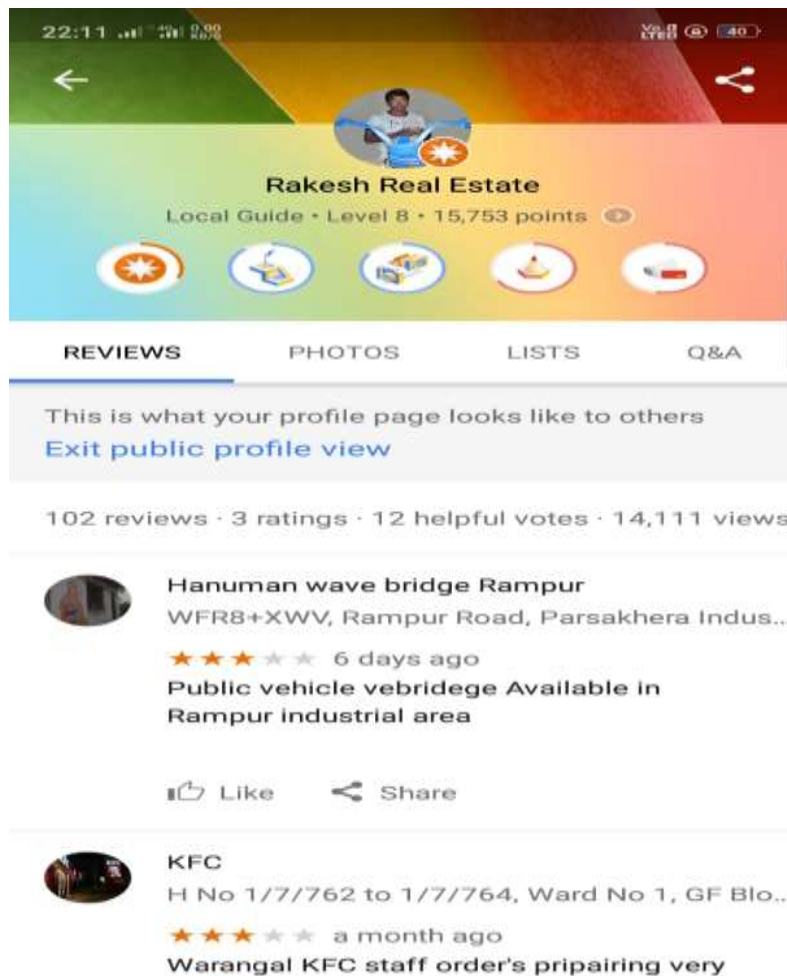

JIGNASA RESEARCH PROJECTS

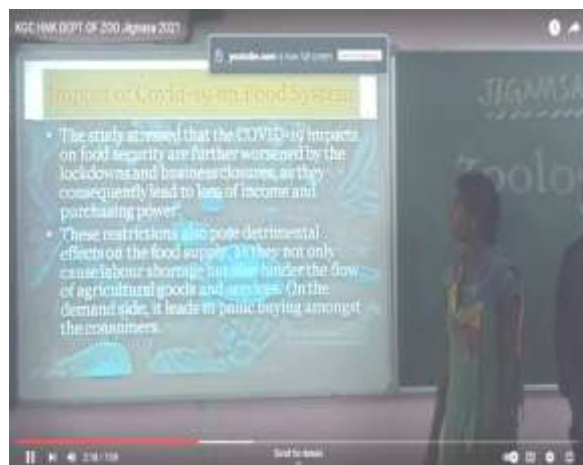

Letter of Understanding Between United Nations Development Programme And Commissionerate of Collegiate Education Government of Telangana

The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), an agency of the United Nations, helps countries to develop policies, leadership skills, partnering abilities, institutional capabilities and build resilience in order to sustain development results. UNDP works in more than 170 countries and territories, helping to achieve the eradication of poverty, and the reduction of inequalities and exclusion.

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Government of Telangana's mandate is to promote Collegiate Education, giving special attention to the areas located in Backward and Rural areas, to strengthen Women education at undergraduate and post-graduate levels to create educational opportunities for weaker sections of the society and to introduce need-based vocational courses replacing the conventional courses in a phased manner. The Government's initiative of Telangana Skills & Knowledge Centre (TSKC) addresses help students learn and practice employability skills as a dependable solution to the problem of unemployment faced by students studying non- professional courses in Government Degree Colleges.

Through this Letter of Understanding (LOU), UNDP and the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Government of Telangana wish to explore areas of collaboration in the framework of the UNDP implemented Project, 'Creating Opportunities for Employment and Entrepreneurship for Women in India'. This initiative seeks to leverage the needs for skilled personnel and other inputs in the business sector (as well as their financial and institutional capacity) and to create opportunities for skill development, employment and entrepreneurship for women. This multi-state initiative is funded by the IKEA Foundation and is supported by Xynteo, an international advisory firm which will help build partnerships with the business sector as well as the India Development Foundation (IDF) which is responsible for concurrent monitoring and research. The project has been duly endorsed by the Department of Economic Affairs, Union Ministry of Finance.

This LOU is aimed at harnessing the initiatives of the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, government of Telangana to make the students of non- professional courses in Government Degree Colleges employable. The core of this partnership will be to bridge the information gap that college students particularly the women confront with regard to information on opportunities for skill development and employment as well as public programmes created to serve these needs.

This LoU will facilitate collaboration in the following areas:

Strengthen the Government Degree Colleges in their efforts as career guidance, counselling & skills centres in the form of Telangana Skills & Knowledge Centres (TSKC) to :

- Provide information, Psychometric profiling & career guidance to girl students.
- Facilitate establishment of close linkages with the businesses / private sector to open up a range of internship and job opportunities for girls.
- Facilitate linkages with the government & private training providers to promote employability and entrepreneurship among students.
- Train & build capacity of select college teachers as trainers & counsellor for Career guidance & counselling so as to sustain the initiative.

The joint programme will be piloted initially in 40 government degree colleges across Hyderabad, Ranga Reddy, Medak, Mahbubnagar, Warangal, Adilabad and Khammam districts.

The LoU will be operational from the date of signing till 31 October, 2018.

A brief project outline is attached for reference (Annex-1). To ensure smooth implementation of the project, a detailed action plan with specific deliverables, timelines and responsibilities will be mutually worked out within a month of signing of the partnership LOU.

The focal points persons under this partnership will be Mr. Clement Chauvet, Chief Skills and Business Development for UNDP and Ms. Vani Prasad, IAS, Commissioner, Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Government of Telangana.

Activities under MoU

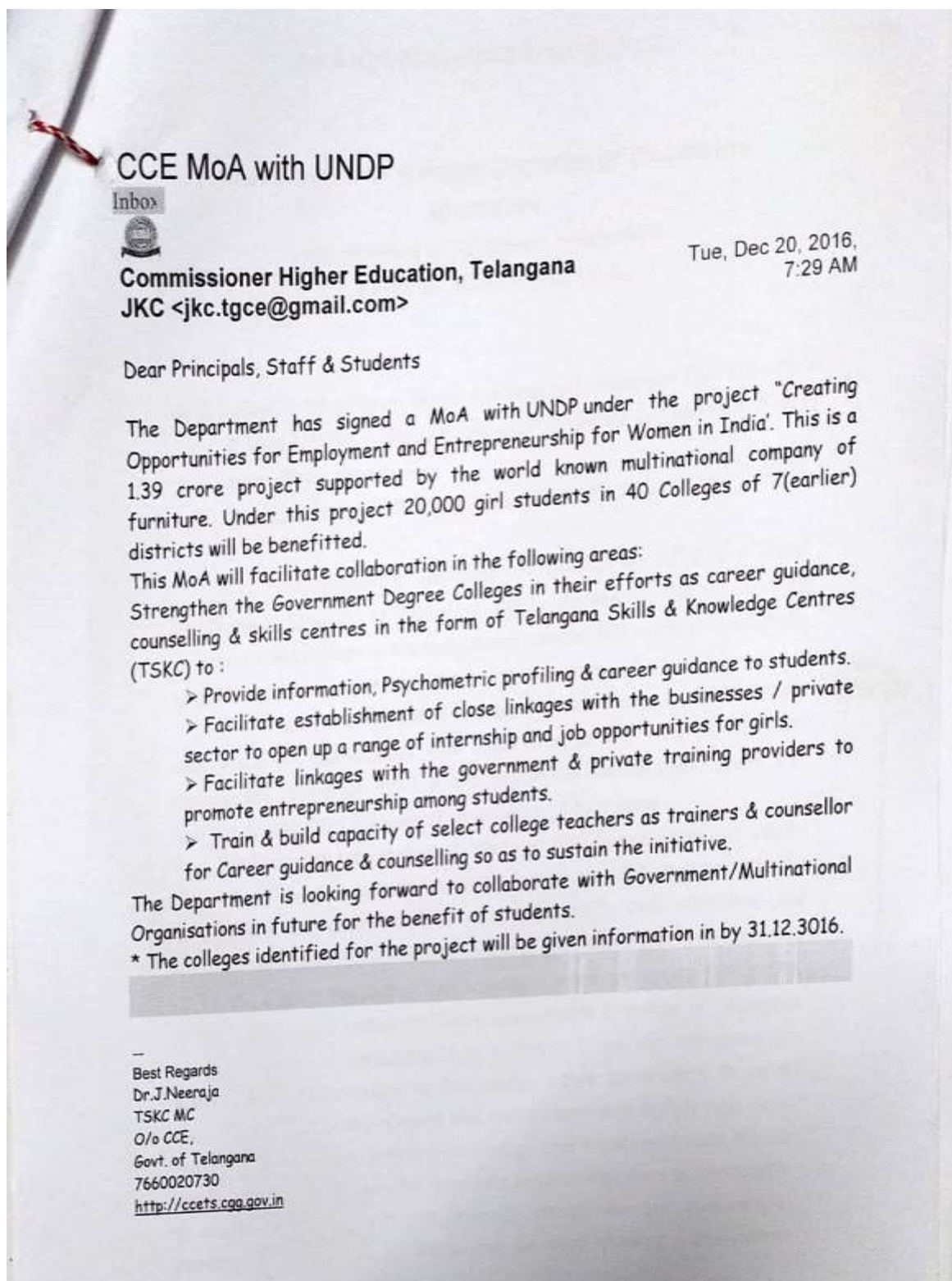

The theme of the workshop is "Power Tools: Confidence, Leadership and Entrepreneurship", an intensive program designed for individuals seeking to think and act more entrepreneurial.

Speaker Bio: The Workshop (Boot-camp) will be led by Hilary MJS Weber, Founder & CEO of Opportu Startup Innovation and an adjunct Instructor on startup innovation for U.C. Berkeley's College of Engineering Executive Education program, Board Member at Sky Deck (U.C. Berkeley's accelerator), an Industry Fellow at the Sutardja

Center for Entrepreneurship and Innovation. She is also a Contributor to the Berkeley Innovation Index, an initiative designed by U.C. Berkeley faculty Hilary MJS Weber is an entrepreneur, Berkeley-Haas MBA, seasoned business leader, leadership consultant, experienced executive and team coach, and healthcare industry veteran.

Entry/Participation: The entry for the boot-camp/workshop is free but the shortlisting of the participants will be done by an expert committee under three categories 1)For Women Entrepreneurs, Women startup Founders 2)For working professionals, aspiring Women Entrepreneurs, women in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) or aspiring to take up STEM and women restarting their careers 3)students

Curriculum debrief: The Girls in Tech India Workshop (Boot-camp) is a blend of interactive lectures, case studies, hands-on workshop exercises that each participant will engage in. Participants will begin with Confidence Building as addressing confidence in women before they become entrepreneurs is a critical step in their success. They become more self-assured, bolstered by the company of their peers in a safe learning environment.

The second portion features an introduction to Entrepreneurship, which begins with creating and communicating a Vision/Mission that they care about. This exercise builds on the Confidence portion. Next, the Overview of Entrepreneurship Basics is an interactive, in-depth segment that allows the participants to jump in with both feet, so they optimize their learning by taking an idea from the beginning stage through building and delivering a final pitch to experienced judges at the end of the Boot-camp/workshop.

In addition, all participants will use a new online assessment called the Berkeley Innovation Index at the beginning, middle and end of the Boot-camp. This tool will

help each participant see their progress as they learn and change their mindset and behaviors over the course of the boot-camp, and (in aggregate) will allow the hosts, partners, sponsors of the boot-camp see how the entire group increased their ability to innovate through their participation in the program.

Take away:

All participants shall receive a certificate with authorization of U.S. Consulate General Hyderabad and 1. Opportu Startup Innovation, USA and 2. Pantas and Ting: Sutardja Center for Entrepreneurship and Technology, Berkeley Engineering, University of California, Berkeley, USA.

Few selected participants have an opportunity to receive entry to Girls in Tech Catalyst Conference USA in April. A few select participants will get to apply for IBM GEP free cloud credits and will get a mentoring session from IBM GEP. They also get an opportunity to get facilitated by Intelicap Advisory Services Private Limited for funding.

There will also be seasoned entrepreneurs, experienced professionals, corporate, experts from all walks of life who will help mentor and deliver a blend of interactive series, case studies and hands-on workshop exercises that each participant will engage in. Whether an entrepreneur attempting to create a startup or an executive working on an internal venture, this program provides tools that they need for starting a business.

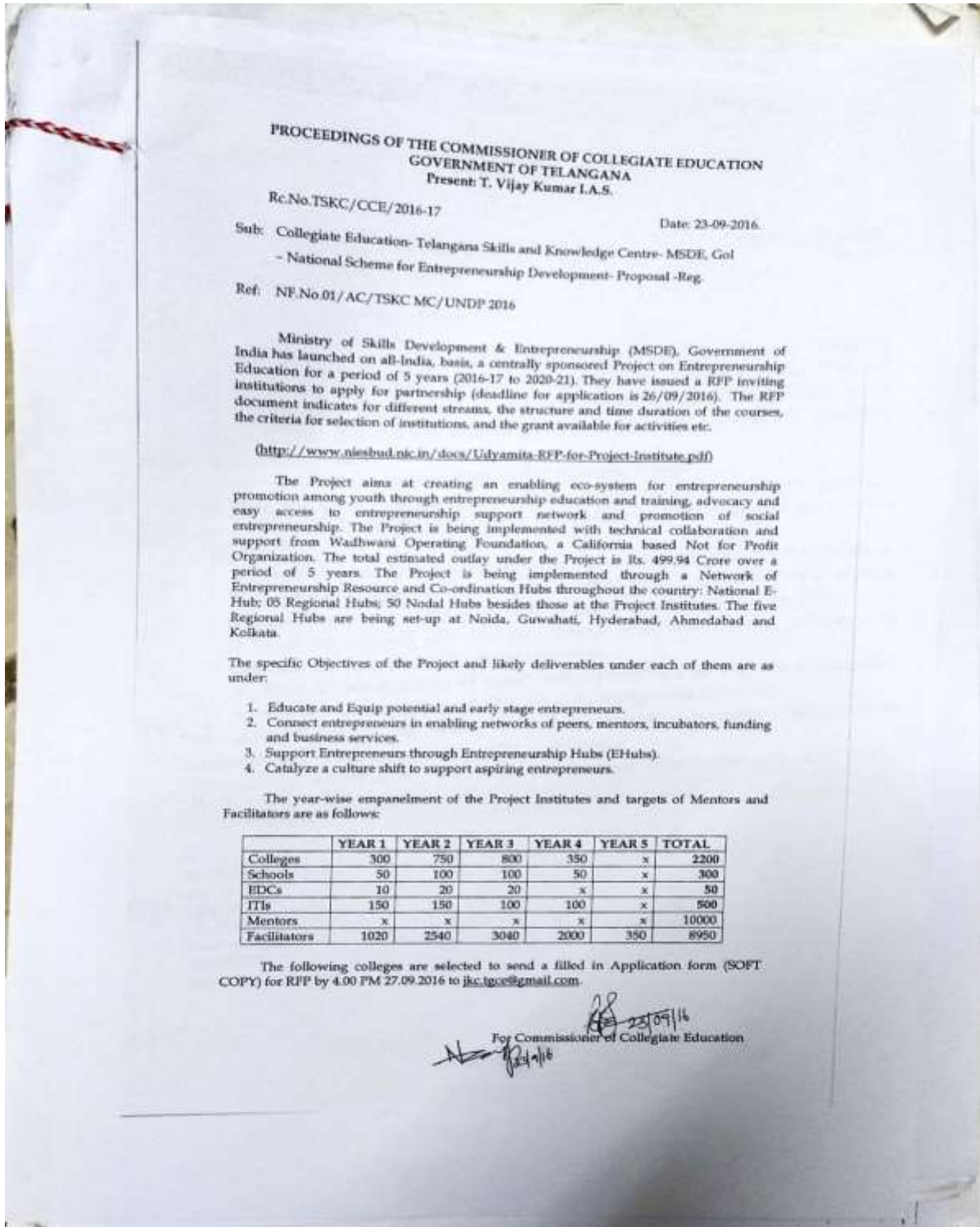
Colleges can shortlist a minimum of 25 girls (maximum is left to college) For short listing the girls, the college can select girls who are in final year (give first preference to final year students some 2nd year students can also be selected), are pro active, have demonstrated some innovative ideas in paper/poster presentations, etc., or have some inclination towards entrepreneurship.

The students shortlisted by the college can then apply online . Final selection of students who apply online will then be done by an independent selection committee .

CERTIFICATE COURSE IN SERICULTURE

Department of Zoology organised a certificate course in Sericulture from October 3rd 2017 to November-15th 2017. The duration of course is 30 days and the number of periods required to complete the course is 60.

Sericulture is a small scale, agro based cottage industry. Silk is a naturally produced animal fibre and it is rightly called as Queen of fibre textiles.

There are four major types of silk of commercial importance obtained from different species of silkworms. India produces all these varieties of silk. The four types of silk are mulberry silk, tasar silk, Muga silk, Eri silk.

Mulberry silk forms the bulk of the commercial silk produced in the world. It comes from the silkworms *Bombyx mori*. In India, mulberry silk producing states are Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, West Bengal, Tamil Nadu and Jammu & Kashmir.

Sericulture provides gainful employment in different states of India. Importance of silk - It is used in the preparation of garments, parachute cords, fishing lines and elastic webs, insulation coils for telephones and wireless receivers etc.

Sericulture plays an important role in anti-poverty programme and prevents migration of rural people to urban areas in search of employment.

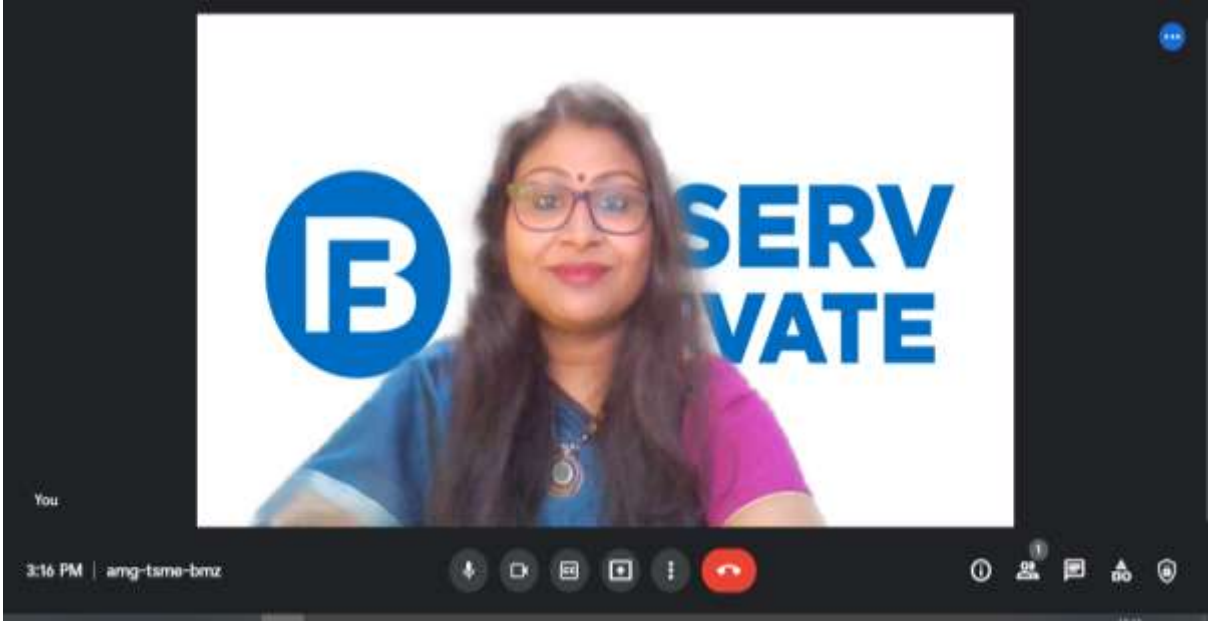
From 17-12-2021 to 31-01-2022

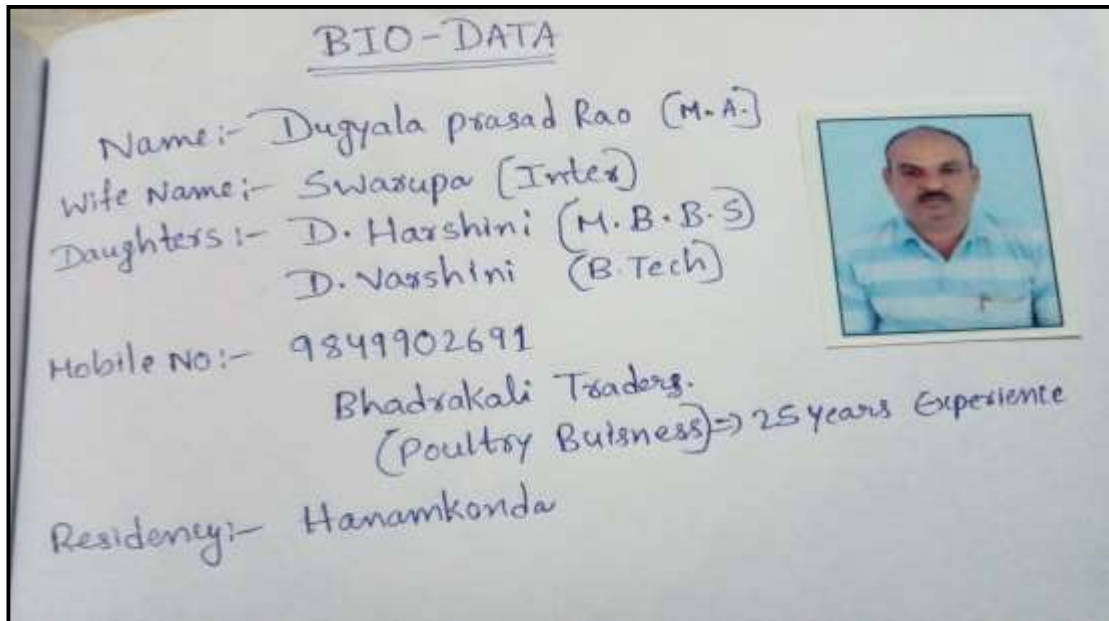
