

Outline of the Workshop

There are several essential components in a network:

- 1. Switches
- 2. Access Points
- 3. Servers
- 4. Clients
- 5. IP Addresses
- 6. Routers and Firewalls
 - 1) **Switches** and access points connect the devices or "clients" in a network so they can talk to each other. Each client has a numerical label known as an IP address.
 - 2) **Servers** host and send information in the form of web content, applications and files to client devices. They use IP addresses for direction.
 - 3) **Switches**: Switches are pieces of hardware that connect devices in a network. They allow information to be sent between PCs, printers, mobile devices, servers and other devices quickly and efficiently.

- 4) **Access Points**: An access point is a hardware device that allows Wi-Fi enabled devices to connect to a network without cables. It can be built into a router or connected via Ethernet cable.
- 5) **Servers**: A server is a high-powered machine that dispatches data to devices in a network.

- 7) **IP Address**: IP addresses are unique identification codes for network devices that tell servers where to send data. A device must have an IP address to allow other devices to establish a connection with it.
- 8) **Routers and Firewalls**: A router acts as the gateway to your network. It also allows all networked computers to use one internet connection.
- 9) A firewall is the most basic level of network security.

The Department of Botany conducted "One day work shop QR codes for Plants" on 20-02-2019. The main objective of this workshop was to enable the students to know the complete information of the plants through QR (Quick Response codes). The in charge of the department Dr. B. Vijayapal Reddy explained the benefits of QR codes. He also mentioned that technology and communication advancements are reaching their maximum point. Every day, new technological advancements are developed, which has led to a profound transformation in every part of our lives, including the field of education. He urged the students to update their knowledge to cope up with these new innovations.

Dr. M. Rambabu mentioned that in digital era, even a common people can also easily scan the code and know the details of the plants. The QR codes were laminated and attached to the plants for the viewers. The duplicate QR codes are kept ready in the college for references. The plants are protected with regular monitoring by the staff and students.

A. Ramana Rao explained the novel idea of pasting the QR (Quick Response) code. Students can use any scanning app available on the phones to get all the information they need to know about the tree, from its scientific name to its medicinal value. He mentioned that there are about 650 trees in the campus. However, in the first phase, it was decided to paste the QR codes to 214 trees that were planted in the last five years.
