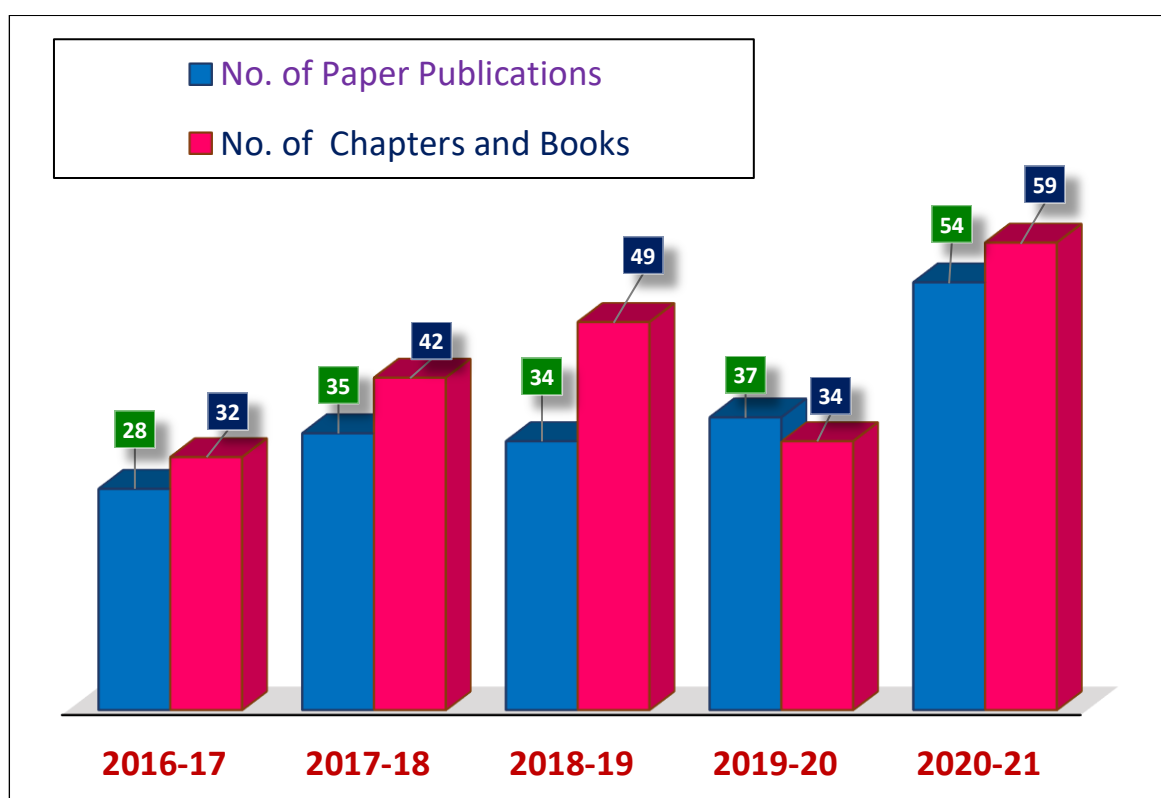
Incremental Improvements

- Most of the teachers have been involved in the research activity by contributing chapters to books, writing text books and publication of research articles in reputed journals.

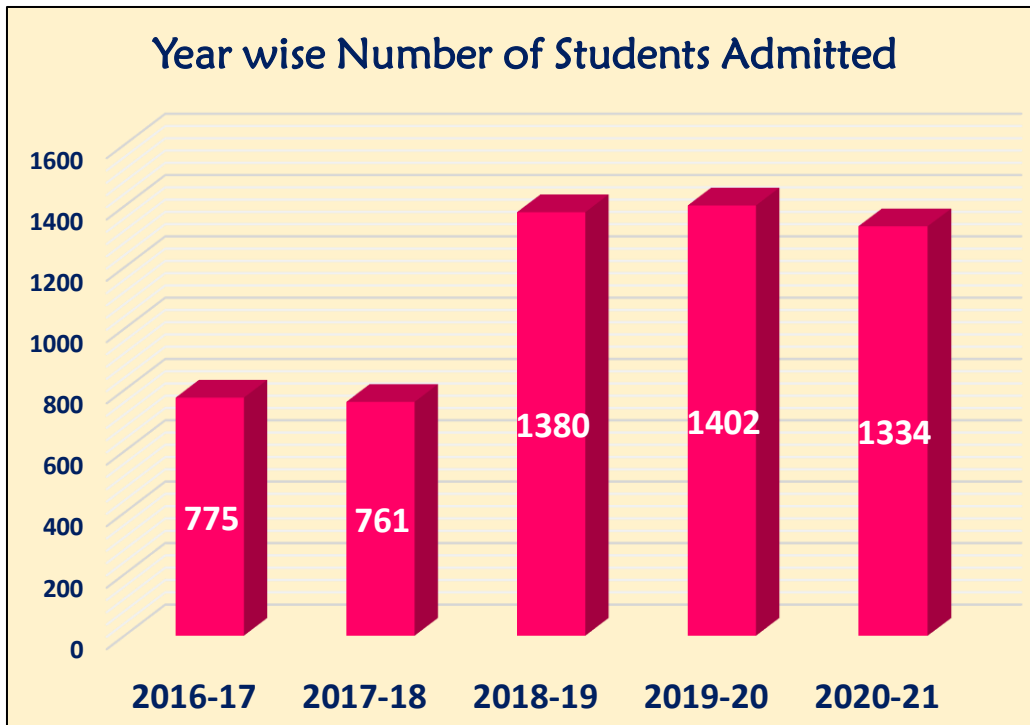

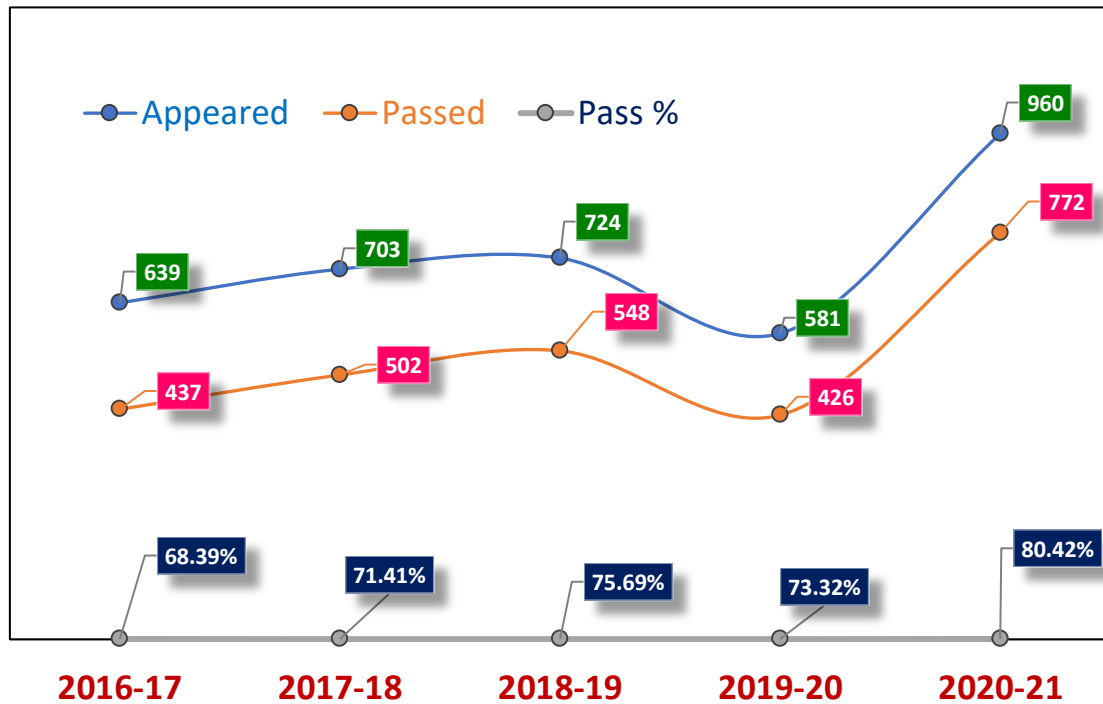
Admissions and Results

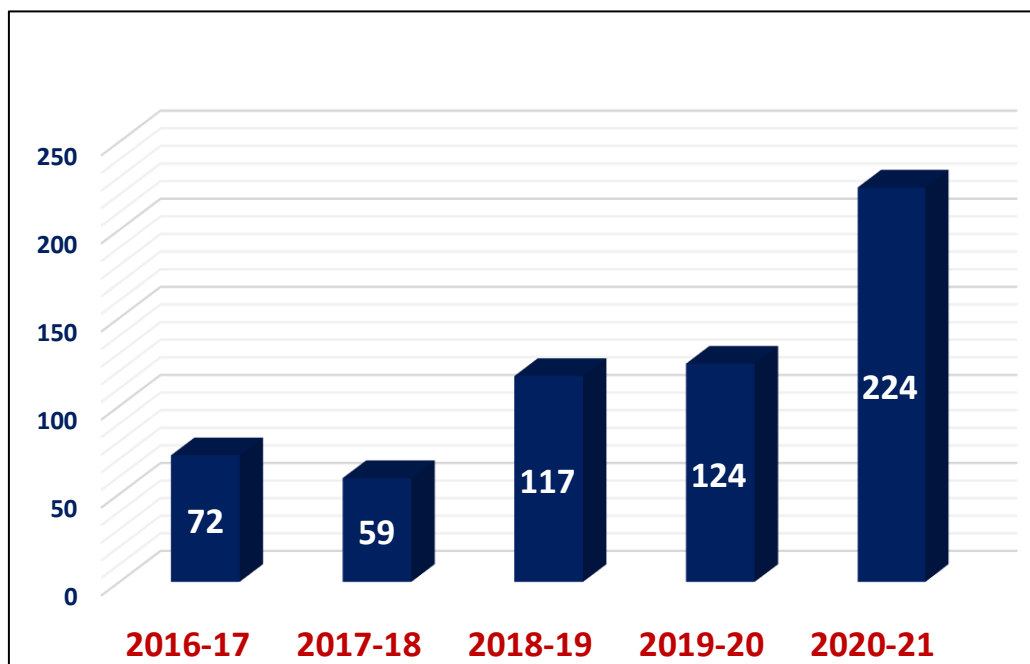

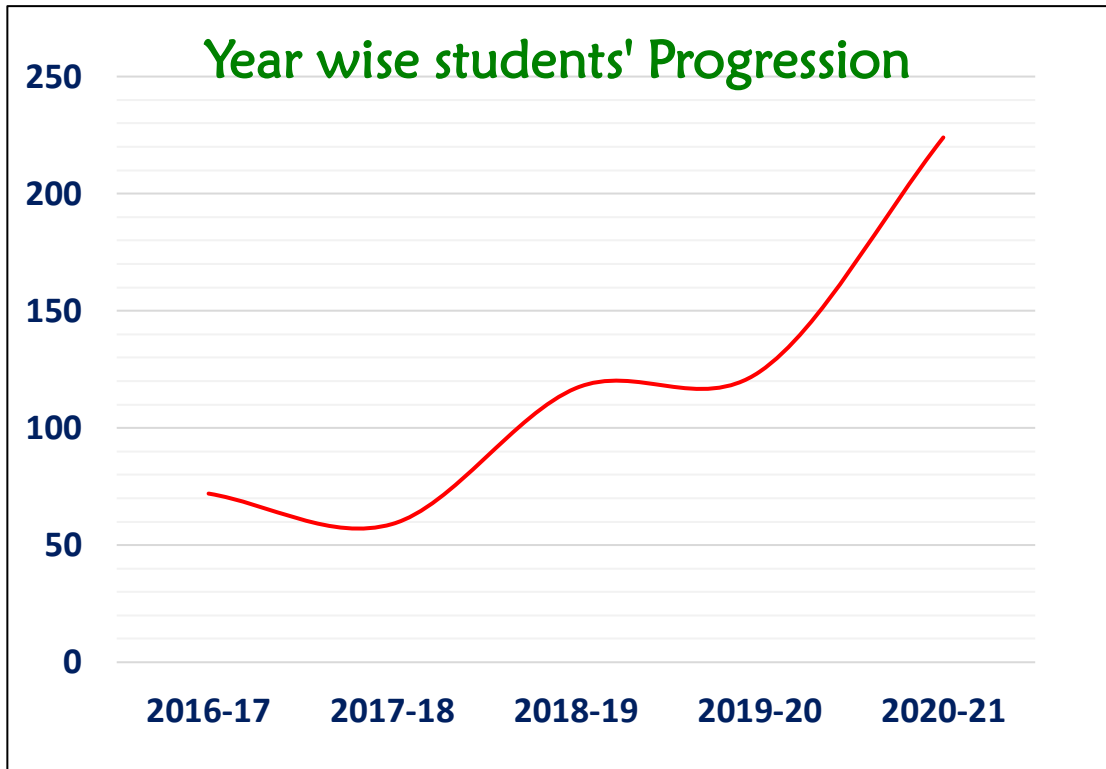
