Introduction

Kakatiya Government College, Hanamkonda was inaugurated on 01.08.1972. The college has 5 acre of land in the heart of the city Hanumakonda which is considered to be the next to Hyderabad in terms of educational opportunities. Today the college is the most sought after institution in Telangana with the student strength of 3500. It offers 33 UG courses and 06 PG Courses through CBCS system.
