### Introduction

Kakatiya Government College, Hanamakonda was inaugurated on 01/08/1972. The college has 5 acre of land in the heart of the city Hanamakonda which is considered to be the next to Hyderabad in terms of educational opportunities. Today the college is the most sought after institution in Telangana with the student strength of 3500. It offers 33 UG courses and 06 PG Courses through CBCS system. The college follows the standard guidelines in maintaining transparency in all aspects such as online admissions, digital classrooms for ICT enabled teaching, consistent academic initiatives, research and innovation in curriculum, well equipped labs, well-stacked college library and departmental libraries, well organised mechanism for student support and governance.

College has well established structure and system for encouraging sports, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, besides CCE initiatives like JIGNASA and YUVATARANGAM. Refresher courses, Orientation courses and workshops are regularly made available to the staff to motivate and refresh their knowledge. ## **Holistic multi-disciplinary approach and flexible system**

The college offers flexible and innovative curricula that include credit-based courses under CBCS pattern. There is transparent mechanism for admissions through DOST online process. Bucket system is introduced to facilitate the student to choose one subject/course of his choice from each of the four subject buckets not exceeding three for the programme he/she opts for. This system provides more flexibility and multiple disciplines in choosing his undergraduate programme. For example, a student can pursue BA program with mathematics, psychology, computer appliances etc as one of the courses.
