

Alumnae Feedback of the Five Years




- 1. Regard to the attributes 1,5,6,7 & they were moving downward during 2016-17 & 2017-18 and moved upward in 2018-19.

- ➤ Action Taken Report: The Academic Staff Council together with all the Teachers have resolved under the chairmanship of the Principal and the IQAC Committee to consolidate the contents of the feedback received from the Alumnae with a view to submitting the proposals to the Higher-ups and the responsible H.R. concerned for the desired improvement in the following parameters:
  - That the proposal for the necessary changes for improvement in framing the syllabi encompassed in the framework of the curriculum in vogue should enable the students to face the competitive examinations without any difficulty. As such, chapters to be included keeping in view of the Competitive Exams are submitted to the university authorities for their kind perusal and consideration.
  - That the Library services need an improvement with source of latest information by way of providing books, journals, magazines, newspapers and competitive exams materials to be in the reach of the students to equip themselves with the current trends of updating the knowledge relevant to various kinds of academic, recruitment and competitive examinations. The Department of Library Information Science is intimated to this extent.
  - That the Laboratory facilities need vehement improvement in terms of infrastructure with the updated expertise in the fields concerned to give an impetus to the future research in the subject by the students who ever are interested in this direction. All the Heads of the Departments of Science Subjects are informed to prepare the list of requirements in this direction for providing the facilities at the earliest in consultation with the Higher Authorities concerned.
  - That the efficiency of teaching standards of the different subject teachers may be kept in pace with the emerging changes in the field of teaching –learning process in their subjects concerned and for which Refresher Courses may be facilitated in frequent intervals for renewed teaching methodologies for the benefit of the students.

- ➤ Action Taken Report: The Academic Staff Council together with all the Teachers have resolved under the chairmanship of the Principal and the IQAC Committee to consolidate the contents of the feedback received from the parents with a view to submitting the proposals to the Higher-ups and the responsible H.R. concerned for the desired improvement in the following parameters:
  - That the Laboratories of Science Subjects are witnessed to be falling short of certain equipment concerned in respect of administering experiments to be performed by the students. As such, the Department Heads are instructed to submit the equipment required to fill in the gap witnessed to facilitate students accordingly.
  - That the quality of teaching on the part of the teachers is understood to have fallen a prey to the necessity of enriching the content inclusive of the latest innovations crept in from time to time. As such, the faculty is advised through a special orientation to take up research publications and programmes of research for Doctoral Degrees which are anticipated to update their knowledge base.
  - That the syllabus in vogue is witnessed to be not befitting enough to make the students face the competitive examinations at ease. As such, content proposals for inclusion of needed syllabus contents are submitted to the university authorities for their perusal and consideration.



- > Action Taken Report: The Academic Staff Council together with all the Teachers have resolved under the chairmanship of the Principal and the IQAC Committee to consolidate the contents of the feedback received from the students with a view to submitting the proposals to the Higher-ups and the responsible H.R. concerned for the desired improvement in the following parameters:
  - ✓ That the students felt the presence of reference books and academic textbooks may please be made available in the college library is addressed in the meeting thus held in the presence of the Librarian and the teachers handed over the complete lists of the textbooks concerned to the Department of Library. Fortunately, the District Collector provided three lakh rupees worth books to the library which sufficed the need of the students' reflection in this regard.
  - ✓ That the syllabi found for each of the U.G. Programmes is felt to have fallen short in order to combat with the demands of the competitive, academic and recruitment examinations for want of missing certain chapters of content. As such, the Staff Council held a meeting with the teachers and obtained data from the students to look into for onward submission to the University Authorities for examining the issue and do the needful because the Curriculum is designed and circulated by the University to one and all affiliated colleges.


