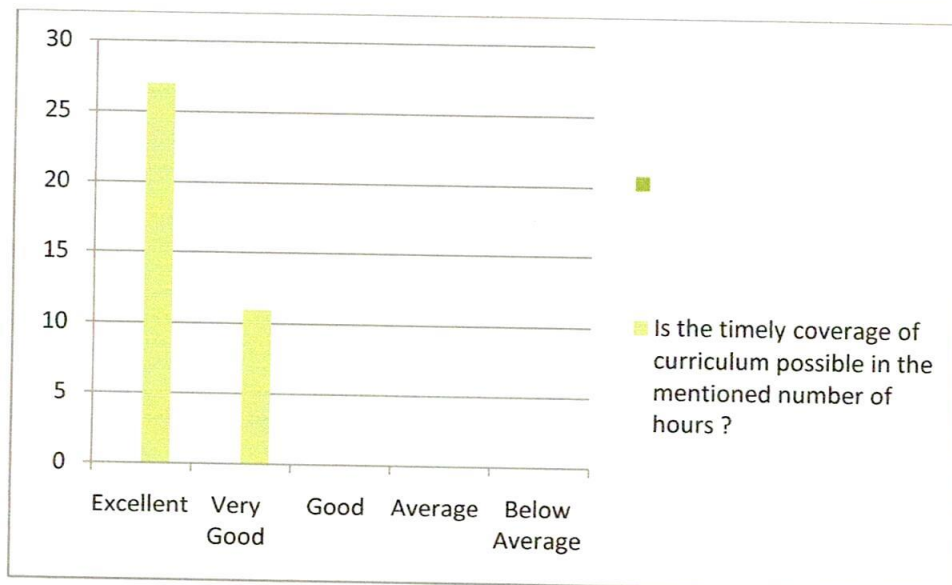
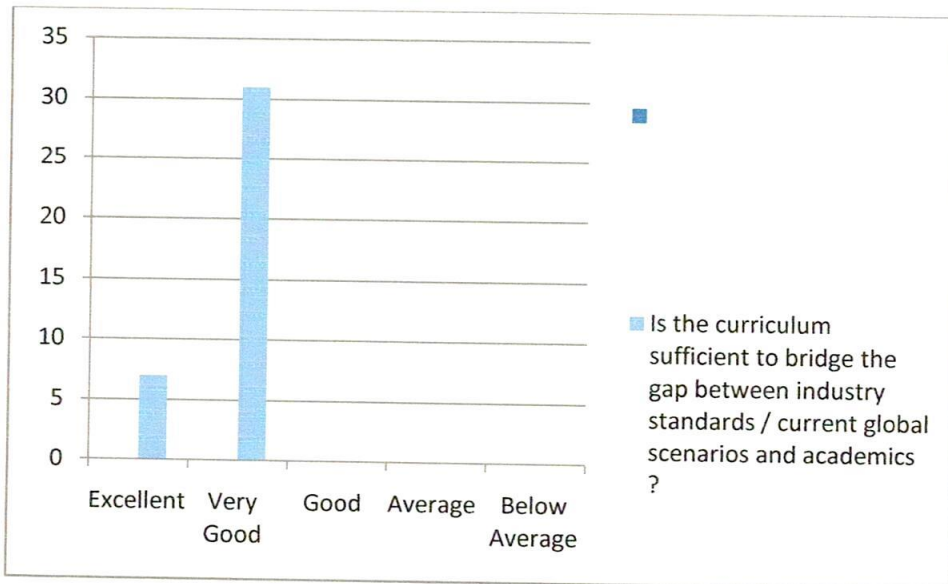
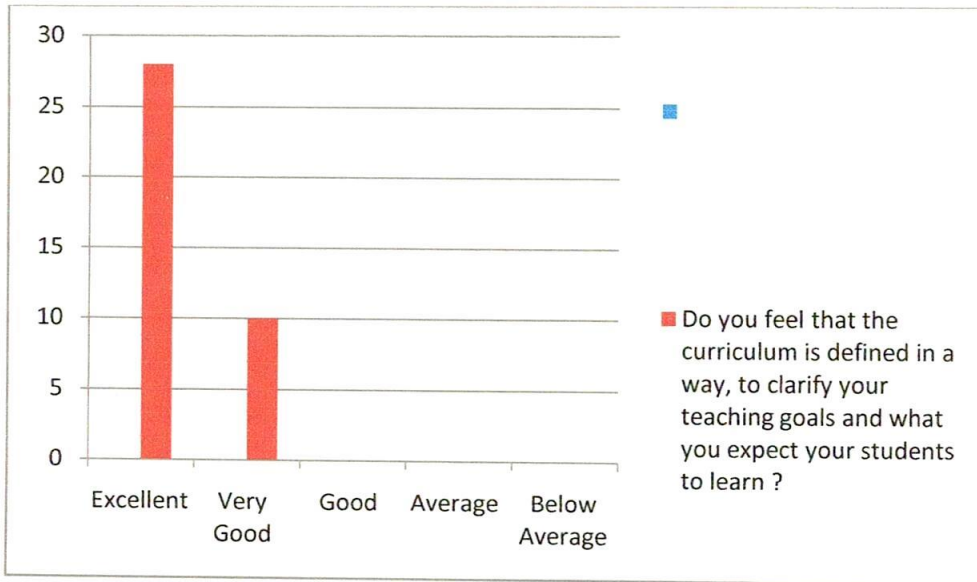
## FEEDBACK PROCESS: 2018-2019

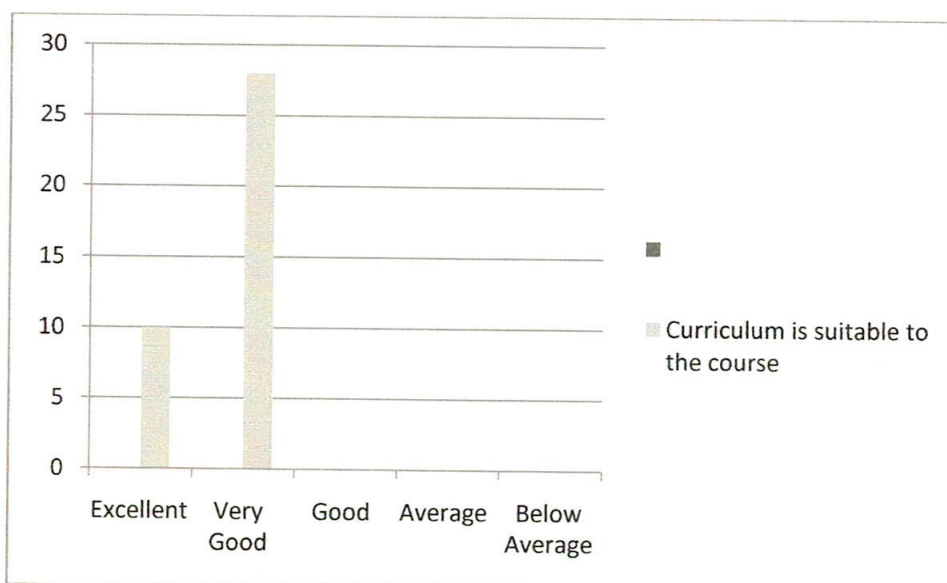
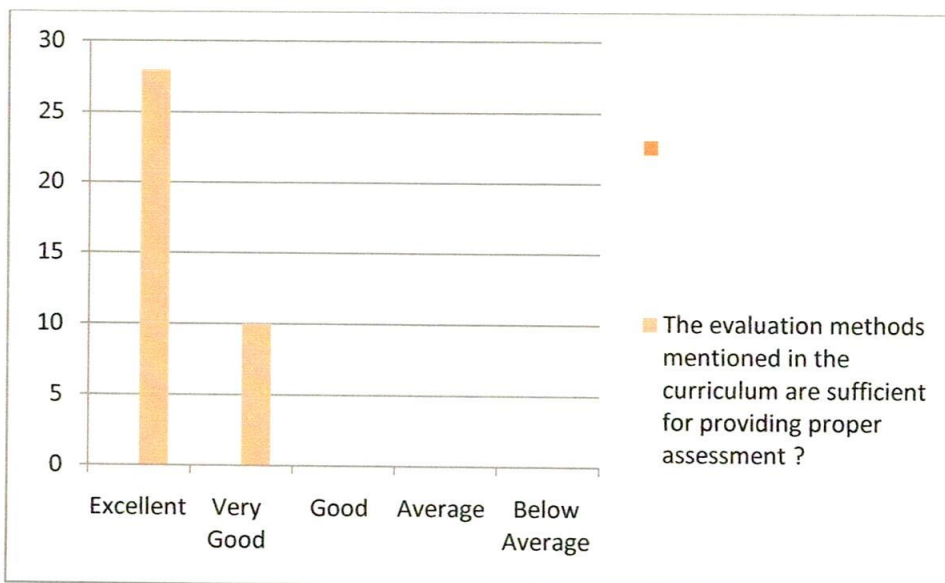
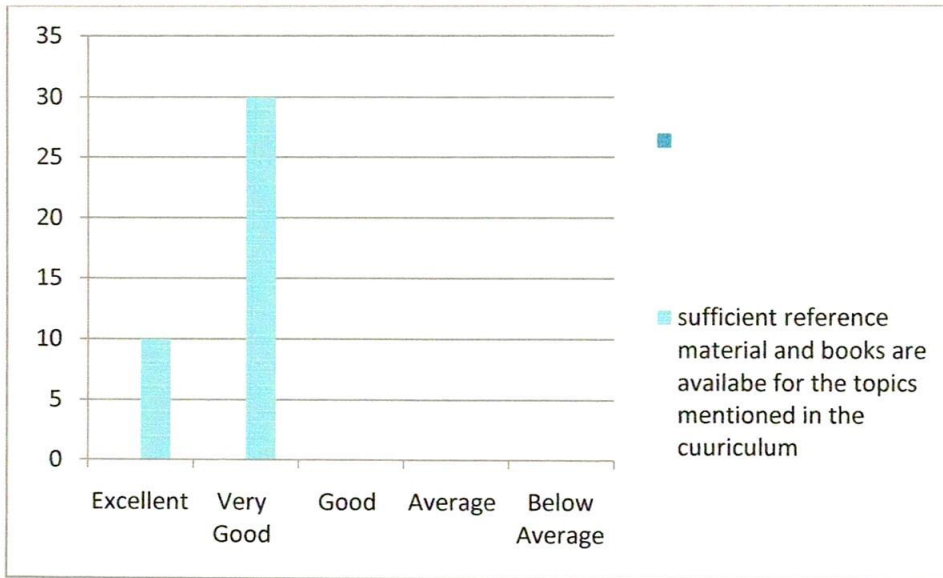

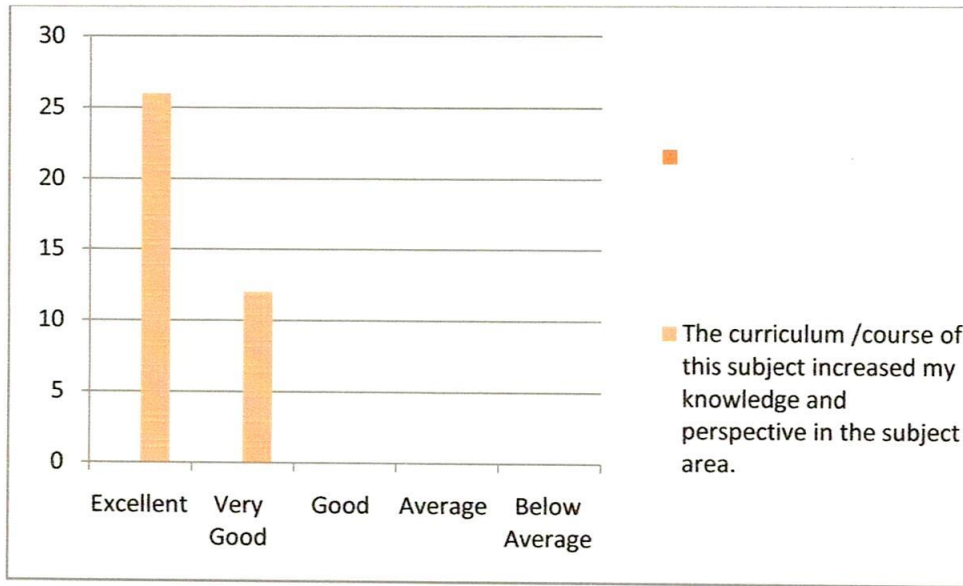
### 2018-19 Faculty feedback Analysis on Curriculum.

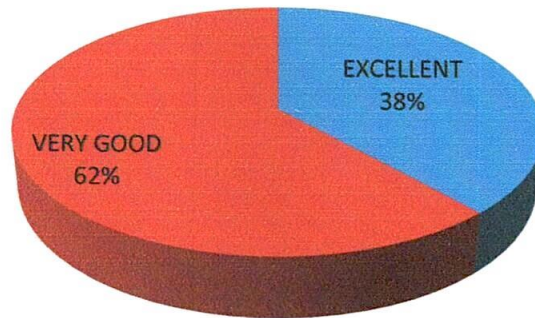


## STUDENT FEEDBACK ANALYSES 2018-19

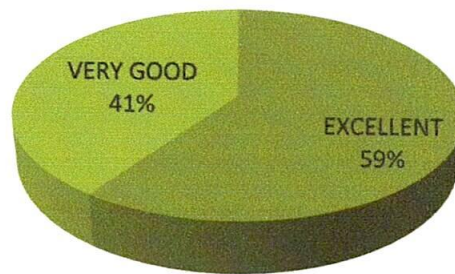
- ❖ Student feedback analysis has been carried out according to the standard questionnaire, and it is found that the responses are ranging from excellent to good.

## ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

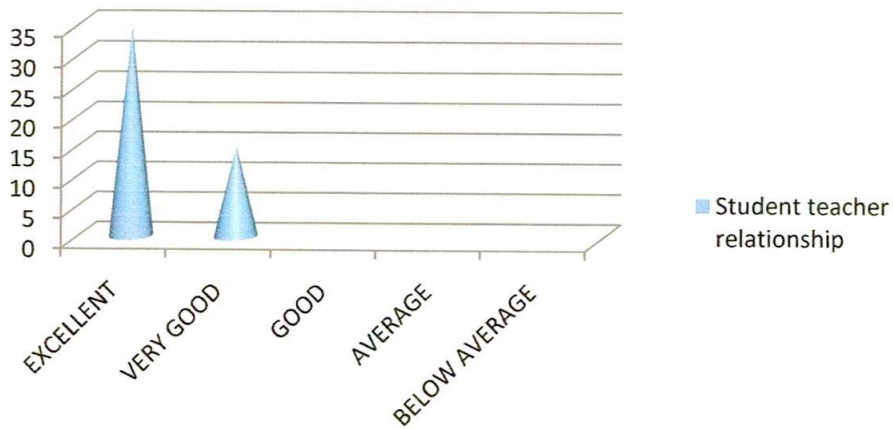
- ✚ Alumni feedback has been received from the members of alumni who are working in various fields and it is found that their responses are ranging from excellent to good.
