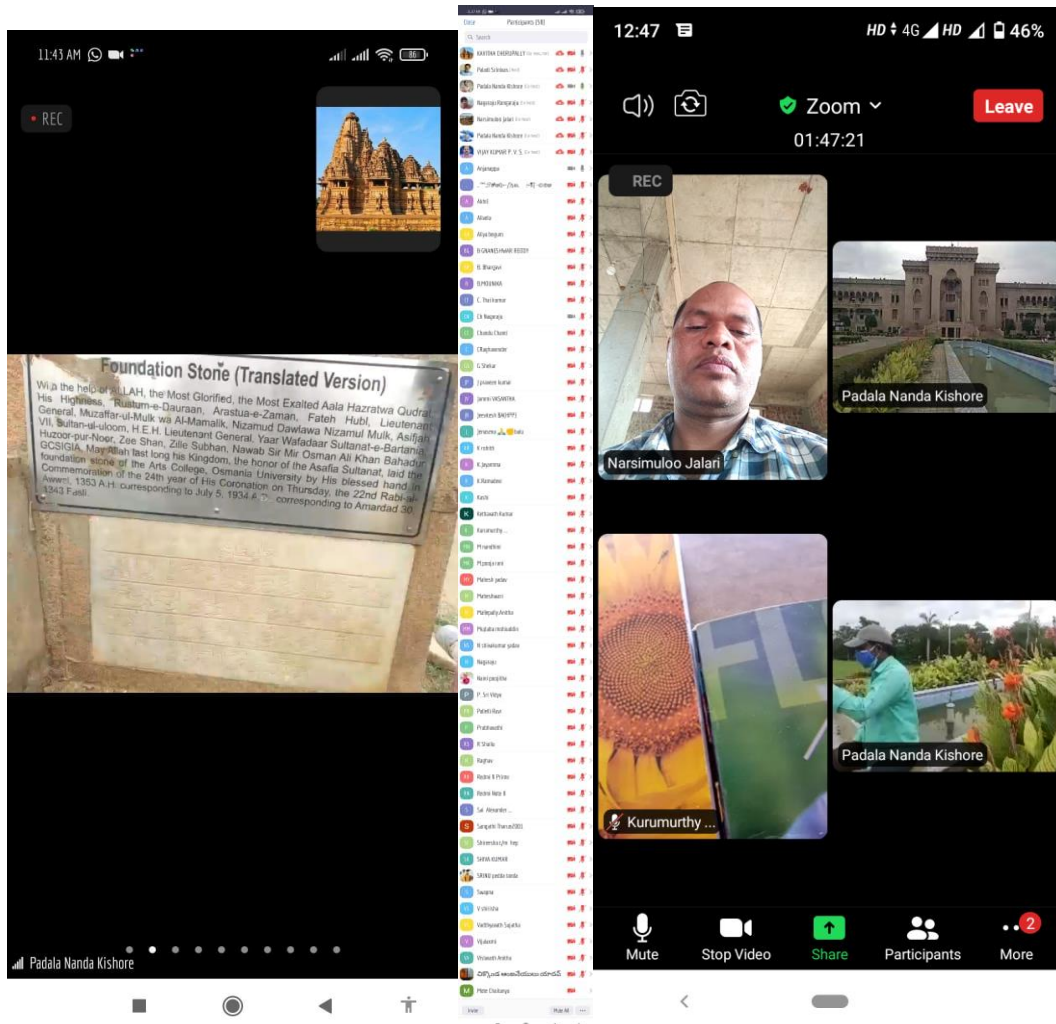

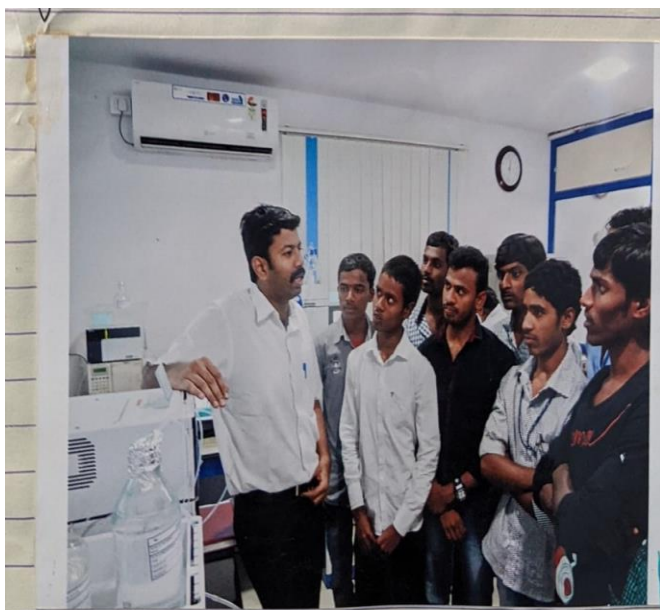



Initially the department has outsourced the Assaying work to professional assayers NCML during incurring monthly expenditure Rs, 72000/-per month with a view to create awareness among the staff and traders for its utilization for period of six (6)months. Later on the staff of AMC got trained and assaying continued for assaying activities. A separate lab was created for this purpose with required equipments including computer, printer for uploading the results.
