National Forest Policy of India envisages a minimum of 33% of the total geographical area under forest / tree cover to maintain environmental stability and ecological balance; that are vital for sustenance of all life-forms, human, animal and plants. Telangana Ku HarithaHaaram, a flagship programme of the Telangana Government envisages to increase the present 24% tree cover in the State to 33% of the total geographical area of the State. The thrust areas to achieve the above are two-fold; one, initiatives in notified forest areas, and the other, initiatives in areas outside the notified forest areas. The first objective is sought to Telangana Ku Haritha Haaram, a flagship programme of the Telangana Government envisages to increase the present 24% tree cover in the State to 33% of the total geographical area of the State. The thrust areas to achieve the above are two-fold; one, initiatives in notified forest areas, and the other, initiatives in areas be achieved by a multi-pronged approach of rejuvenating degraded forests, ensuring more effective protection of forests against smuggling, encroachment, fire, grazing and intensive soil and moisture conservation measures following the watershed approach. Major fillip is sought to be given to Social Forestry for achieving the second objective. In the areas outside the notified forest, massive planting activities will be taken up in areas such as; road-side avenues, river and canal bank, barren hill, tank bunds and foreshore areas, institutional premises, religious places, housing colonies, community lands, municipalities, industrial parks, etc.

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Based on the above importance, the NSS units and NCC of this college started TelanganakuHaritha Haram in the premises of college by involving students. Guests explained the importance of the plantations. The Chief Guest and other guests planted various types of plants. Our guests have also explained about the importance of management and watering of the plantations. Our principal also taught us how to plant them and then they watered the plants. The Guests and Our College Principal and Volunteers planted several Saplings and then watered the saplings. An Awareness Rally was conducted by NSS Volunteers. In this Program NSS Program Officers and Staff members are involved.

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
HARITHAHARAM COMPETITIONS <u>DATE: 20-07-2017</u> <u>NSS Unit -III</u>

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

The holy site of Tirumalaiah Gutta is situated close to Wanaparty town on a hill in the forest. Hindus observe the holy month of Sravana Masam, which began on August 12 and ended on September 9, as a sacred period. Devotees come to this temple and offer prayers to god every Saturday during this month. All of the pooja materials are carried by the devotees in plastic bags, and after the pooja is finished, the devotees discard the plastic bags into the forest, where they pile up and take many years to decompose. These plastic bags are being eaten by forest animals as well, which is dangerous for the animals.

In this regard, NSS Unit III, the Eco club, and Association for Biodiversity Conservation and Development organization collaborated to conduct awareness campaigns on the dangers of plastic. At the temple's entrance, volunteers took the plastic bags left behind by worshippers and replaced them with cloth bags donated by local contributors. DR. A.P.J. ABDUL KALAM BIRTH ANNIVERSARY 15-9-2020

Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam (15 October 1931 - 27 July 2015) was an Indian aerospace scientist and statesman who served as the 11th President of India from 2002 to 2007. He was born and raised in Rameshwaram, Tamil studied physics and aerospace engineering. He spent the next four decades as a scientist and science administrator, mainly the Defense at Research and Development Organization (DRDO) and Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) and was intimately involved in India's civilian space programme and military missile development efforts. He thus came to be known as the Missile Man of India for his work on the development of ballistic missile and launch vehicle technology. He also played a pivotal organizational, technical, and political role in India's Pokhran-II nuclear tests in 1998, the first since the original nuclear test by India in 1974.

Kalam was elected as the 11th president of India in 2002 with the support of both the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party and the then-opposition Indian National Congress. Widely referred to as the "People's President", he returned to his civilian life of education, writing and public service after a single term. He was a recipient of several prestigious awards, including the Bharat Ratna, India's highest civilian honour. While delivering a lecture at the Indian Institute of Management Shillong, Kalam collapsed and died from an apparent cardiac arrest on 27 July 2015, aged 83. Thousands, including national-level dignitaries, attended the funeral ceremony held in his hometown of Rameswaram, where he was buried with full state honors.

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



A meeting was conducted under the chairmanship of Dr.Appiya Chinnamma. She said that Human beings should be discrete from wild animals. Dr.NagaRaju Scientist, BSI, Dr.Ravikiran Scientist, BSI, and Dr.Prasad from Yogi Vemana University are speakers in this program. The speakers educated and motivated the students on wildlife.

Dr. Nagaraju, a scientist at BSI, stated that human activities endanger animals in two ways: by destroying and harming the habitats where they dwell and by exploiting them in ways that are not sustainable.

Dr. Ravikiran, a scientist with the BSI, lectured that wildlife is a vital component of biodiversity and is vital to both human health and the health of the entire world. Every macro- and microorganism, whether it is an animal, a plant, or a fish, has an impact on every other organism in the interrelated ecological system in which we live. The natural environment of any creature can be changed without causing a dynamo effect; therefore the life cycles of many species are threatened by an ecological system that is out of equilibrium.

Dr.Prasad from Yogi Vemana University expressed that Humans can benefit from about 40,000 different types of animals, fungi, and plants. Our medicines come from wild plants, more than a third of them.
