

**Scholarships:** The College provides scholarships to the eligible candidates of Schedule Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Backward Classes through sanctions from Social Welfare Department, Government of Telangana and other scholarships. The eligible candidates have to apply within the stipulated date. Fee concession for BC/ST/SC candidates will be given only on submission of Caste and Income Certificate. From M.R.O. Otherwise they have to pay fee in full on par with OC Candidates. To be eligible for scholarship the income of the Parent/guardian should not exceed One Lakh per Annum:

**Computers:** The College has two well equipped computer laboratories to provide training in Computer Classes at the UG level. **Semester System of Instruction & Evaluation:**

- There will be two semesters in each academic year.
- There will be final examination at the end of each semester.
- If a student has failed, he / she is allowed to appear during the next semester.
- Improvement is allowed in the next immediate semester exams.
- There will be detention at the end of the second and fourth semester. If a student fail is more than 50% of the total papers of first and second semester, he will be detained at the end of Second Semester, if a student fails in more than 50% of first, second, third and fourth semester put together he will be detained at the end of fourth semester.

**Internal Assessment:** Students are required to write two Internal Assessment examinations in each paper in each subject as a part of continuous Internal Evaluation. The Maximum marks in each paper 15 Marks and 5 Marks for Assignment. The student has to write compulsory Two Internal Assessments in each paper and the average of the two internal exams will be taken into account for the end examination result.

**End Exam Evaluation (Each Semester):** The Maximum mark in the theory paper in each subject in each paper is 80 marks (end exam, each semester) and the Internal Assessment is 20 marks. The student has to get a minimum of 40 out of 100, (32 + 8) to pass in each paper of the examination.

6. The students are informed to take enough Xerox copies of all the Certificates for their personal use before submitting to the College their Certificates. The College will not provide the Original TC or any other original certificates after admission for making Xerox copies.
7. Students from other state Board have to produce 'No objection Certificate from Satavahana University at the time of admission.
