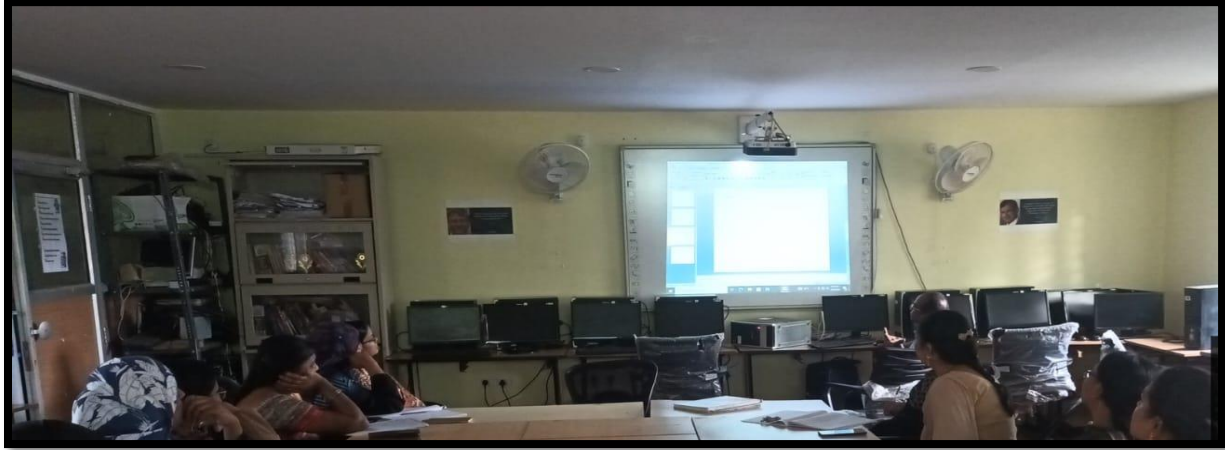
DAY-1:

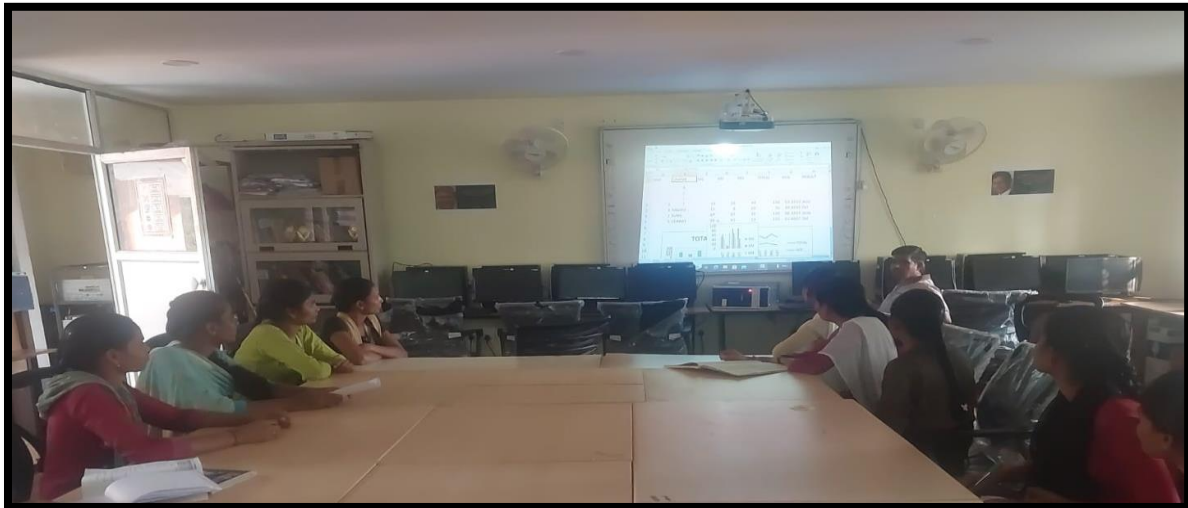
DAY-2:

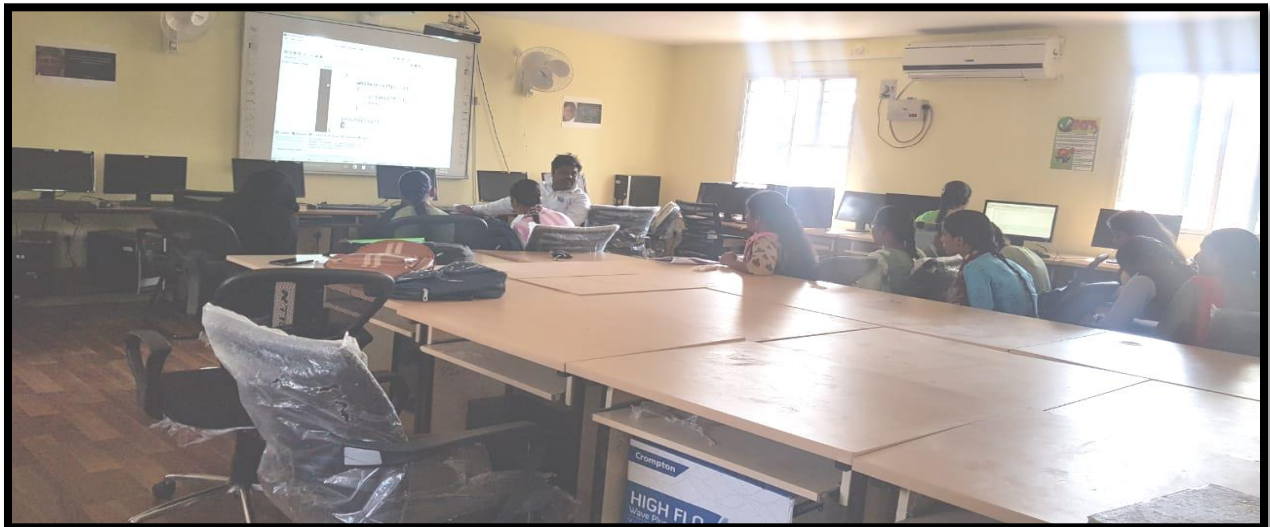
DAY-4:

DAY-5:

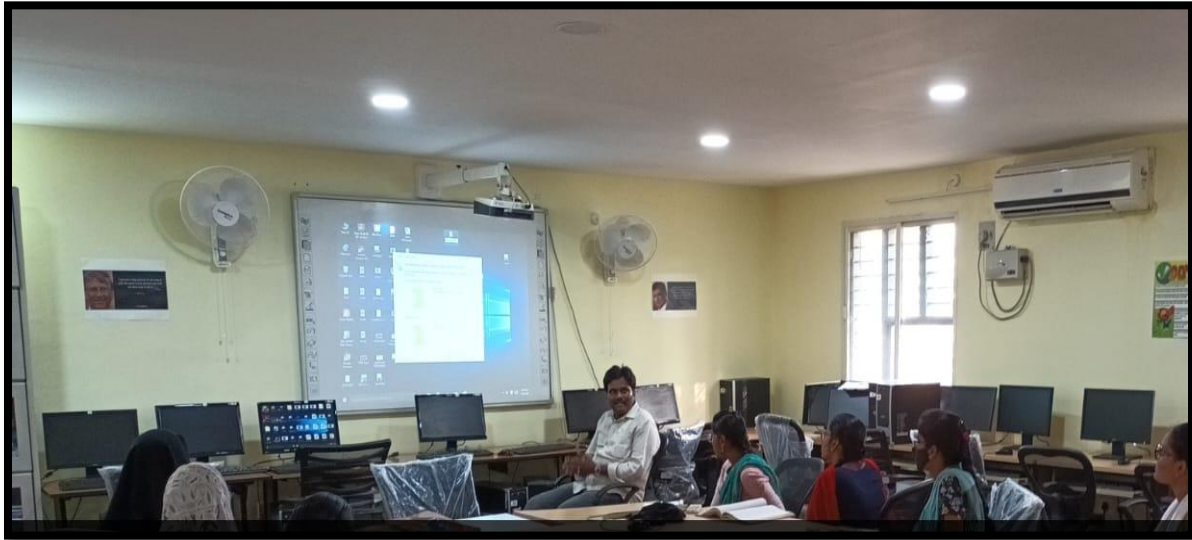
