



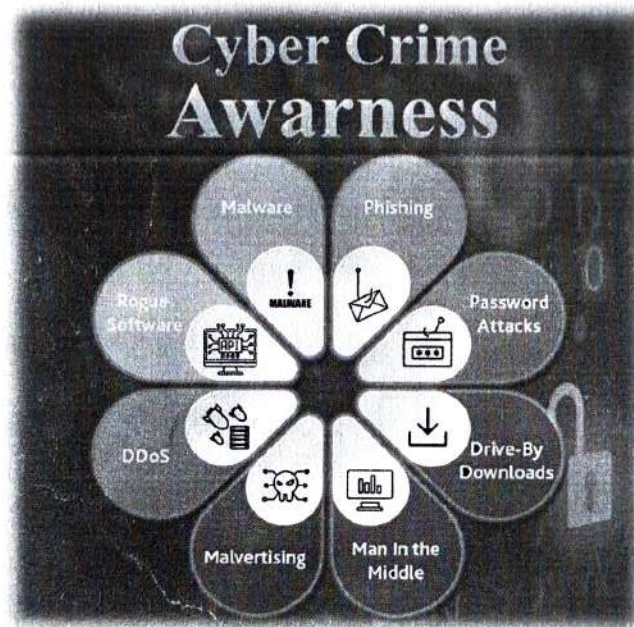

**REPORT
ON
CYBER CRIME AWARENESS PROGRAMME**

Cybersecurity Awareness Program is a national public awareness effort aimed at increasing the understanding of cyber threats and empowering students to be safer and more secure online. Cybersecurity is a shared responsibility and we each have a part to play. When we all take simple steps to be safer online – at home, in the workplace, and in our communities – it makes using the Internet a more secure experience for everyone.

NSS Units of Tara Government College(A), Sangareddy organized an Awareness program on **Cyber Crime, Eve Teasing & POSCO Act** with the help of **SHE TEAM & Sangareddy Town Police Station** with the prior permission of the principal on **25-04-2023**. The main aim of this program is to give awareness on cybercrimes and the further consequences.

The chief guest **Sreedhar Reddy**, Circle Inspector & SHO of Sangareddy town police station said “Creating an awareness on cybercrimes among students is of crucial importance. We need to substantially improve our knowledge regarding internet safety and issues of illegal internet usage to prevent cybercrimes. Most crimes in recent days have been committed using computers as a tool.” He further added that while some criminal cases have come to light, many have not.

T. Naresh Sub Inspector of Police said that these crimes occur not only in our states but also at national and international levels. He expressed his regret that young people are behind such criminal activities. He also said if anyone suffered from this type of crime to complain 1098 helpline within 24 hours. He motivated the students to protect themselves from cybercrime. To stop the spread of Cyber

Crime and to safeguard the interest of people the government has made several laws related to Cyber Crimes. Also, these laws serve as protection against Cyber Crime. Apart from that, the government has also introduced cyber cells in police stations to counter the problem of Cyber Crime as fast as they can.

Students were also made aware of different types of cybercrimes such as email bombing, hacking, salami, phishing, identity fraud, ATM skimming, web banking, cyberstalking, online lottery fraud, etc.

Principal, Dr. K.S.S. Ratna Prasad in his presidential address said that in several cases, phone calls & messages of students are recorded, and they are blackmailed based on these records and video footage. He advised students to refrain from sending photographs to strangers on social networks and sharing personal ideas with them, as it could get them into trouble.

SHE TEAM SI G. Mogulaiah addressed the gathering about the importance of the POSCO Act and not to trouble any girl/woman. It is illegal and criminal activity.
