PEER TEAM REPORT ON INSTITUTIONAL ACCREDITATION OF GOVERNMENT DEGREE COLLGE, MULUGU, DISTRICT, WARANGAL, A.P

The Government Degree College, Mulugu, Warangal District, Andhra Pradesh, was established in the year 1999 to meet the educational requirements of the tribal region in Andhra Pradesh. The college is located in a predominantly economically backward area comprising tribal agricultural labourers. The college is located 45km away from Hanamakonda and it is also 3 km away from Mulugu.

The college is spread over an area of 13.30 acres with built in area of 2379 square meters. The total strength of the college is 1452 of which 63% is made up of boys while girls constitute 37% of the total. The break-up of the students is that 13.15% belong to the SC, 22.4% ST, 55.9% BC and the remaining belongs to other castes. As of today, the college is affiliated to Kakatiya University and is in the process of acquiring recognition under sections 2(F) and 12(B) of the UGC Act. The total strength of the college faculty is made up of 22 permanent, six teachers on a temporary basis and 11 non-teaching staff are on a permanent basis, while one nonteaching staff is on a temporary basis. According to the data provided by the college, the unit cost of education is Rs 3177/-(which includes salary component) and Rs1166/-(without salary component). Presently, the college offers seven programmes by way of traditional courses at the under graduate level and certificate courses in English and Computers. The total number of working days in the academic

year 2005-06, is 229 out of which 181 constitute effective teaching days.
