EMPLOYERS FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2020-2021

Our college believes that the performance of the college is fundamentally dependent on effective learning outcomes. Feedback Mechanism is an essential and effective tool to know whether the college is delivering on imparting quality education. To impart Quality Education, IQAC developed a Feedback Mechanism and framework for its analysis. There is a formal Procedure for collecting and evaluating feedback. Feedback Forms are circulated to all the teachers at the end of academic year /each semester. Duly filled feedback forms are to be forwarded to the IQAC for analysis.

The feedback collected from employer is based on 20 questions divided based on four criteria which includes Professional competence, Classroom teaching performance, co-curricular and extracurricular activities and General and college development. The feedback collected is analyzed on a five point scale ranging from excellent to satisfactory. 91 to 100% is given excellent, 81 to 90 is very good and 71 to 80 is good.

The analysis represents 90-99% of the teachers as very good. The overall opinion for all the teachers given by the employer is very good and only 5-10% teachers are given good with. The Feedback analysis report is forwarded to the Principal for further process and action.
