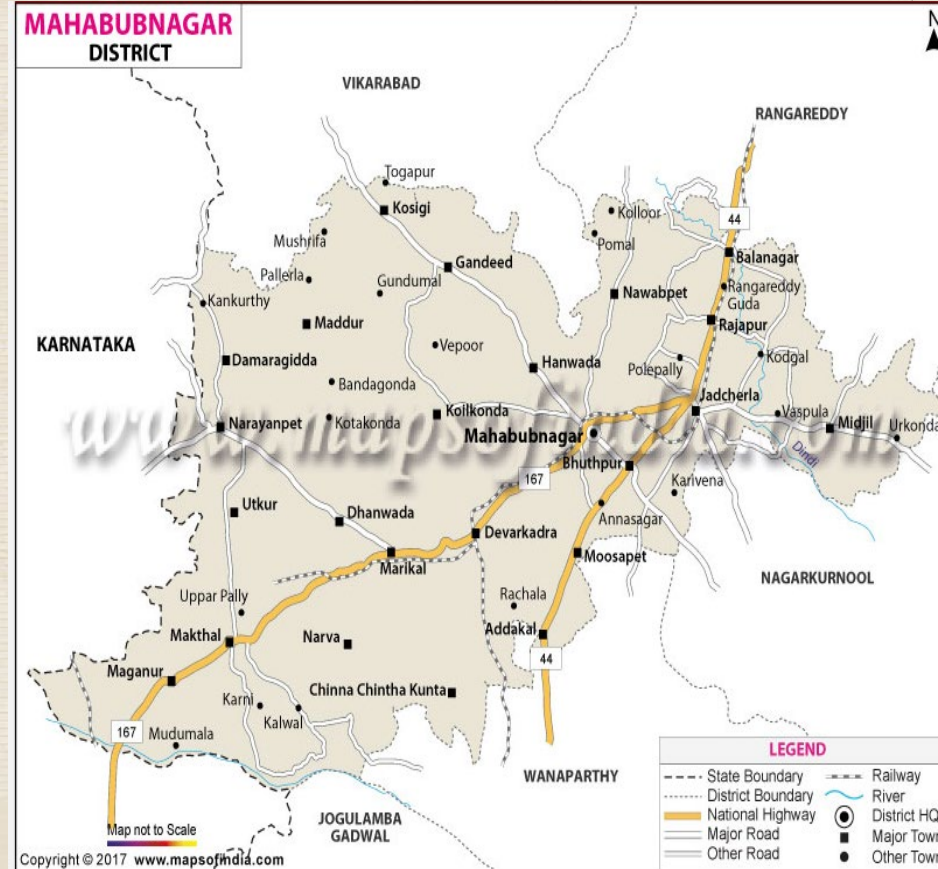

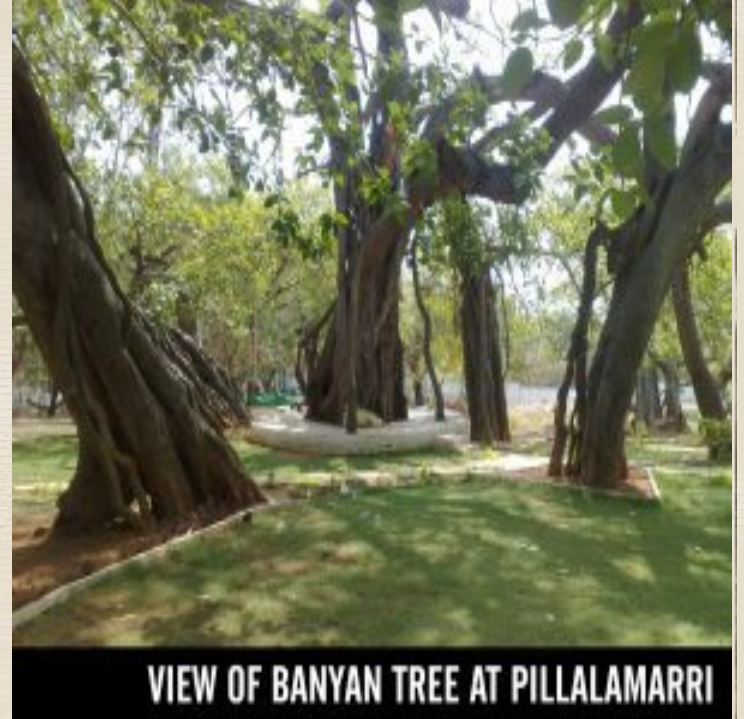
# MBNR Famous Places

## Pillala Marri Tree – 700 year old

The most interesting place to see in Mahabubnagar is the famous banyan tree called Pillalamarri, which is about 4 km from the town.

It is 700 year old banyan tree and its branches extend over an area of 3 acres.

In Telugu, “Pillalu” means children & “marri” means a banyan tree. There is also an aquarium, a small zoo and an archaeological museum here. There is a boating facility in the premises of Pillalamarri available only during the rainy season.



## Sri Venkateswara Temple-Manyam Konda

Manyam Konda is located about 16 Kms from Mahaboob Nagar District head quarters towards Raichur. This is one of the important spiritual centers in Mahaboob Nagar District.

One can have a glimpse of the ancient caves where the sages / gurus did meditation over here. The main deity of this place is Sri Venkateswara Swamy and it is a Harihara Kshetra.

This temple is located in a cave and it is perched on the top of three hills.



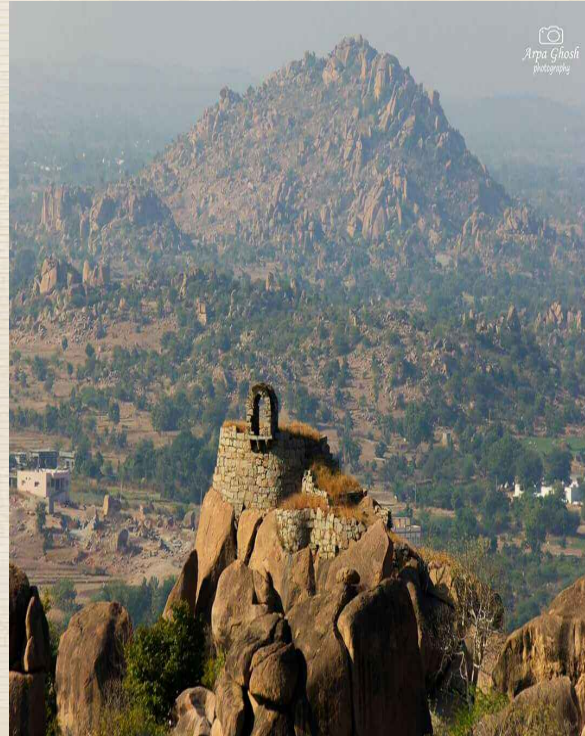

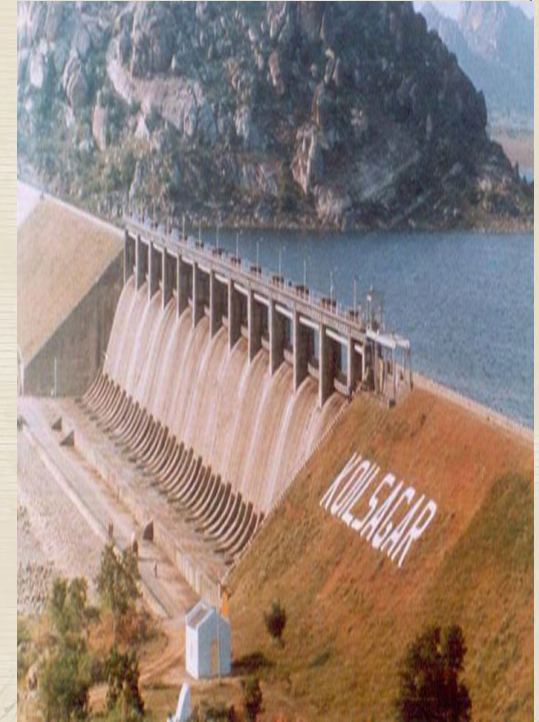

## Criterion 1 - Curricular Aspects

- The Palamuru University prescribed Curriculum is followed.
  - Implementation of curriculum is as per ALMANAC issued by Palamuru University.
  - Academic Calendar issued by Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Telangana State (CCE-TS).
  - Based on above guidelines, The Principal constitute various committees by nominating the faculty in the first or second week after reopening of the college.
  - Principal conduct meeting with a team consisting of IQAC, Academic coordinators and HODs of all the departments to prepare the college annual academic calendar in line with Almanac & CCE-TS Academic Calendar.

- HOD's convene meeting with its department and prepare Annual action plan of department.
- Subject wise & paper wise annual curricular plan is prepared on the basis of the blue print provided by the affiliating University.
- All the teaching faculty maintain their individual teaching dairies containing the details of the individual time table, lesson plan and other curricular activities.
- The HOD's conduct the review meetings once or twice in a month in their respective departments to know the status of the completion of syllabus and to monitor the conduct of other curricular activities such as remedial coaching classes, seminars, quiz competitions, assignments, group discussions and internal exams etc.

- The Principal also conduct the review meeting (internal academic audit) along with the IQAC and academic coordinators once /twice in a month to know the status of academic activities and also verify all the academic records to confirm whether they are adhering to the annual academic curricular plan or not.
- The college also organize various programs related to the academics such as field trips, educational tours, personality development seminars, TSKC and TASK etc.
- The main aim is “empowering the rural women graduate with the tools of subject knowledge and need based educational skills to face the modern age challenges’.

## 1.3 Curriculum Enrichment

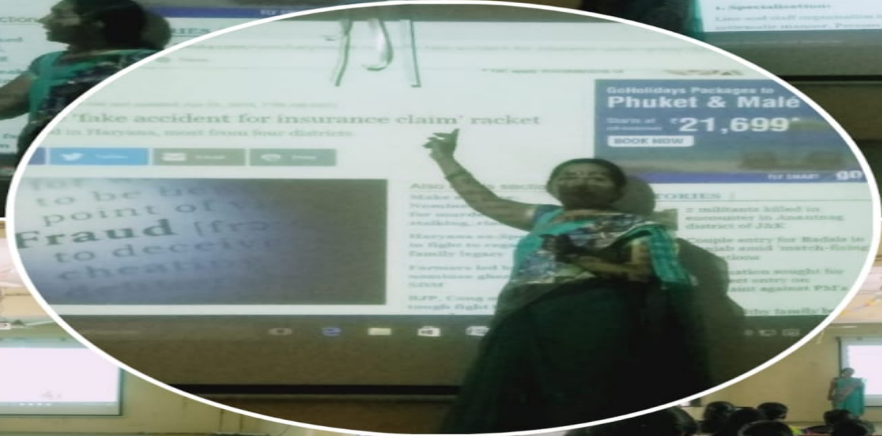
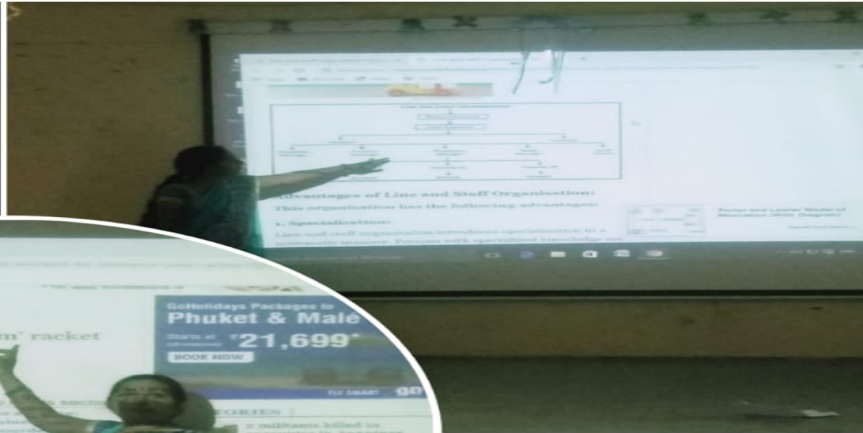
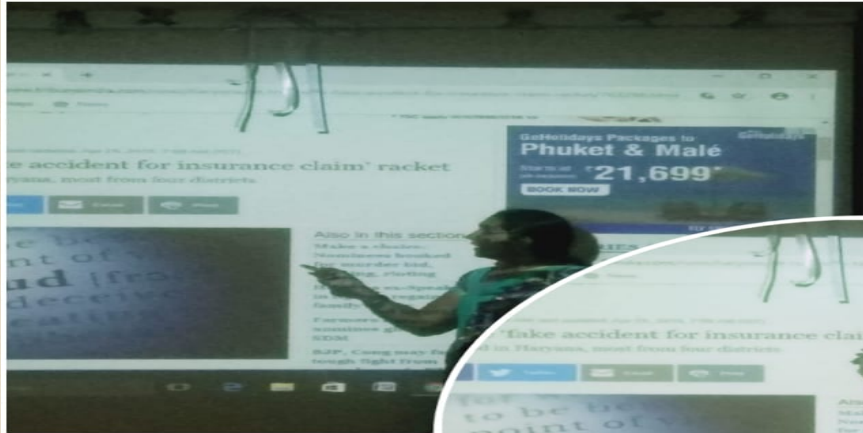
## Student Seminars,
