1.1 District profile: Wanaparthy is an Educational hub. School education is very strong with huge number of Private and Government high schools. Every mandal/ Tahasil is flourished with its own Government Junior college and also well established private Junior colleges having every year with state ranks. In this Dist 04 Govt. Degree Colleges and 09 Private Degree colleges, 04 Teacher education Colleges 02 Govt. Polytechnic College, 03 Vocational Junior Colleges and 02 ITI colleges are feather in the cap of the District.

1.2 profile of Government Degree College for women Wanaparthy :

With the holier and nobler intention of providing educational needs to the young women in this area, the Govt. Degree College for Women, Wanaparthy was established in the year 1991 under Govt. sector to cater the specific and general educational needs of the women students of Wanaparthy and surrounding villages in response to the rapid urge for higher education. The college is affiliated to Palamuru University. The college has been included under section 2 f of UGC act 1956 on 15th January 2015. Presently the institution is running B.A., B.Com. B.Sc. Programmes. A majority of the students seeking admission in this college are economically poor hailing from the downtrodden sections of the town and 24 peripheral villages. The present student strength of the college is 1270 and 90% of them being first generation literates. The college has a well planned curriculum for the all-round development of the students. In order to achieve objectives of valued based education, this college implements curriculum strictly under CBCS system designed by Palamuru University. The college has marginally supplemented and enriched the task through co-curricular, and extracurricular activities. The college extends all support services besides steering all the necessary committees and clubs for monitoring academics and administrative transactions. Volunteers of 2 NSS units shoulder the responsibility in imbibing the values of social, cultural, economic and environmental aspects. This Educational institution adopts all possible interactive institutional techniques like debates, group discussions, study projects and field trips and other activities in order to make the teaching learning process more effective. Within the constraints, the

college promotes research work by encouraging the staff to apply for minor research projects and other possible project works. A large collection of books with an internet facility in semi automated Central Library is of immense help to the learners as well as to the teachers. The college is also renowned for the activities in sports and games. The Library and Games wing are great resources of the college fulfilling mental, physical, educational and psychological relishment, enrichment and refinement. Vision Wanaparthy is well known as Educational hub. It has been a renowned learning center since days of erstwhile Samsthan under Nizams rule. The college came up with a vision and mission to catering to the needs of higher education to impart quality education to the poor, economically and socially backward sections of the society particularly to the women students. To march our college in the right direction, we have set passionately a vision mission and objectives. Our vision is to educate ----- The students to excel in all forms towards the Global needs With human touch/holistic approach.

The Govt. Degree college for women Wanaparthy was established in the academic year 1991

In the process of assessment in the National level our college has faced three cycles of NAAC peer team, the first cycle of NAAC peer team has visited in 2008 and graded with B. In the second cycle of NAAC peer team visited our college in 2015, graded B with 2.54 CGPA, and the third cycle peer team visited in 2021, graded with 2.25 CGPA. Soon after that our college got Rs. 2 crores from RUSA funds for the development of the Institution in various aspects.

At present we have 04 regular lecturers, 02 Regular Lecturer on OD basis, 12 contracts lecturers and 10 guest lecturers totally 28 teaching faculty are giving their services for the progress of the college. We have three Doctorates and three are pursuing Ph.D program, four are holding M.Phil degree. The regular lecturers have undergone several orientation programme, refresher and training courses and providing quality education to the students, we have well experienced contact faculty who have been giving their services to the students and motivating them with their quality education to achieve their goals. Some of the guest faculty though fresh in teaching field rendering their services to the students with dedication and enthusiasm.

Besides steering all the necessary committees and clubs for monitoring academic and administrative transaction the college extends all support services. The volunteers of two NSS units shoulder responsibility in inculcating the values of social, cultural, economic and environmental aspects. The

college encourages women's participation in all the institutional activities and constituted a women empowerment cell.

In order to make the teaching learning process more effective, the institution adapts all possible interactive instructional techniques like debate, group discussion, study projects and field trips.

The college has an open land of 6.25 acres, and well equipped computer lab, mana TV hall, TSKC room, NSS room, Games, Gym room, Library, JKC, Girls waiting room, Museum (Zoology Department) and Botanical garden. The college has library with large collection of books as immense to help the learners as well as teacher, the students make maximum utilization of all the facilities available in the college.

The college has an efficient internal Co-ordination mechanism helping the smooth conduct of academic and administrative matters. The College Planning and Development Council (CPDC) play an important role in guiding the college towards the right direction; the college has many committees that help in smooth running of the college. The Telangana State Knowledge Centre (TSKC) has become an important branch of learning in the College it has been training the outgoing students on the essential skills required by a graduate to get a job in the present corporate world. Each year many students selected for jobs in the campus drives organized by many MNCs.

The college has sufficient furniture's, labs and two computer Labs with a round of 80 computers, we have also TSKC lab with 30 computers, in addition 3 smart boards with projector to give the visual learning to the students, one Virtual class room to teach and learn from other colleges & also to monitor the college campus we have electronic surveillance with 16 cameras centralized the principal room. The college has many committees for the smooth functioning of the college.

In spite of having insufficient Non-teaching staff as hindrance , Management and governance are being properly executed with the assistance of teaching faculty and the available Non-Teaching staff. 3. Fund generation is not rested with the institution. However teaching learning process is observed to continue systematically with the available college funds only. 4. Retaining authority of the experienced staff members is not in the hands of the head of the institution. 5. Majority of the students are from rural background.They have low communicative skills and computer skills but the institution tries its best to better their computer and communication skills through TSKC and the Department of English.

### 4. Action taken report:

From time to time we are conducting staff meeting for every month, in that meetings we are discussing all the issues complaints raised from students community and making some resolutions to resolve the problems and the same is implemented.

### 5. Academic performance:

Regularly we conduct internal exams and semester wise exams to monitor the student progress.

Almost every department monitor and guide students in student study projects, with this our students very enthusiastically participating in district level and state level Jignasa programme which is conducted by RUSA from Commissioner of Collegiate Education.

**a. Certificate Courses:**

The college has almost all the required infrastructure including R.O. Plant, Dual desks, Digital Boards, Lab equipment, CC Cameras, Computers. But most of these are preserved and unused due to lack of rooms.
