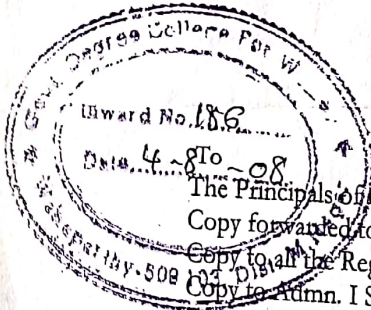

The Committee constituted vide ref 1 read, has examined and approved the the courses/intake strength in the Govt. Degree Colleges during 2018-19 and 2019-20. Vide ref 2<sup>nd</sup> read, Commissioner of Collegiate Education was delegated powers for the distribution of the sanctioned strength in the categories of Degree Lecturers, Physical Directors and Librarians among the Government Degree Colleges as per the requirement based on the student strength.

Further, it was identified that there are Government Co-Ed and Women's Degree Colleges running in the same location where the accommodation, infrastructure and teaching resources were under-utilized. The no. of students admitted in two colleges for certain courses are not even feasible as a single section.

In view of the above, for optimum utilization of the accommodation, infrastructure and teaching resources of both Co-Ed and Women's college in the same station, here after Sciences Courses shall be run in a college with established laboratories and Arts/Commerce Courses shall be run in the other college. As per the above, Posts for respective courses were allotted to respective colleges.

In view of the above, the nomenclature of the colleges is ordered to be re-designated as follows-

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education is created to promote  
Collegiate Education giving special attention to the areas located in  
Backward and Rural areas and to introduce need based courses in a  
phased manner. The reorganization of courses through G.O.Rt.No.65  
Higher Education Department dt.13-04-2018 under the chairmanship  
of Commissioner, Collegiate Education has increased the enrolment in  
131 government degree colleges by 39% i.e. the enrolment increased  
from 30,517 during 2017-18 to 42,266 \* during 2018-19.

Due to the increased admissions in UG courses by 39% during  
2018-19, it was found that the accommodation, infrastructure and  
teaching resources are not even sufficient for handling UG courses. In  
this connection, an extensive exercise was done with the Committee  
on Courses in GDCs and Principals of Govt. Degree Colleges on the  
viability of PG courses based on the availability of accommodation,  
infra structure and admissions in PG courses from last three academic  
years i.e. 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18.

Here in after, PG courses shall be offered in Arts and Commerce in the GDCs where they are viable and can afford paying guest faculties with the fee collected from the students. GDCs with required equipment in the laboratories shall only offer PG courses in Sciences to justify to run the courses.

The fee structure of PG courses in Government Degree Colleges shall be on par with the Private College fee structure in respective courses prescribed by respective universities. The PG Courses which are not viable in Govt. Degree Colleges due to above reasons shall be temporarily kept under sleeping mode and shall be offered as and when the college acquires additional accommodation, infrastructure and teaching resources. The PG Courses which are kept in sleeping mode for more than 3 years shall be referred to Government for closure.

The Principals who have requested for continuation of PG courses are hereby permitted to run the courses with the following instructions for running the courses in the academic interest of the under graduate courses-

- i. The PG courses may be run in a specific shift without any disturbance to the regular academic work of UG courses.
- ii. All the PG courses should have an intake of 60, hence Principals should make arrangement for the same in coordination with the respective universities.
- iii. The services of Regular /Contract faculty in the Government Degree Colleges should not be utilized for teaching the PG courses.
- iv. The colleges with sufficient space, infrastructure to run PG courses shall see that the fee structure of the PG courses in Government Degree Colleges shall be equal to the Private College fee structure in respective courses prescribed by respective universities.
- v. The colleges should maintain Biometric Attendance for the

students and Guest Faculty of PG Courses and the guest faculty should be paid as per the biometric attendance.

- vi. The Principals shall also see that the accommodation and infrastructure grants are procured with the support of local MLA, MP, District Collector and Philanthropists to run PG courses without any disturbance to the UG accommodation and infrastructure.

The details of the PG courses temporarily discontinued at GDC, Jadcherla, GDC(W) Nalgonda and GDC, Palem shifted to Government Degree College(W), Nagarkurnool for the Academic Year 2020-21 are as follows:
