About the College

Kakatiya Government College, Hanamkonda, was established in 1972. It is one of the premier higher education institutions in the country duly accredited by NAAC. The Kakatiya Government College is affiliated to Kakatiya University, Warangal and it has been granted 2(f) and 12(b) by the University Grants Commission. The institution offers its peerless services to the students of underprivileged families of the rural and urban areas. Spread in 5 acres of campus, it consists of 4 Blocks to accommodate around three thousand students.

The infrastructural facilities include 57 class rooms of which 50 are ICT enabled, two seminar halls, video conferencing hall, 19 well equipped laboratories, one English language lab, one TSKC lab, 5 computer labs, one digital library, etc. The college library has 21560 books as of now. The college offers 39 UG and 6 PG programmes in addition to UG programmes offered by the Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Study Centre on campus. The college has received funds and grants from funding agencies like UGC, ICSSR, DST, DBT, etc. This is the only Government degree college in the state to organize prestigious INSPIRE internship camps thrice. The college has competitive examination cell to cater to the higher educational and career needs of the students. Telangana Academy for Skill and Knowledge (TASK), a State Government official initiative, conducts various programmes like communication skills, industrial skills, class room to campus programme, arithmetic and reasoning ability development for skilling the students for making them more employable. It also conducts drives for placements.

Out of 85 permanent teachers, 39 are Ph.D. holders. Many of them have completed minor/ major research projects. Besides being actively engaged in the academic work, the staff members have also authored textbooks and have a considerable count of publications in reputed Journals. The teaching staff has been active as the members of Board of Studies/paper setters/ Examiners in Universities and Autonomous Colleges. Many of the staff members have been honoured with awards for excelling in their chosen fields, including State Best Teacher Awards

from Government of Telangana. Equipped with latest technical knowledge, they have made the ICT learning easy and prepared the required online material like videos and audios that are uploaded on the YouTube.

The Physical Education department is equipped with indoor Gym, large playground, three open gymnasia, shuttle court, volleyball court, kabaddi court and other facilities for sports and games.

The Seminar Hall and mini conference hall of the college are air-conditioned with enough seating capacity with an LCD projector and public address system.

There are two NCC and three NSS units. The college has three RO plants for safe drinking water.
