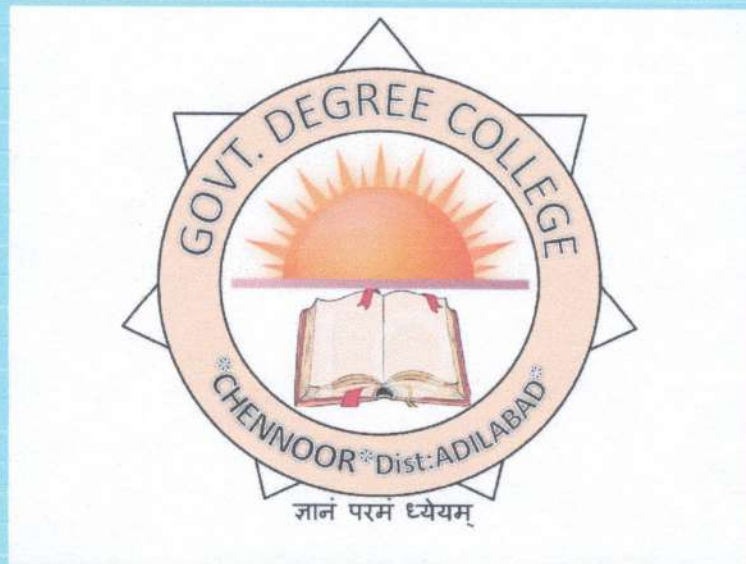


Conducted Date: Online in the month of May, 2021. The google form link is shared with various whatsapp groups and requested people who suffered to voluntarily share the data through the google form. The NSS team requested the nearby PHC to share the form to the local residents of Kishtampet village, who come for PCR test.

Outcomes:

Around 38 responses have been received during the month of May, 2021 and analysis of the data has been done which suggests that most of the affected persons are not vaccinated. As the surveyed group is small, perfect conclusions may not be reached. Yet we can say that the intensity of symptoms suffered by this group is mild except few.

Problem Encountered:

Due to reluctance of the Covid Patients to take the survey, the number of volunteers who responded is a meagre group.

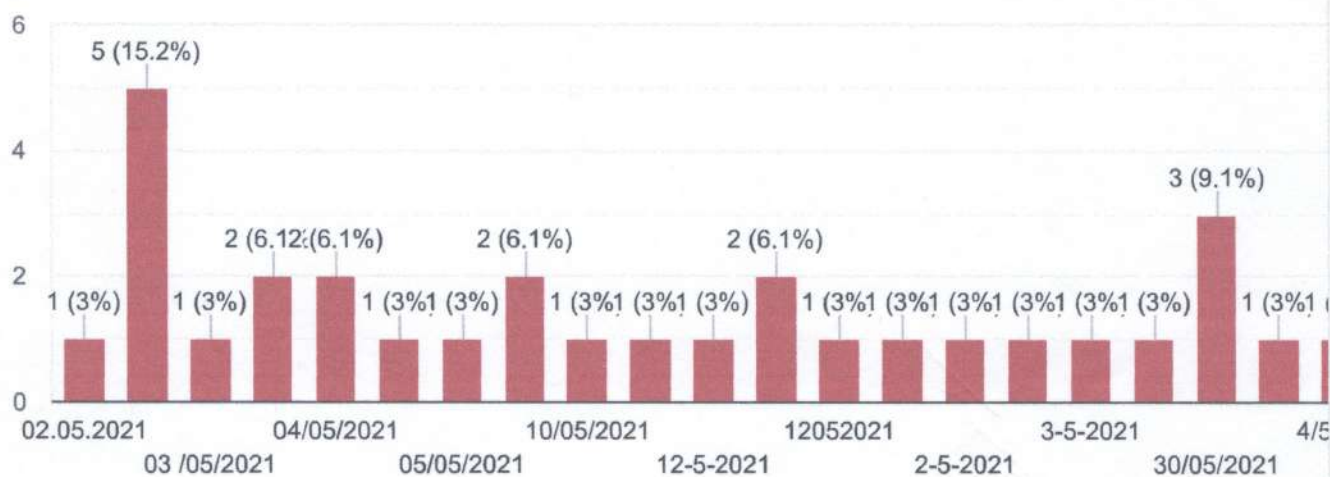

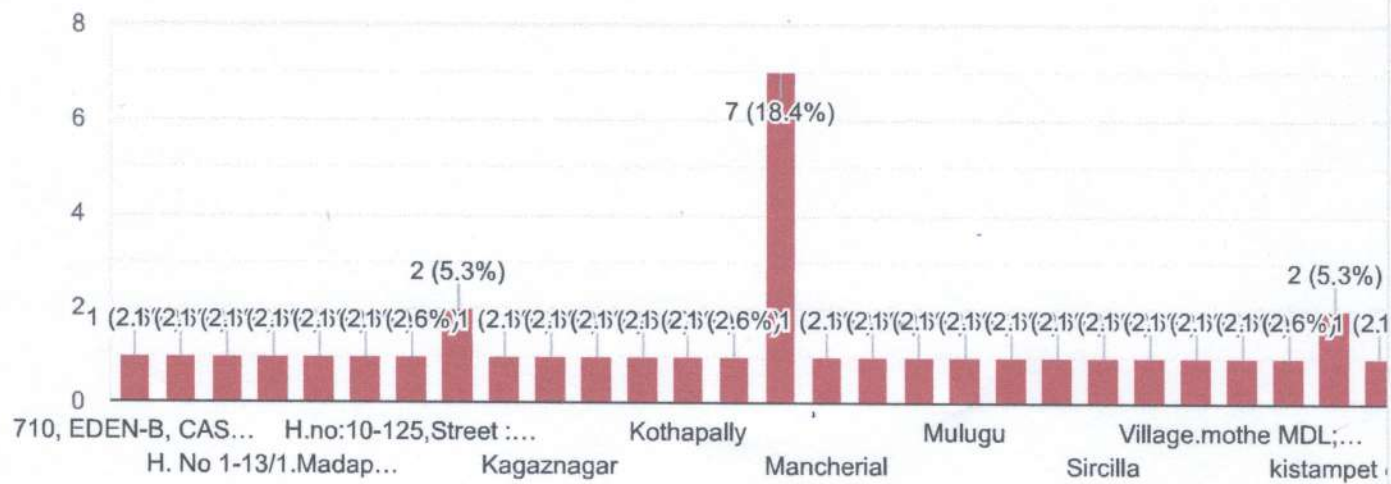

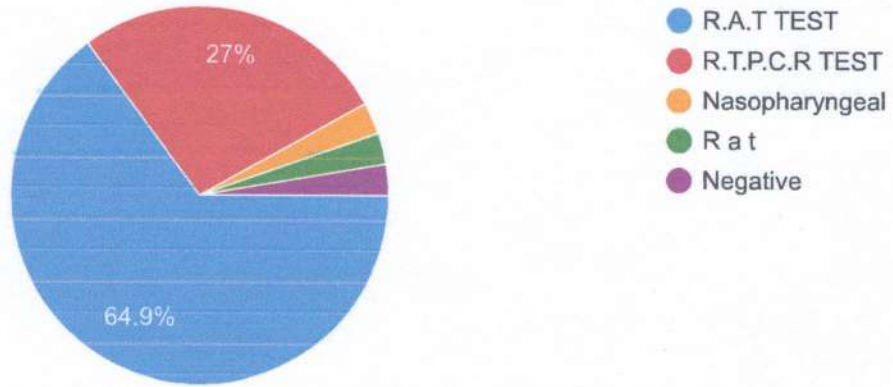

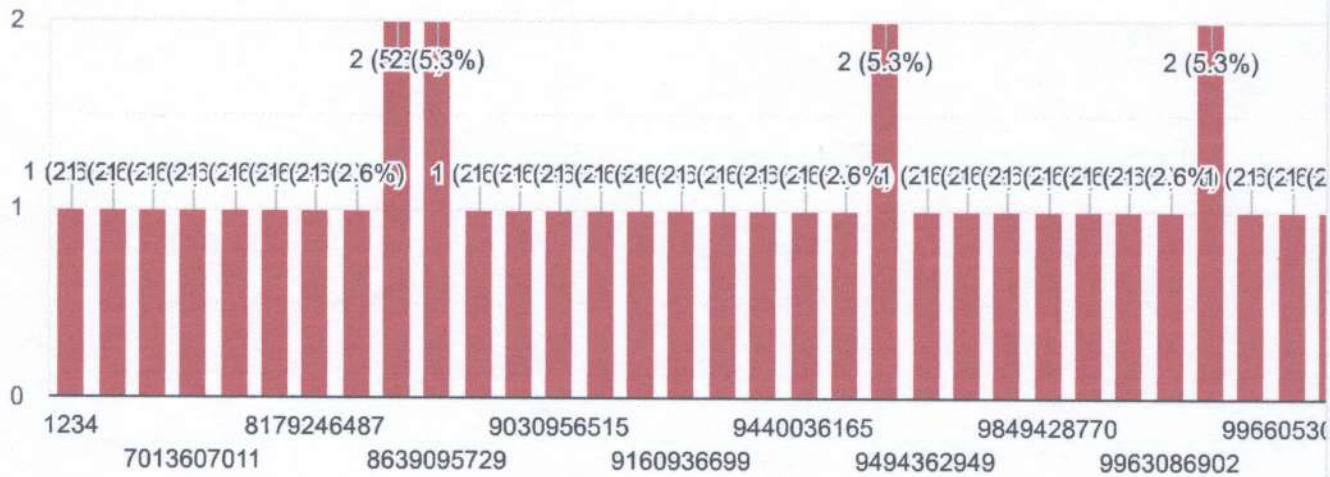

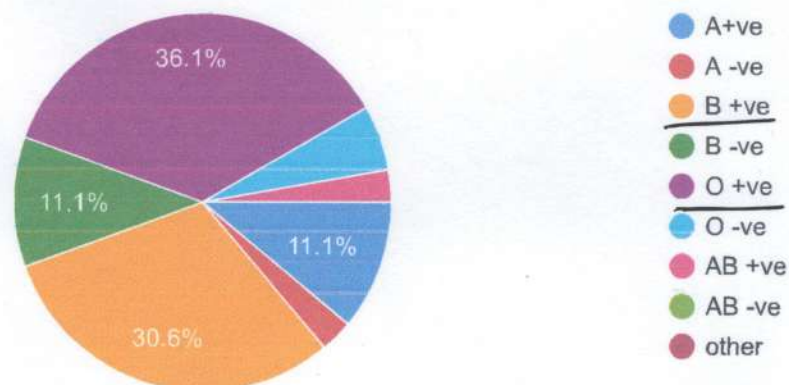

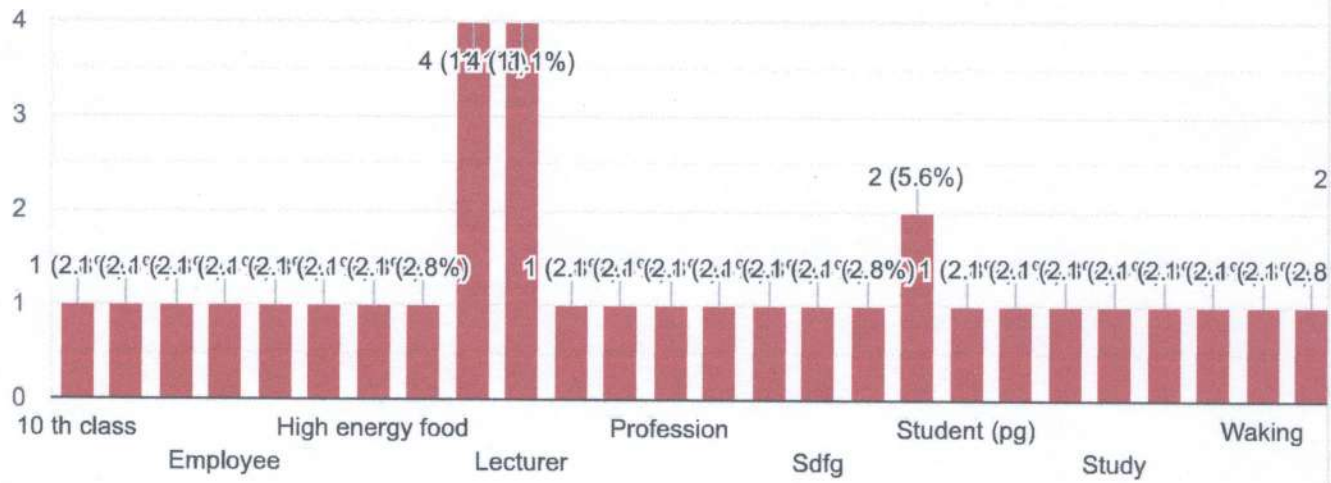

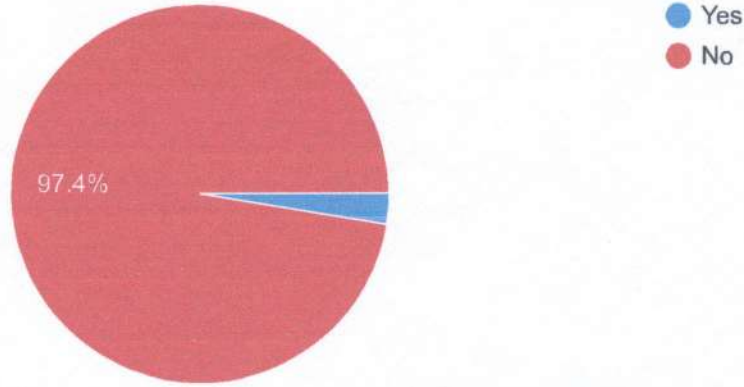

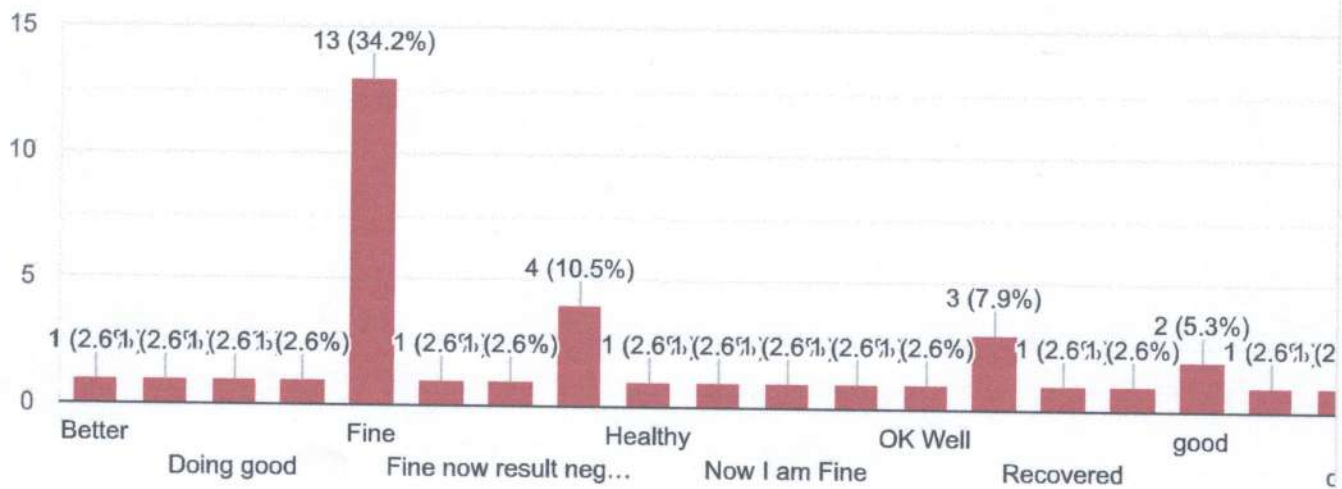

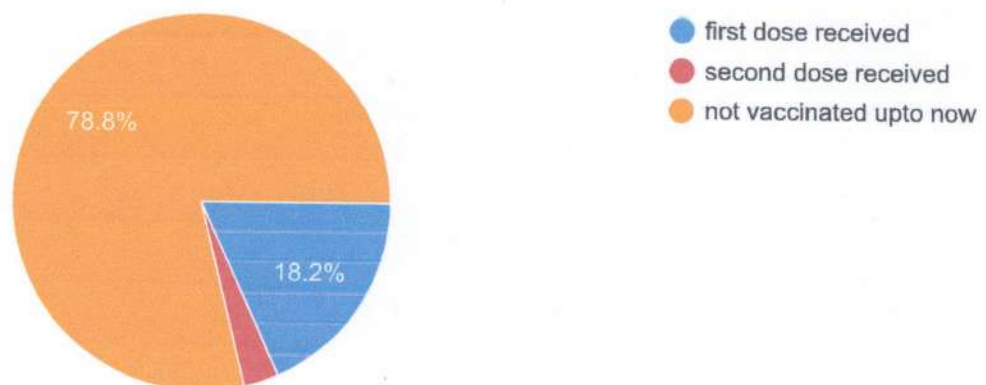

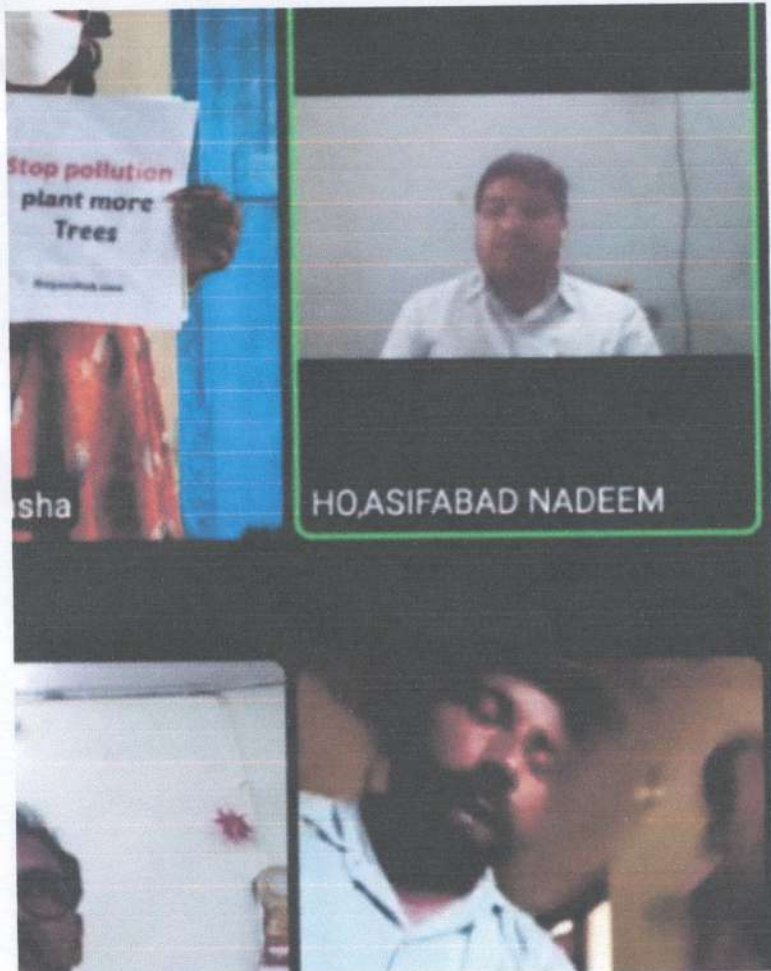
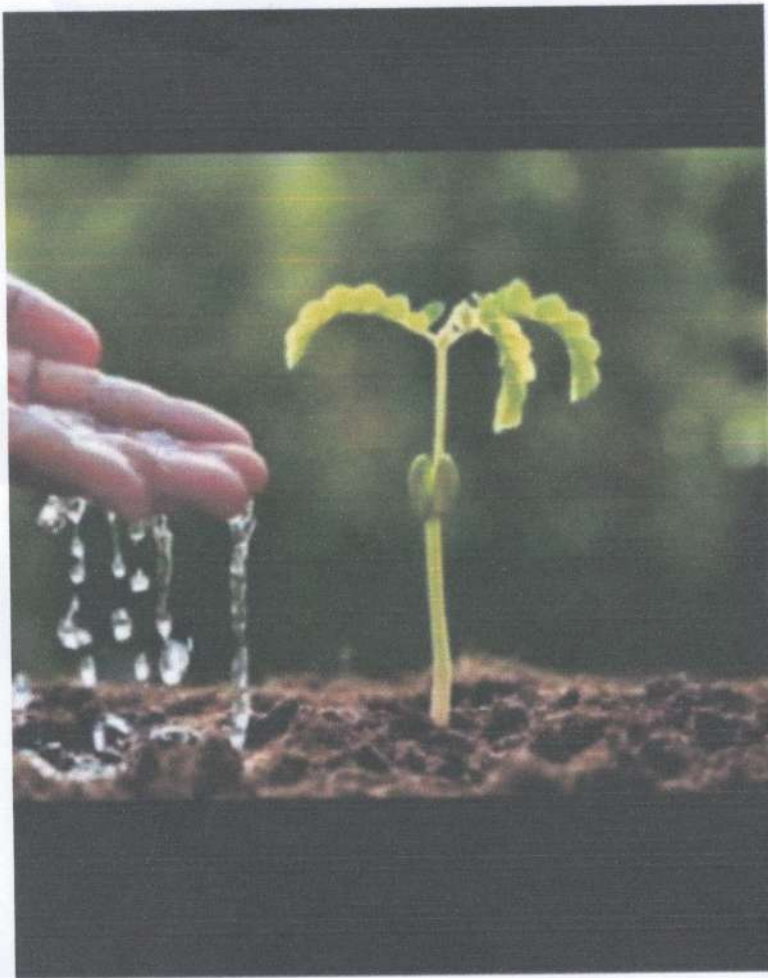
SUMMARY OF THE ACTIVITY

- About the Activity Conducted :
 - The invitation of ZOOM link is shared with the students and at the specified time 11.30 am, the ZOOM meeting started promptly.
 - District Horti-Culture officer was invited as the resource person to deliver a talk about the healthy agricultural and horticultural practices about growing organic vegetables, seeds, fruits etc. who gave excellent information about organic farming using Power Point Presentation.
 - The ID college Principal is invited as the chief guest and other principals as guest of honour.
 - The village farmer Srinivas who cultivates organic farming is also invited to speak about the methods who gave much information about the profits of using natural fertilizers and pesticides and how he maintained good soil quality and the profit parameters achieved.
 - Other speakers also gave valuable information and the students took the information to their homes to adopt quality practices.
- Problems Encountered : Some of the rural enthusiastic students could not participate due to connectivity issues.
- Outcome of the Activity :
 - Some very good methodologies were shared both by resource person and the farmer, wherein not only farmers but also common people with limited space and grow natural vegetables using the kitchen waste that can be directly converted into manure.
 - COVID-19 created constraints for the people to move out and purchase groceries. So home-cultivation techniques were beneficial to them.
 - Students were also taught about how to make use of waste water for growing some greenery to keep their environment full of oxygen in wake of COVID-19.

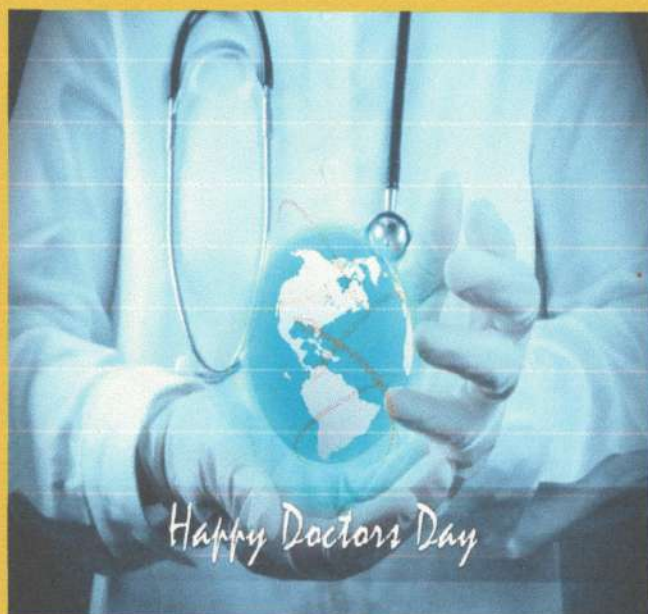




