

HISTORY OF DEPARTMENT OF TELUGU

The department of Telugu is one of the Arts departments of New Government Degree College for Women, Golconda established in 2015, it had the rare privilege of becoming the first Arts department of the college. The college is now affiliated to the Osmania University, Hyderabad. since 2015, the department offered a 3-year undergraduate program in Arts, Science and Commerce. The course was modeled on the annual evaluation system and the instruction was tailored to address the learning objectives defined in the syllabus. With the introduction of a choice-based credit system, the department moved to a more flexible and innovative space in terms of the form and content of the program from 2016 onwards. The new program is structured on a semester basis which runs through 3 years from the entry-level.




FUTURE PLAN


- Planning to introduce PG course in Telugu.
