






Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU)

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana

And

HireMee

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is entered into and effective as of 6th June 2018, by and between:

HireMee, a unit of KAAM Services Private Limited a company incorporated under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, and having its registered office at No.483, Seetha Complex, 16th cross, RR Nagar, Bengaluru-560098, Karnataka, India, and hereinafter unless the context otherwise requires, be referred to as "**HireMee**";

And

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Hyderabad having its registered office at 2nd Floor Vidya Bhavan, Opposite to Latha Talkies, Nampally, Hyderabad-500001 and hereinafter unless the context otherwise requires be referred to as "CCETS".

Whereas:

CCETS and HireMee have entered into discussions on HireMee's provision of free technology assistance to CCETS, for job placements for students of CCETS approved Colleges. HireMee serves as a Virtual Bridge between Recruiters and Aspiring Applicants esp. of Tier-2 and Tier-3 areas. HireMee is an end-to-end Web Portal and Mobile App developed with intent to reach out to all students, recruiters and colleges across the country in these areas who will benefit from using the HireMee. Students, Colleges, Corporates and Recruiters can register through HireMee Portal, and assessments are directly carried out by HireMee. The entire recruitment process will be seamlessly linked on a chain.

HireMee and CCETS desire to enter into this Memorandum setting out the terms and conditions under which the purpose and scope of this MOU will be achieved.

Article 1 Effective Date

The Parties hereby agree that the Effective date of this MOU shall be the date on which it is signed. The preamble to this Agreement constitutes an integral part thereof.

ARTICLE 2 Purpose and Scope

Purpose: This MOU outlines the mutual cooperation between the two parties for helping in bridging the gap in employability skills by imparting suitable training especially, in rural areas; help the academia to understand the gap in skills and support them with industry specific inputs; and provide an opportunity to the all students by connecting them to the right jobs.

This is a Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) effort to discover diamonds in students in rural and urban colleges free of cost.

Role and scope of cooperation: The Parties agree to, in the spirit of mutual cooperation, use the best efforts towards fulfillment of their respective obligations in achieving the purpose of this MOU.

This MOU outlines the commitments of both the Parties.

2.1 Commitments of CCETS:

- Informing all CCETS approved college Principals about HireMee's services and act as a platform for helping students find employment opportunities by linking industries for hiring.
- Support awareness for www.hiremee.co.in, by having colleges inform students through e-mail/circular/assembly/bulletin board notices and any other medium that provides similar and suitable benefit.
- Support HireMee by allowing to put posters and other awareness material for colleges to disseminate the information to students across campus on bulletin boards, notice boards, emails, etc.

2.2 Commitments of HireMee:

 Provide the free online and app based platform www.hiremee.co.infor Students and Recruiters to find the best students for jobs.

- Provide access to web portal and mobile app by all students studying in CCETS approved colleges and help them in getting placements.
- Help academia to understand the gaps in skills and areas of improvement
- Help bridge the gap in specific employability skills especially in rural areas and support them with industry specific inputs.
- Support CCETS in increasing awareness of <u>www.hiremee.co.inamong</u> students, colleges and universities by providing the required materials.

ARTICLE 3 Confidentiality

- 3.1 This document is confidential. Both the parties agree to maintain in confidence, and not reveal to any person or body, rights and obligations of the Parties or any information or data which it receives through the other Pursuant to this Agreement. The provision of Confidentiality shall survive the termination of this MOU and continue to bind the parties.
- 3.2 Both parties hereby declare that they know that this undertaking will be in force during the validity of this MOU, as well as at any time after this MOU is terminated.
- 3.3 Both parties declare that they know that the undertaking pursuant to this agreement is a pre-requisite for each party to enter into this MOU with the other, and that without this declaration each would not be willing to enter into an agreement with the other.

Article 4 Intellectual Property

- 4.1 Intellectual Property means all systems, processes, procedures, proposition descriptions, models, copyrights, trademarks, trade secrets, and patents, utility models, methods and other intellectual property rights recognized in any jurisdiction worldwide, including all applications and registrations.
- 4.2 This understanding will be operational and valid for 3 years from the date of signing or until the date of earlier termination upon completion of 3 years MOU can be renewed with mutual consent of both parties.

Either party may terminate this agreement by providing notice of at least 30 days in advance in writing to the other party at the official address for communication.

- 4.3 The Materials provided by HireMeeare protected by copyright, including without limitation by Copyright Law and other applicable laws in India.
- 4.4 CCETS & HireMee will not reveal, make use of or commercialize any of the confidential information provided by HireMee/CCETS either during the currency or after termination of the related Agreement for a period of 5 years.
- 4.5 HireMee will retain the right of ownership to all the Intellectual Property Rights. processes, protocols, propositions and models of HireMee, even though CCETS may have amended and added to the foundation Intellectual Property.

ARTICLE 5 General Provisions

5.1 Both Parties agree to maintain at all times, a one-point contact for undertaking and overseeing the initiatives listed out in this MOU. Any change in the contacts will be promptly notified to the other Party.

5.2 This MOU references good faith efforts by both CCETS and HireMee and is an expression of the Parties' current intent and recognizes the fact that the execution of some of the terms of the MOU could require the Parties to enter into definitive agreements. It is understood that without such definitive agreements, the terms of the MOU are not legally binding and will not be relied upon by any party for any purpose and no party is or will be bound by the terms of this MOU, unless and until definitive agreements are signed.







- 5.3 Terms and Termination: The Terms and Conditions agreed under this MOU shall commence on 6th June, 2018 and shall remain in effect until terminated.
- 5.4 Amendments: Either party may request changes to this MOU. Any changes, modifications, revisions or amendments to this MOU which are mutually agreed upon by and between the parties to this MOU shall be incorporated by written instrument, and effective when executed and signed by all parties to this MOU.
- 5.5 Applicable Law: The construction, interpretation and enforcement of this MOU shall be governed by the laws of India. The courts of Bangalore shall have jurisdiction over any action arising out of this MOU and over the parties, and the venue shall be Bangalore, India.
- 5.6 This MOU supersedes all prior oral or written communication, discussions and representations communicated between the parties hereto in respect of the subject matter of this MOU.
- 5.7 Any notice under this MOU will be in writing and delivered by hand or by registered post acknowledgement due, to the other party at the registered office or as may be substituted by the notice. If any notice sent by e-mail, post will be effective on the date of receipt.
- 5.8 Severability: Should any portion of this MOU be judicially determined to be illegal or unenforceable, the remainder of the MOU shall continue in full force and effect, and either party may renegotiate the terms affected by the severance.
- Third Party Beneficiary Rights: The parties do not intend to create in any other individual or entity the status of a third party beneficiary, and this MOU shall not be construed so as to create such status. The rights, duties and obligations contained in this MOU shall operate only between the parties to this MOU, and shall inure solely to the benefit of the parties to this MOU. The provisions of this MOU are intended only to assist the parties in determining and performing their obligations under this MOU. The parties to this MOU intend and expressly agree that only parties signatory to this MOU shall have any legal or equitable right to seek to enforce this MOU to seek any remedy arising out of a party's performance or failure to perform any term or condition of this MOU, or to bring an action for the breach of this MOU.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is entered into this on 16th November 2018 by and between

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana State, Vidya Bhavan, Nampally, (hereinafter referred to as "CCETS" which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executors, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) as FIRST PARTY.

AND

Naandi Foundation, a Public Charitable Trust incorporated under the Indian Trusts Act, having its registered office at 502, Trendset Towers, Road No 2, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad - 500 034, Telangana, India represented by Shri. Raj Iyer, Chief Youth Employment Officer, through its authorized signatory (hereinafter referred to as "Naandi" which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executors, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) as SECOND PARTY.

(Both Parties are hereinafter jointly referred to as "Parties" and individually as a "Party")

Introduction

WHEREAS CCETS is a non-profit organization created by Government of Telangana to promote education, giving special attention to the areas located in backward and rural areas. It aims to strengthen education at undergraduate and post-graduate level especially for women and underprivileged sections of the society.

WHEREAS Naandi Foundation is an apolitical, autonomous Public Charitable Trust and a not for profit organisation having registration under section 12AA of Income tax act, 1961 is tax exempt and is recognised by tax authorities as an organisation established for 'charitable purpose'

WHEREAS Naandi is working with an objective of people centred development through its charitable activities in whole of India, without distinction of caste, creed or religion, etc

WHEREAS Naandi engaged, inter alia, in improving the livelihoods of the underprivileged communities through its various social initiatives, developmental programs, in various states of India. Naandi's activities include, education to underprivileged children with a specific focus on girl child education, improving livelihoods of small and marginal farmers through its farming practices, employable training and skill development programs to underprivileged youth, provision of safe drinking water to communities, etc

WHEREAS Naandi, in furtherance of its objectives and as a part of its skill development program to underprivileged youth, wish to build and enhance the employability skill set of the underprivileged youth/students in colleges under the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education in the State of Telangana.

WHEREAS the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, in the State of Telangana, is desirous of engaging in employability skill building program of the underprivileged youth/students in Government Degree Colleges at undergraduate and post-graduate levels, in the State of Telangana.

WHEREAS both the parties having recognised each other's intention of supporting the underprivileged youth / students, studying in Government Degree colleges in the State of Telangana have decided to work together in the space of employability skill development initiative.

WHEREAS both the parties have decided to reduce the mutually agreed terms and conditions into writing

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS UNDER:

1: The employability skill development program (MPC)

- 1.1 The program shall be carried out in Government Degree and PG Colleges, in the State of Telangana. A list of such colleges/institutes is given in Annexure - I enclosed herewith which is a part of this MOU.
- 1.2 The beneficiaries/students shall be the underprivileged students studying in the final semester under this program in Government Degree and PG Colleges, in the State of Telangana.
- 1.3 The skilling program shall be for a duration of 40 hours or as the case may be decided mutually by the parties.
- 1.4 The program shall include Soft-Skills, Communication Skills, Life Skill and Interview preparations for the beneficiaries under employability skill development program. The

- beneficiaries may be trained in any other skill set, as mutually decided by both the parties, that improves their employable skill and livelihoods.
- 1.5 The first party or the respective college/institute/university shall select the beneficiaries/students for the said program.

II: Obligations of the First Party

- 1.1 Ensure that the necessary infrastructure like well-equipped class rooms are made available where the program shall be implemented.
- 1.2. Ensure that each of the selected colleges/ Institutes identify one resource person from their faculty to co-ordinate between the beneficiaries/students, the Institute management and the second party. Contact details of such identified resources shall be with the rest of the team.

III: Activities of the Second Party (Naandi):

- 1.1. Prepare content that will be most effective in training the beneficiaries/students.
- 1.2 Provide the first party a detailed Course Schedule containing curriculum and day wise lesson plans of courses to be conducted
- 1.3 Ensure that well-trained trainers are identified for each Institute to ensure overall success of the Project.
- 1.5 Monitor the program by conducting periodic assessments to ensure that the trainers do a quality job.
- 1.6 At periodic intervals, give a narrative report to the first party with the challenges met, opinion about the program, suggestions for improvement and feedback from the trainees. Similarly, parameter-based impact evaluation report shall be prepared by second party and submitted to first party periodically on completion of trainings for all students. A consolidated impact report shall be submitted on evaluating impact at project intervention level.

IV. TERM:

The MoU will be effective for a period of twelve months from the date of signing. The MOU may be extended on mutually agreed terms for a further period of one year or for such other period as mutually agreed by parties.

V. Free of Cost:

The Program is free of cost. Naandi shall not charge any fees on whatsoever account/name either from the students or the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education - Telangana or its affiliated institutions, for conducting the aforesaid program.

VI. Certification:

Certificates shall be awarded by Naandi to the students on successful completion of the training and clearing of the assessment held post completion of the program.

VII. General Terms

Amendments to the MoU:

No amendment or modification of this MoU shall be valid, unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this MoU. The modifications/changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed, unless otherwise agreed to.

Compliance with laws, statutes, rules and regulations of Government / local authority:

Both the parties shall comply with all laws, statutes and rules & regulations of Central and State Governments or Local authorities that may be applicable from time to time as required under this MoU.

Termination:

Where as Government Degree college has agreed to collect and give away the dry recyclable waste including any kind of paper waste and old records generated in its college and form Swachh Manuguru.

NOW THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

This is an agreement for a synergic alliance between Government Degree college and Arroww waste management solutions for the social cause of recycling of Dry Waste and Environment Protection through recycling

 Time period: This MOU shall be for a period of three years commencing from the date of signing of this MOU.

Roles and Responsibilities of Government Degree college;

- To ensure source segregation of dry and wet waste at College premise through its Teaching staff, housekeeping staff and Students.
- b. Government Degree college will give away any kind of paper waste, dry recyclable waste and old records to arroww at price agreed mutually, arroww will pay Rs 8/kg for any kind of Paper waste and old records and Rs. 4/kg for Plastic Waste (pet bottles, polythene bags etc.,) and iron and metal waste Rs 15/kg Government Degree college merce shall form Swachh Manuguru, in the college with Student Volunteers and adopt nearby Schools or Colonies to promote Source Segregation through student volunteers.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

INDIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY - HYDERABAD (IITH) AND

COMMISSIONERATE OF COLLEGIATE EDUCATION (CCETS), GOVERNEMENT OF TELANGANA

FOR THE COLLABORATIVE EDUCATION, RESEARCH & TRAINING

This Memorandum of Understanding signed on 28/04/2022 between INDIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY – HYDERABAD (IITH), established in 2008, and having its campus at Kandi Village, Sangareddy District, Telangana, 502 285 (herein after known as IITH)

AND

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Government of Telangana, Vidya Bhavan, Nampally, Hyderabad 500001 (herein after known as CCETS, Hyderabad which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executers, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) is intended to facilitate collaborative programs in the field of Education, Research & Training in allied subjects between the two Organizations.

Whereas,

- (A) Indian Institute of Technology Hyderabad (IITH) is a premiere institute of science and technology established in 2008. IITH has been consistently ranked in the top 10 institutes in India for Engineering. IIT Hyderabad is established to promote research and innovation in various fields of Technologies. The vibrant research culture is evident from the number of patents and publications that IITH produces consistently every year. IITH offers graduate programs at both Masters and Doctoral level in several diverse areas. IITH is also offering separate programs for Technology, Design, Science, and Liberal Arts.
- (B) Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Government of Telangana is the Department created to promote education, giving special attention to the students hailing from backward and rural areas. It aims to strengthen education at Undergraduate and Postgraduate level especially for women and under privileged sections of the society.


Whereas, both IIT, Hyderabad and CCETS, Hyderabad (herein after together referred to as parties) are empowered to enter into collaborative agreement of this nature in respect to the subjects related to achieve its goals objectives as stated by them.

NOW THEREFORE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

To enter into Memorandum of Understanding for a joint collaborative program of Education, Research, Training to the students & faculty members between the two institutions.

PURPOSE

IIT, Hyderabad and CCETS, Hyderabad desiring to develop cooperation and collaboration in Education, Research, Training and other agreed



activities that further the aims and objectives of both parties mutually agreed upon are as follows:

- Co-operation in New and Existing Academic Programmes.
- Conducting of Faculty Development Programs (FDPs).
- Support and extension for undertaking research activities and publication of research to the faculty members.
- Support and guidance for Patent generation/development to the faculty members
- Providing mutual opportunities for faculty members and Researchers to deliver invited lectures/talks.
- Providing opportunities for students to undertake certificate courses and internship programs.
- To encourage and support innovation and entrepreneurship among the students at every stage.
- viii. Research co-operation to the students.
- ix. Facilitating for conducting Trainings, Lectures, Symposia, International Conferences and Workshops.
- Providing opportunity to the students to undertake campus visits at IIT, Hyderabad.

2. IMPLEMENTATION

- All programs or activities implemented under the term of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually agreed upon in writing, including the necessary budget for the program of activity as the need may arise.
- Both IITH and CCETS, Hyderabad shall be fully responsible financially for the activities carried out under its direction or by its staff, except as otherwise agreed by IITH and CCETS, Hyderabad.
- iii. Both IITH and CCETS, Hyderabad will designate one officer each who will develop and coordinate specific programs or activities between them.

3. DURATION AND RENEWAL OF AGREEMENT

The memorandum of understanding will become effective immediately after signature by the representatives of IITH and CCETS, Hyderabad for a period of **THREE** years. The MoU may be subject to renewal on mutual consent of both parties, for the period internally agreed upon.

4. AMENDMENTS

- This memorandum of understanding may be amended by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both IITH and CCETS, Hyderabad.
- b) In the event of any unforeseen incident during collaborative activities both IITH and CCETS, Hyderabad agree to negotiate a mutually and acceptable solution.

5. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

There will not be any financial commitment between the parties and cost, if any, for exchange of faculty and students shall be borne by the individual or borrowing organization as the case may be.

6. CONFIDENTIALITY

- Each party recognizes that pursuant to this MoU, if, given access to information that is confidential and /or proprietary to the other party; and agrees to undertake not to use any such confidential, proprietary or restricted information for the own purpose without the prior written consent of the other party.
- 2. Both the parties shall take all reasonable steps to keep confidential (and ensure that its employees, students, associates and agents also keep them confidential), any subject matter and information or material classified as confidential, whether technical or commercial, acquired formally or informally by either party from the other or their staff or students or by the Researcher(s) concerned in the work done or to be done under this agreement.

 Neither party shall assign and/or transfer any nor all of its rights, obligation and/or interests arising or claimed under or by virtue of this MoU to a third party without obtaining the prior written consent of the other party.

 Both parties agree to subscribe to the principles of equal opportunity and will not discriminate on the basis of gender, age, disability, race, colour, religion, marital status, veteran's status, national or ethnic origin, or sexual orientation.

7. TERMINATION:

During the validity of this Agreement, each party shall be entitled to terminate the same at any time, without assigning any reason, after giving six months advance notice to the other party. Notwithstanding such termination, each party shall fulfill all obligations accrued under this agreement prior to the time the termination becomes effective.

This MoU is to develop and promote the student/institutional capacity building/research activities and does not have any legal binding. However, for administrative purposes the parties to this MoU agree to legal jurisdiction of Civil Courts of Hyderabad.

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is made at Hyderabad on 24th day of May 2022.

By and Between

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Government of Telangana, Vidya Bhavan, Nampally, Hyderabad 500001 (herein after known as CCETS, Hyderabad which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executers, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) is intended to facilitate a collaborative program in the matter of





training manpower with employment oriented skillset.

AND

ICICI Foundation for Inclusive Growth, a charitable trust registered at Chennai vide a Trust Deed dated January 04, 2008 and having its head / principal office at ICICI Bank Towers, Bandra Kurla Complex, Bandra East, Mumbai 400051 (hereafter referred as the "SECOND PARTY", which expression shall unless repugnant to the context and meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its present and future trustees).

(Both the parties are hereinafter, collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually as the "Party")

WHEREAS, the First Party is keen on skill development of the unskilled manpower (specifics like tribal youth / minority / socially backward, etc. may be added depending on the mandate of the Government agency) in the State of Telangana ("State") and thereby enabling them to participate in the growth and economic development of the State / District and the Second Party has the relevant experience of successfully conducting training programmes through ICICI Academy for Skills ("Academy"), a training institute that provides skill development training to underprivileged youth with the objective of improving their livelihood prospects through self-employment and wage employment and providing placement opportunities for successful trainees, the Parties have decided to enter into this MoU for achieving the objective envisaged by the First Party.

This MoU has been entered with respect to the Telangana State and Hyderabad centre of ICICI Academy for Skills in the Telangana State ("Centre").

By this MoU, the Parties agree that the following shall be the role and responsibility of each party towards achieving the aforesaid objective -

- The First Party shall counsel and mobilise the underprivileged youth for training at the Centre. The candidates who meet the eligibility criteria of the Second Party, may be offered admission to forthcoming training batches, subject to availability.
- The Second Party shall continue to determine the eligibility criteria (age, educational qualification and family income), documents required from the prospective candidates, training curriculum and content and duration of





each training session, number of candidates per batch and number of batches in which the training to be carried out at the Centre and intimate the same to the First Party, from time to time, prior to commencement of training for each batch to enable the First Party to mobilise candidates as per the criteria.

- The Second Party shall bear all costs of training programme and First party shall provide eligible candidates for the training program as per the eligibility criteria.
- 4. The Second Party shall make efforts (including through engaging placement agencies) to facilitate employment for trainees who complete the training successfully. The Second Party is however, not obligated to fulfil employment opportunities for all the trainees. The First Party shall support the efforts of the Second Party.
- This MoU shall operate for two (2) years from the date of signing. However, the Parties may extend this MoU for such further period as may be mutually agreed by the Parties in writing.
- The First Party proposes to provide aforesaid support to 2000 candidates during the course of this MoU. If the targeted number of candidates to be supported under this MoU is achieved before the expiry of this MoU, the Parties may mutually agree to increase the target.
- The Parties acknowledge that this MoU will be subject to the laws of Telangana, India in case of any disputes. The courts of Hyderabad shall have jurisdiction on non - exclusive basis in relation to any disputes arising under this MoU.
- 8. The Parties acknowledge that neither them nor their employees, agents, officers or representatives, have received or shall receive, purport to receive or seek, directly or indirectly, any payments or transfers in kind of any value from the trainees and / or any other persons, including but not limited to any relatives/friends/other people accompanying or known to the trainees or people in general being sourced / counselled by them for the purposes of this MoU and for acceptance into the Academy. The Parties further acknowledge that they have put in effective process to ensure working / compliance of the aforesaid arrangement.
- 9. The Parties acknowledge that this is a non-financial collaboration and it has not and shall not in connection with this MoU, make or has made any payment or transfer anything of value, directly or indirectly for securing the arrangement under this MoU or any other matter relating to this MoU:

- To each other, the other's employees, officers, managerial personnel or any person, involved in the management and administration of each entity;
- (ii) To any person(s) who are the subject of the initiatives/collaboration stated in this MoU, including any trainees or their relatives, friends, people accompanying them, etc:
- (iii) To any governmental official or employee (including employees of a government corporation or public international organisation) or to any political party or trainee for public office; or
- (iv) To any other person or entity if such payments or transfers would violate the laws of India.
- None of the First Party's employees or other man power shall be construed or deemed to be the employees of the Second Party at any time and vice a versa.
- In order to streamline coordination between the Parties for effective implementation and monitoring of the training programme, the Parties will nominate a single point of contact from each side.
- 12. The Parties agree that each of them will not be bound by any other obligations other than those specified as a part of this MoU. Each Party will be solely liable for performance of the obligations and activities assigned to it under this MoU, including any third party claims arising from each Party's actions or omissions during the term of this MoU.
- 13. Unless otherwise provided herein, all notices or other communications under or in connection with this MoU shall be given in writing and may be sent by personal delivery or post or courier at the below mentioned address. Any such notice or other communication will be deemed to be effective if sent by personal delivery, when delivered, if sent by post, 7 (seven) days after being deposited in the post and if sent by courier, one day after being deposited with the courier.
- 14. The Second Party may terminate this MoU, in whole or in part, at any time prior to the expiry of the term of this MoU by giving the First Party thirty (30) days prior written notice.
- 15. The Parties shall not be liable for any failure to perform any of its obligations under this Agreement if the performance is prevented, hindered or delayed by a Force Majeure event (defined below) and in such case its obligations shall be suspended for so long as the Force Majeure Event

continues. Each party shall promptly inform the other of the existence of a Force Majeure Event and shall consult together to find a mutually acceptable solution.

"Force Majeure Event" means any event due to any cause beyond the reasonable control of the Party, including, without limitation, unavailability of any communication system, sabotage, fire, flood, explosion, acts of God, civil commotion, strikes or industrial action of any kind, riots, insurrection, war or acts of government.

- Each Party will seek the other Party's prior written consent for use of that other Party's name and / or logo and / or intellectual property in any manner whatsoever.
- 17. This MoU constitutes the final and entire understanding between the Parties with respect to this collaboration and supersedes any previous agreement or understanding between the Parties and any amendments or waiver to this MoU shall be in writing and signed by both the Parties.
