ACADEMIC CURRICULUM POLICY

1. The Incharge of the department will be the chairperson for the respective Board of Studies and other members in the department will be members of Board of Studies.
2. Each Board of Studies should have a Osmania University nominee, industry representative, a subject expert and if available Alumnus of college.
3. The Board of Studies should meet before the commencement of the Academic Year and ready with approval on curriculum to be implementing along with Model Question Paper & Panel of Examiners.
4. The curriculum should be reviewed every year based on the feedback received from faculty, students & employers etc.
5. The Academic Council is the higher Academic Body of the college includes Dean of all the Faculty of OU, Principal of the college, IQAC Coordinator, UGC Coordinators, Academic Coordinators and All the in charges of the departments will be the members of the body
6. The Academic Council will meet once in a year and approve all the curricular aspects along with SEC/AECC and other certificate programs to be offered in the Academic Year after deliberation. All the Board of studies minutes to be approved by the Academic Council.
7. The Academic Coordinator along with the Controller of Examinations after deliberation with staff council to propose college Time Table, Almanac and Academic Calendar for Approval.
8. All the In charges of the departments to ensure strictly adhere to Academic Calendar and College Time Table.
9. Class Representatives and Deputy Class Representatives will ensure these Student Club Activities are conducting in smooth way.

10. Student Representative are mandatory Certain Bodies/Committee like Academic Council, Special Fee Committee or Minor Repair Committee etc.
11. Departments to arrange Bridge class and Remedial classes as & when required.
12. Efforts to be made by the respective departments to integrate IT into Curriculum.
13. More than 20 trans-disciplinary Courses to be offered to the students and each student is expected to take up at least 2 trans-disciplinary Courses which has 4 credits each.
14. Students should score at least 150 credits to become eligible for Award of Degree, where opportunity is created to the students to earn extra credits by participating in NCC/NSS/Sports/Yoga/UAC.
