World Tourism Day:

World Tourism Day is commemorated each year on 27 September to foster awareness among the international community of the importance of tourism and its social, cultural, political and economic value.

World Tourism Day was designated by the World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) in September 1979, with the commemoration to commence in 1980. This date was chosen to coincide with an important milestone in world tourism: the anniversary of the adoption of the UNWTO Statutes on 27 September 1970.

Since 1980, the United Nations World Tourism Organisations has celebrated **World Tourism**Day as International Observances on September 27. This date was chosen as on that day in 1970, the Statutes of the UNWTO were adopted. The adoption of these Statutes is considered a milestone in global tourism. The purpose of this day is to raise awareness on the role of Tourism within the international community and to demonstrate how it affects social, cultural, political and economic values worldwide.

At its Twelfth Session in Istanbul, Turkey, in October 1997, the UNWTO General Assembly decided to designate a host country each year to act as the Organization's partner in the celebration of World Tourism Day. At its Fifteenth Session in Beijing, China, in October 2003, the Assembly decided the following geographic order to be followed for World Tourism Day celebrations: 2006 in Europe; 2007 in South Asia; 2008 in the Americas; 2009 in Africa and 2011 in the Middle East.

The late Ignatius Amaduwa Atigbi, a Nigerian national, was the one who proposed the idea of marking September 27 of every year as World Tourism Day. He was finally recognized for his contribution in 2009. The colour of World Tourism Day is Blue.

UNO Formation Day

United Nations Day, on 24 October, marks the anniversary of the day in 1945 when the UN Charter entered into force. This will include an official ceremony at the Al Wasl Dome and an exciting cultural performance by the Emirates Youth Symphony Orchestra (EYSO), a unique group of young musicians in the UAE and the Arab world at large, devoted to cultivating the musical talent of young people, by creating a cultural and artistic environment for young talents for audiences of all ages. The ceremony will take place on the Stage of Nations in Al Wasl Dome starting 10:15 am GST, with the presence of high-level government officials from the United Arab Emirates. UN Deputy Secretary-General Amina Mohammed will join the ceremony in person and give opening remarks to commemorate the global efforts and impact of the United Nations work to serve people and planet for 76 years.







Field Trip to Bongir Fort and Yadadri Temple:

Department of History and Heritage Club Organized Historical Field visit to the UG Students in the part of Educational Tour. Nearly 100 students are participated very actively. Dr. T. Mallesham, Head of the Department, Sri. M. Kondal Reddy and Sri. A. Santhosh kumar Lecturers, acted as mentors to the students. They visited historical places like: Kolanupaka Jaina Mandir, Ghongir Fort and Yadagiri Gutta Temple.

Yadagirigutta is a Census Town in Aleir Assembly constituency of Yadadri, Bonagiri Disrict of the Indian state of Telangana. It is a temple town as the famous Lakshmi Narasimha Temple is situated here. It is located at a distance of 16 Kms from the district headquarters Bhuvanagiri which is a part of Hyderabad Metropolitan Region and 55 Kms from Uppal, a major suburb of Hyderabad.

Bhuvanagiri Fort is a Fort located in Bhuvangiri, Yadagiri Bhuvanagiri District, Telangana, India. It is located on a huge rock at a commanding height. The Bhongir fort adorns the place from the time it was built in 10th century. Bhongir Fort was built on an isolated monolithic rock by the Western Chalukya ruler Tribhuvanamalla Viramaditya IV in the year 1076 and was thus named after him as Tribhuvanagiri, later it was called as Bhuvanagiri. Some of the inscriptions found in the fort were in Kannada and Telugu language highlighting the lifestyle of the people of that era. The inscriptions, the architecture and some sculptures found in the fort reveal that the fort was ruled by the Chalukya dynasty for a long time and then by the Kakatiya Dynasty. The stone wall, the steps through the granite archways and the crumbling stucco ruins of the later age, still adorn the place.

Somewhere in 15th century, the fort was ceded to the Bahamani Sultans and then was taken over by a local governor. The Qutb Shahis used the fort as a prison for those who aspired to snatch their throne. During the time of the British, the fort escaped their attention and was not occupied. Bhuvanagiri was much ignored after the downfall of the Nizams at the time of communist revolution in the late 1940s.

Bhongir sits on a unique egg-shaped rock hill more than 500 feet high. The steps from the bottom of the hill to the top are still intact; at the beginning of the steps there is a Hanuman Temple with two entry points protected by huge rocks, so the fort was considered practically

impregnable by invading armies. The splendid historical fort with the awe-inspiring rock and the aesthetically fortified courts which have stood the ravages of time stir the imagination of tourists. A moat that encircles the fort, a vast underground chamber, trap doors, an armory, stables, ponds, wells, etc., make for fascinating viewing. The fort is associated with the rule of the heroic queen and the countryside is simply breathtaking. The Bala Hisar or citadel on the top of the hill gives a bird's eye view. Rumor has it that there once was an underground corridor connecting Bhongir Fort to Golconda Fort. There is a statue placed at entry of the fort which came out in nearby diggings around fort. It is a popular trekking spot.

Field Trip to Kolanupaka

Department of History and Heritage Club Organized Historical Field visit to the UG Students in the part of Educational Tour. 100 students are participated very actively. Dr. T. Mallesham, Head of the Department, Sri. M. Kondal Reddy and Sri. A. Santhosh kumar Lecturers, acted as mentors to the students. They visited historical place like: Kolanupaka Jaina Mandir and surroundings.

Kolanupaka: Kulpakji also **Kolanupaka Temple** is a 2,000-year-old at the village of Kolanupaka in Aler City, Yadagiri District, Telangana India. The temple houses three idols: one each of Lord Rishabhanatha, Lord Neminatha, and Lord Mahavir. The image of Lord Rishabhanatha, carved of a green stone has been historically famous as "Manikyaswami" and Jiyantasyami.

Kolanupaka Temple is more than 2,000 years old. A number of Jain antiquities have been discovered in Kulpakji. A grant mentioning a gift to a basadi during the rile of Sanfkaragana (9th century) has been found at Akunur. Kolanupaka flourished as a Jain center during the Rashtrakutas period. Over 20 Jain inscriptions have been found at Kulpak. Inscriptions suggest that the Kulpak was a major center of Kranur Gana of Mula Sangh. A manastamba with an inscription of 1125 AD has been found. A 12th-century inscription found in the temple mentions Meghachadra Siddhantadeva who entered sallekana.

In Viyidha Tirtha Kalpa (14th century) of Jinaprabhasuri the sections Kulyapak Rishabhadeva Stuti and Kollapakamanikyadeva Tirthakalpa. He mentions that according to legends, the Manikyasami image was originally worshipped by Mandodari, the wife of Ravana. It was brought here by the ruler Sankar of Kalyana.

Birthday Celebrations of Mahatma Jyothirao Pule

Jyotirao Govindrao Phule, also known as **Mahatma Jyotiba Phule** (11 April 1827 – 28 November 1890) was an Indian social activist, thinker, anti-caste Social Reformer and writer from Maharashtra. His work extended too many fields. including eradication of untouchability and the Caste system and for his efforts in educating women and oppressed caste people. He and his wife, Savithribhai Pule were pioneers of women's education in India. Pule started his first school for girls in 1848 in Pune at Tatyasaheb Bhide's residence or Bhidewada. He, along with his followers, formed the Sathyashodak Samaaj (Society of Truth Seekers) to attain equal rights for people from lower castes. People from all religions and castes could become a part of this association which worked for the uplift of the oppressed classes. Pule is regarded as an important figure in the social reform movement in Maharashtra. He was bestowed with honorific Mahatma (Sanskrit: "great-souled", "venerable") title by Maharashtrian social activist Vithalrao Krishnaji Vandekar in 1888.

Extension Lecture on DR. B.R.Ambedkar Philosophy and Social Justice

Ambedkar Jayanti or Bhim Jayanti is an annual festival observed on 14 April to commemorate the memory of B.R. Ambedkar, Indian polymath and civil rights activist. It marks Dr. Babasahib Ambedekar's birthday that was born on 14 April 1891. Since 2015 it has been observed as an official public holiday throughout India. Ambedkar Jayanti is celebrated not just in India but all around the world. Ambedkar struggled for equality throughout his life; hence his birthday is celebrated as 'Equality Day' in India, and the demand to declare this day as "International Equality Day" goes to the United Nations.

Ambedkar Jayanti processions are carried out by his followers at Chaitya Bhoomi in Mumbai and Deeksha Bhoomi in Nagpur. It is a customary for senior national figures, such as the President, Prime Minster and leaders of major political parties, to pay homage at the statue of Ambedkar at the Parliament of India in New Delhi. It is celebrated throughout the world especially by Dalits, Adivasis, labor workers, women and also those who embraced Buddhism after his example. In India, large numbers of people visit local statues commemorating Ambedkar in procession with lot of fanfare.

- 2. They get to know about Ambedkar and his Philosophy.
- 3. They get to know about Social Justice and its impact on society.













Buddha Jayanthi:

Buddha Jayanti or Buddha Purnima is the celebration of the birth of Gautama Buddha, and this year it will be observed on May 16. His birth anniversary is also known as Buddha Purnima or Vaisakhi Buddha Purnima or Vesak. As per the Hindu calendar, Buddha Jayanti falls on a full moon day in the month of Vaisakh (which usually falls in April or May). Buddha Jayanti, 2022 will mark the lord Buddha's 2584th birth anniversary. However, it is actually based on the Asian lunisolar calendar, which is why the dates change every year. Lord Buddha was born as Prince Siddhartha Gautama on the Purnima Tithi (full moon day) in 563 BC in Lumbini (modern day Nepal). In Hinduism, Buddha is considered as the ninth avatar of Lord Vishnu.

This day is commemorated by Buddhists and Hindus all over the world, and is a major festival in countries like India, Nepal, Bhutan, Burma, Thailand, Tibet, China, Korea, Laos, Vietnam, Mongolia, Cambodia, Singapore, Indonesia and Sri Lanka (where it is called Vesak), however every country celebrates the festival differently.

Out Comes:

- 1. Students get to know the importance of Buddha and his Dharma.
- 2. They get to know about the life and sacrifice of Buddha.
- 3. They analyze the difference between Buddhism and other religions.




Talk on Historical Importance of Siddipet



Extension Lecture on History and Culture of Telangana:


