Sub: Collegiate Education - Transgender persons (Protection of Rights) Act, 2019-Appointment of Complaint Officer in GDCs - Instructions - Issued-Reg.

Ref: Memo. No. 512/Prog.II(1)/2023-2 from Special Secretary to Government, Dated: 21.07.2023

The Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India has enacted "The Transgender Persons (Protection of right) Act, 2019" with the aim of creating a more inclusive society and provisions of the same came into force on 10<sup>th</sup> January,2020. The Act, interalia, provides the right to self-perceived gender identify access to healthcare services, the right to Non-discrimination in employment and Education and other welfare measures to transgender persons.

It is also informed that under Section 11 of the Act mandates that every establishment shall designate a person to be a complaint officer to deal with the complaints relating to violation of the provisions of the Act.

In view of the above, Principals of all the GDCs in the State are hereby instructed to appoint One Senior Faculty Member as Complaints Officer in the College, in order to combat the prejudices against the community.

The receipt of the circular shall be acknowledged.
