As part of the *Swachhta Hi Sewa Campaign*, the Commissioner of Collegiate Education hereby directs all the Principals of the Government Degree Colleges in the State to carry out the following activities related to *Swachhta Hi Sewa* (SHS) Campaign in the premises of these educational institutions and their adopted villages with the active participation of NSS Volunteers and NSS Progamme Officers:

- 1. Single use plastic awareness and distribution of cloth bags among public.
- 2. Cleaning drives in Traditional water bodies and coastal cleaning activities will be organized in association with local NGOs and State Govt. Depts.
- 3. Social media awareness on keeping premises clean.
- 4. Out of 120 hours of regular activities, every NSS volunteer will devote 20 hours on *Swachhta* cleaning activities.
- 5. *Swatchhta* pledge taking event (Pledge enclosed).
- 6. *Swachhta* cleaning activities organize at public places like bus stand, Railway Station and market places.
- 7. During NSS 7-day Special Camp period, the volunteers may organize *Swatchhta* cleaning drives at the adopted villages and clean public places like Schools/Colleges, water bodies and conduct awareness rallies, street theatre on *Swatchhta* importance.

The Principals of GDCs are also directed to conduct cocurricular activities such as essay writing, elocution, painting, drawing competitions to create awareness on *Swatchhta* and
