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With reference to the subject cited, it is informed that the Government of Telangana is giving utmost importance for enhancing quality in Higher Education Institutions and taking several initiatives like encouraging students to work on project based learning which eventually inculcates the habit of research and identify the problems and solutions for the same.

In this connection, Commissionerate of Collegiate Education has instructed all the Principals to encourage students to participate in Group Study Projects in 15 subjects. After the preparation of the projects, selections were carried out at College and District level and the selected projects were submitted for State Level Selections. The State Level Presentation programme was held from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 at Government City College (A), Hyderabad and BJR Government Degree College, Narayanaguda, Hyderabad. Professors from various Universities were invited to evaluate and select the best projects.

In continuation with Jignasa-State Level Presentation and Selection of Student Study Projects programme, a Prize distribution function for the winners of Jignasa is planned on 15<sup>th</sup>, February, 2020 at NTR Auditorium, Potti.Sreeramulu Telugu University, Nampally, Hyderabad from 9:00 am to 1:30 pm.

The following instructions have to be followed by the Prize Winning Colleges for the prize distribution programme:

 The Principals are informed to make arrangements for the Winners of Jignasa – Student Study Projects to attend the Prize Distribution

Function along with their Supervisor/Mentor at 9:00 am on 15<sup>th</sup>, February, 2020.

- 2. The Projects selected for First Prize shall be awarded with Rs 25,000/-cash prize for the group and Rs 5000/- for the Mentor/Supervisor. The Projects selected for Second Prize shall be awarded with Rs 18,000/-cash prize for the group and Rs 3000/- for the Mentor/Supervisor. The projects selected for Commendable Project Work shall be awarded with a Certificate of Merit.
- 3. The Cash prize for the Prize Winners shall be issued in favour of the Principal of the concerned College. The Principals are therefore requested to distribute the amount equally among the winning students of the team through cross cheque and acquire a stamped receipt from the students concerned. The acquaintance along with the compliance report shall be made available to O/o CCE on or before 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2019.
- 4. The Principals shall bring the cheques for the programme in favour of the Supervisor and the students of the first and second prize winners neatly placing each cheque in a transparent cover and hand it over to the State Coordinators at 9 am on 15<sup>th</sup> February, 2020.
- 5. The Principals, Supervisors shall claim TA from the parent College utilizing the TA Budget under HoA 110/111 based on actual fare as per Government rules and the students of 45 prize winning projects attending the Function of Jignasa- Student Study Projects prize distribution ceremony shall claim transport expenditure from the accumulated funds of respective colleges based on the actual fare.
- 6. The list of Jignasa Student Study Projects Prize winners is placed in the Annexure for information. The Mentors/Supervisors are instructed to submit one page (A4 Size) brief synopsis of the project covering aspects like Aim and Objectives of the project, Research Methodology, Analysis of Data, Findings, Conclusions and Suggestions for publishing in the Jignasa Magazine. The format for the synopsis is as follows:
