Sub:-	Collegiate Education – UGC SERO – Government and Private Aided Degree Colleges – unsettled UGC amounts under various schemes –IX,X, XI & XII plan periods –Orders– Reg.

UGC SERO officers have approached Commissioner of Collegiate Education with a request to take necessary action for settlement of funds taken under various UGC Schemes by Government and Pvt. Aided colleges. Further, they have also submitted the list of colleges which have not settled amount under different schemes during IX, X, XI & XII plan periods of UGC.

In this connection, an interface meeting between Principals of Government and Pvt. Aided Degree colleges and UGC SERO was arranged. Further, repeated reminders were also sent from O/o CCE to these colleges, requesting them to clear the dues at the earliest. In spite of all this, some of the colleges have not settled the UGC accounts. The list of these colleges is placed here in annexure.

Under these circumstances, the Principals of the colleges mentioned in the above list, are instructed to look into the issues related to pendency and fix responsibilities on the persons concerned and to send reminders to ensure the settlement as follows:

- Persons who have not settled UGC accounts and are in-service, Principals concerned shall recover the amount from their salaries to clear the dues.
- In case of the persons who were retired from the service before 2015, criminal case may be filed against them.
- The persons who are retired from the service during the last four years, their case shall be referred to the Government for framing of Article of Charges and to recover the amount from their pensionary benefits.

In view of the above the Principals are instructed to fix the responsibilities and give them 15 days from the time of receipt of the proceedings to settle the pending amounts and submit the clearance certificate from UGC SERO to the O/o CCETS. If they fail to settle the dues, action shall be initiated against them.
