CIRCULAR

Sub : Collegiate Education-Government Degree Colleges- Admissions Campaign for the Academic Year 2022-23- Certain Instructions-Issued-Reg.

Due to the various academic and administrative initiatives like Redesigning & Reorganizing of Courses, Introduction of Bucket System, and Introduction of Bio-metric Attendance System initiated by the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, the admissions in Govt. Degree Colleges have increased by **68%** over the last 4 years.

In spite of huge growth in the overall admissions of Government Degree Colleges, there is an imbalance in the admissions in some Govt. Degree Colleges in the State. Few Colleges are excelling with maximum number of admissions, whereas few Colleges have very low students strength. Even some colleges with good infrastructural and other teaching staff also recorded low admissions in DOST -2021.

Further, due to prolonged two years of Covid time, the academic environment has got disturbed and the academic calendar has got delayed. In view of the above, all the Principals of Government Degree Colleges are hereby directed to work hard for streamlining the coming academic year 2022-23. The Principal and Faculty should prepare an action plan for improving the admissions for the year 2022-23 by collecting the contact numbers of the students who have passed out during the academic year 2021-2022 from the feeder colleges, Intermediate Colleges/DIEOS in the vicinity of the Government Degree Colleges and reaching them to enlighten them about the strengths and facilities of Government Degree Colleges.

The total number of students in the feeder colleges shall be divided among the faculty members and each faculty member shall contact the students over phone and enlighten them about the Infrastructural Facilities, Courses and other Services Offered in their concerned Govt. Degree College.

In this regard, this initiative shall be taken up immediately before commencement of the DOST-2022 online admissions. The admission Campaigning shall be taken up on daily basis and Lecturers (Regular, Redeployed, Part-time and Contract) shall contact at least 20 students per day and submit the feedback to the Principal. The Principals shall monitor the program on daily basis and report the compliance of the same to the Academic Cell.
