This Memorandum of Understanding (herein after referred to as MoU) is entered into by and between:

**Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Government of Telangana** having its office at 3rd Floor, Prof. Jayashankar Vidya Bhavan, Nampally, Hyderabad – 500001, hereinafter unless the context otherwise requires be referred to as “**CCETS**”

As FIRST PARTY

And

**StoryTech Private Limited**, incorporated in September 2016 as a startup by professionals with academic qualifications and experience in the field of software development. It is represented by its Founder & Chief Executive Officer, Mr. Manikanth Challa with their Registered Office located at Flat No - 202, Shreya Blossom, Plot No-185A, Road No-15A, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad - 500033, Telangana, India and hereinafter unless the context otherwise requires be referred to as “**SPL**”,

As SECOND PARTY

(Both Parties are hereinafter jointly referred to as “Parties” and individually as a “Party”)

**Introduction:**

- A. Whereas CCETS is a non-profit department created by the Government of Telangana State to promote education, giving special attention to backward and rural areas. It aims to strengthen education at under graduation level especially for underprivileged sections of the society.
- B. StoryTech Private Limited is a startup which aims at development of dynamic, flexible and scalable solutions or challenges in domains to arrive at integrated solutions for arriving at measurable impacts.
- C. CCETS and SPL have entered into discussions on SPL’s Digital Employment Exchange of Telangana’s (DEET’s) provision of technological assistance to CCETS in the areas of placement services, skill enhancements, trainings in the emerging horizons, interview & employment success factors





including but not limited to Curriculum Vitae (CV) building etc. for students/jobseekers.

D. SPL's DEET is an end to end web portal and mobile app developed with an intent to connect all stake holders i.e., students/jobseekers and recruiters across the state of Telangana in the above-mentioned areas. The stakeholders can register through SPL (DEET) portal. Assessments are directly carried out by SPL (DEET). The entire recruitment process will be seamlessly linked on a chain.

E. The parties share the common interest of engaging in creating a platform that connects academia and industry with the objective of providing employment opportunities to students by connecting them to the right jobs.

SPL and CCETS desire to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding setting out the terms and conditions under which the purpose and scope of this MoU will be achieved.

### **Article 1 Effective Date**

The parties hereby agree that the effective date of this MoU shall be the date on which it is signed. The preamble to this agreement constitutes an integral part thereof.

### **Article 2 Purpose and Scope**

**Purpose:** This MoU outlines the mutual cooperation between the two parties which shall create an ecosystem, to bridge the gap between industry and academia through need-based trainings to the job aspirants that shall support them with industry specific inputs, and provide opportunities to all, to achieve the right job.

**Role and scope of cooperation:** The parties agree to, in the spirit of cooperation, use the best efforts towards fulfilment of their respective obligations in achieving the purpose of this MoU.

This MoU outlines the commitments of both the parties.





## **2.1 Responsibilities of CCETS:**

- Instruct all Government Degree Colleges working under its ambit:
  - to partner with SPL for DEET activities
  - support awareness activities on SPL (DEET) and disseminate the information to the students through display of posters/other awareness materials/circular/e-mail/bulletin board notices and any other medium that provides similar and suitable benefit
- Recommend and encourage all Government Degree Colleges under its purview to motivate their students to utilize the services of SPL (DEET).

## **2.2 Responsibilities of SPL (DEET):**

- Provide online and app-based platform (website) for students of Government Degree Colleges approved by CCETS and recruiters to find the best candidates for jobs.
- Jobseekers shall have the option of skill enhancements, trainings in the emerging horizons, interview & employment success factors, Curriculum Vitae (CV) building and other facilities on chargeable basis. SPL shall provide these options subject to terms and conditions, with consent of the jobseekers.
- Provide assistance to understand the gaps in employability skills and areas of improvement, with industry specific inputs.
- Support CCETS in increasing awareness on [www.tsdeet.com](http://www.tsdeet.com) among students, colleges, jobseekers and universities.

### **Article 3 Term**

The MoU shall be effective for a period of one year from the date of signing. The MoU may be extended on mutually agreed terms for a further period of one year or for such other period as mutually agreed by parties.





## **Article 4 Financial Liabilities**

4.1 StoryTech Private Limited shall not charge any fee on whatsoever account/name either from the students or the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education or its affiliated institutions for job placements and internships.

4.2 Skill enhancement trainings and other corollary features will be charged by SPL subject to terms and conditions specified, with consent of the jobseekers, without any financial liability on CCETS or its affiliated institutions.

## **Article 5 Confidentiality**

5.1 This document is confidential. Both the parties agree to maintain confidentiality and not reveal to any person or body, rights and obligations of the Parties or any information or data which it receives through the other pursuant to this agreement. The provision of confidentiality shall survive the termination of this MoU and continue to bind the parties.

5.2 Both parties hereby declare that they know that this undertaking will be in force during the validity of this MoU as well as at any time after this MoU is terminated.

5.3 Both parties declare that they know that the undertaking pursuant to this agreement is a pre-requisite for each party to enter into this MoU with the other, and that without this declaration; each would not be willing to enter into an agreement with the other.

## **Article 6 Intellectual Property**

6.1 Intellectual Property means all systems, processes, procedures, proposition descriptions, models, copyrights, trademarks, trade secrets, and patents, utility models, methods and other intellectual property rights recognized in any jurisdiction worldwide, including all applications and registrations.

6.2 The Materials provided by SPL (DEET) are protected by copyright, including without limitation by Copyright Law and other applicable laws in India.





6.3 CCETS & SPL (DEET) will not reveal, make use of any of the confidential information provided by SPL (DEET)/ CCETS either during the currency or after termination of the related agreement for a period of 5 years.

6.4 SPL (DEET) will retain the right of ownership to all the Intellectual Property Rights. CCETS shall not use intellectual property that is in any way based on the systems, processes, protocols, propositions and models of SPL (DEET), even though CCETS may have amended and added to the foundation of Intellectual Property.

6.5 The data of the students should not be shared to anyone without the permission of CCETS other than for the project for which the students have registered.

### **Article 7 General Provisions**

Both parties agree to maintain at all times, a one-point contact for undertaking and overseeing the initiatives listed out in this MoU, any change in the contacts will be promptly notified to the other party.

This MoU references good faith efforts by both CCETS and SPL (DEET) and is an expression of the Parties' current intent and recognizes the fact that the execution of some of the terms of the MoU could require the parties to enter into definitive agreements. It is understood that without such definitive agreements, the terms of the MoU are not legally binding and will not be relied upon by any party for any purpose and no party is or will be bound by the terms of this MoU, unless and until definitive agreements are signed.

**Terms and Termination:** The terms and conditions agreed under this MoU shall commence on the date of signing and shall remain in effect until terminated. This MoU may be terminated by either of the Parties by giving not less than 3 months' notice in writing to the other Party.

**Amendments:** Either party may request changes to this MoU. Any changes, modifications, revisions or amendments to this MoU which are mutually agreed upon by and between the parties to this MoU shall be incorporated by written instrument, and effective when executed and signed by all parties to this MoU.

**Applicable Law:** The construction, interpretation and enforcement of this MoU shall be governed by the laws of India. The Courts of Hyderabad, Telangana, India shall have jurisdiction over any action arising out of this MoU and over the parties, and the venue shall be in Hyderabad, Telangana, India.

This MoU supersedes all prior verbal or written communications, discussions and representations communicated between the parties hereto in respect of the subject matter of this MoU.

Any notice under this MoU will be in writing and delivered by hand or by registered post acknowledgement due, to the other party at the registered office or as may be substituted by the notice. Any notice sent by e-mail/post will be effective on the date of receipt.

**Severability:** Should any portion of this MoU be judicially determined to be illegal or unenforceable, the remainder of the MoU shall continue in full force and effect, and either party may renegotiate the terms affected by the severance.

**Third Party Beneficiary Rights:** The parties do not intend to create in any other individual or entity the status of a third-party beneficiary, and this MoU shall not be construed so as to create such status. The rights, duties and





obligations contained in this MoU shall operate only between the parties to this MoU and shall inure solely to the benefit of the parties to this MoU. The provisions of this MoU are intended only to assist the parties in determining and performing their obligations under this MoU. The parties to this MoU intent and expressly agree that only parties' signatory to this MoU shall have any legal or equitable right to seek to enforce this MoU to seek any remedy arising out of a party's performance or failure to performance any term or condition of this MoU, or to bring an action for the break of this MoU.

## **Memorandum of Agreement**

This Memorandum of Agreement is made between

**Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana (CCETS)**

and

**Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay (ST- IIT Bombay)**

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education is created to promote quality education, giving special attention to the areas located in backward and rural areas. It also strengthens the women education at undergraduate level and works towards educational opportunities for weaker sections of the society.

The Spoken Tutorial project developed by IIT Bombay for MHRD, Government of India is the initiative of the National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (ICT), launched by the Ministry of Human Resources and Development, Government of India. The uses of spoken tutorial is to advocate and popularize numerous Open Source software and their utilization.

Spoken tutorial project intends to provide opportunity to conduct software training from ST-IIT Bombay to all the Government Degree Colleges (GDCs) in Telangana state. As the programme is funded by the National Mission on Education through ICT, MHRD, Government of India it charges a nominal annual User Fee of Rs.25000/year/college. The program will provide the following benefits to the students of GDCs under purview of CCETS-

1. Students and Teachers receive hands on training through a particular FOSS (Free and Open Source Software) like Linux, Scilab, LaTeX, PHP & MySQL, Java, C/C++, Libre Office etc. The students who complete the required training hours will be awarded Certificates by Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay.
2. The training enhances IT, Software skills and employability for the students and any number of students and faculty can take any number of courses and Certificates in a year with User Fee of Rs. 25000/year/college.



**The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education (CCE), Telangana State and Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay** does hereby agree to the following broad terms of cooperation as under:

**Commissionerate of Collegiate Education shall-**

- Identify a Chief Central Co-ordinator from the department who will actively work and co-ordinate with Spoken Tutorial team, IIT Bombay to roll-out and introduce the project into all degree colleges in the state.
- Put up the signed agreement note on the CCE website along with Spoken Tutorial site link and Telangana training manager Ms. Swati Dongardive's contact details and issue notifications to all the Principals of Government Degree Colleges to make the Payment through NEFT, introduce and roll-out the Spoken Tutorial based software training in colleges.
- Conduct a Master training program for a faculty member in each GDC through Faculty Development Training Program for running Software training SELF learning way in their respective Colleges as one of the initiatives under capacity building.
- Offer General IT Skills package in Telugu also.
- Issue circular to all the GDCs to introduce and roll-out the Spoken Tutorial based software training in the GDCs.
- Have a monitoring system on department's website [ccets.cgg.gov.in](http://ccets.cgg.gov.in) to track the progress made by the different colleges, suggest bi-monthly reports from colleges to CCE and ST, IIT Bombay.

**The Spoken Tutorial Project, IIT Bombay shall-**

- Work as a mentor for the GDCs in the Telangana State.
- Support the training and execution by CCE by providing manuals and continuous guidance at the unit level that is the Government Degree College.
- Nominate a Representative who will work with the Faculty Development Training Program in CCE.



- Provide guidance and learning path for progressively higher levels of learning through advanced courses.
- Provide the knowhow and course content material that includes CDs/DVDs, online material, instruction sheets and any other training material related to the GDCs.
- Issues Completion Certificates, who undergo training and qualifies the Online assessment test
- Participation Certificates shall be issued to the students who undergo the training and do not take the online test.
- Provide the promotional materials like posters, brochures, leaflets, banners etc. to the CCETS and the GDCs in TS.


### **General**

- This agreement is for a duration of one year from the date of signing and can be renewed and modified from time to time if necessary, based on mutual consent.
- IIT Bombay-ST permits the colleges with less than 100 number of students to learn along with nearby college students and will not expect the User Fee of Rs.25000/college/year.
- The interpretation of any clause will rest with CCE TS.

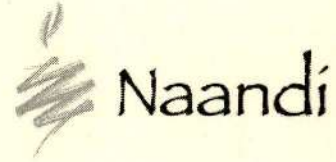

## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is entered into this on 16<sup>th</sup> November 2018 by and between

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana State, Vidya Bhavan, Nampally, (hereinafter referred to as "CCETS" which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executors, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) as FIRST PARTY.

AND

Naandi Foundation, a Public Charitable Trust incorporated under the Indian Trusts Act, having its registered office at 502, Trendset Towers, Road No 2, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad - 500 034, Telangana, India represented by Shri. Raj Iyer, Chief Youth Employment Officer, through its authorized signatory (hereinafter referred to as "Naandi" which expression shall mean and include its heirs, successors, executors, administrators, authorized representatives and permitted assigns) as SECOND PARTY.

(Both Parties are hereinafter jointly referred to as "Parties" and individually as a "Party")

### **Introduction**

**WHEREAS** CCETS is a non-profit organization created by Government of Telangana to promote education, giving special attention to the areas located in backward and rural areas. It aims to strengthen education at undergraduate and post graduate level especially for women and underprivileged sections of the society.

**WHEREAS** Naandi Foundation is an apolitical, autonomous Public Charitable Trust and a not for profit organisation having registration under section 12AA of income tax act, 1961 is tax exempt and is recognised by tax authorities as an organisation established for 'charitable purpose'

**WHEREAS** Naandi is working with an objective of people centred development through its charitable activities in whole of India, without distinction of caste, creed or religion, etc

**WHEREAS** Naandi engaged, inter alia, in improving the livelihoods of the underprivileged communities through its various social initiatives, developmental programs, in various states of India. Naandi' s activities include, education to underprivileged children with a specific focus on girl child education, improving livelihoods of small and marginal farmers through its farming practices, employable training and skill development programs to underprivileged youth, provision of safe drinking water to communities , etc

**WHEREAS** Naandi, in furtherance of its objectives and as a part of its skill development program to underprivileged youth, wish to build and enhance the employability skill set of the underprivileged youth/students in colleges under the **Commissionerate of Collegiate Education in the State of Telangana.**

**WHEREAS** the **Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, in the State of Telangana,** is desirous of engaging in employability skill building program of the underprivileged youth/students in Government Degree Colleges at undergraduate and post-graduate levels, in the State of Telangana.

**WHEREAS** both the parties having recognised each other's intention of supporting the underprivileged youth / students, studying in Government Degree colleges in the State of Telangana have decided to work together in the space of employability skill development initiative.

**WHEREAS** both the parties have decided to reduce the mutually agreed terms and conditions into writing

**NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS UNDER:**

**I: The employability skill development program (MPC)**

- 1.1 The program shall be carried out in Government Degree and PG Colleges, in the State of Telangana. A list of such colleges/institutes is given in Annexure - I enclosed herewith which is a part of this MOU.
- 1.2 The beneficiaries/students shall be the underprivileged students studying in the final semester under this program in Government Degree and PG Colleges, in the State of Telangana.
- 1.3 The skilling program shall be for a duration of 40 hours or as the case may be decided mutually by the parties.
- 1.4 The program shall include Soft-Skills, Communication Skills, Life Skill and Interview preparations for the beneficiaries under employability skill development program. The



beneficiaries may be trained in any other skill set, as mutually decided by both the parties, that improves their employable skill and livelihoods.

- 1.5 The first party or the respective college/institute/university shall select the beneficiaries/students for the said program.

## **II: Obligations of the First Party**

- 1.1 Ensure that the necessary infrastructure like well-equipped class rooms are made available where the program shall be implemented.
- 1.2. Ensure that each of the selected colleges/ Institutes identify one resource person from their faculty to co-ordinate between the beneficiaries/students, the Institute management and the second party. Contact details of such identified resources shall be with the rest of the team.

## **III: Activities of the Second Party (Naandi):**

- 1.1. Prepare content that will be most effective in training the beneficiaries/students.
- 1.2 Provide the first party a detailed Course Schedule containing curriculum and day wise lesson plans of courses to be conducted
- 1.3 Ensure that well-trained trainers are identified for each Institute to ensure overall success of the Project.
- 1.5 Monitor the program by conducting periodic assessments to ensure that the trainers do a quality job.
- 1.6 At periodic intervals, give a narrative report to the first party with the challenges met, opinion about the program, suggestions for improvement and feedback from the trainees. Similarly, parameter-based impact evaluation report shall be prepared by second party and submitted to first party periodically on completion of trainings for all students. A consolidated impact report shall be submitted on evaluating impact at project intervention level.

#### **IV. TERM:**

The MoU will be effective for a period of twelve months from the date of signing. The MOU may be extended on mutually agreed terms for a further period of one year or for such other period as mutually agreed by parties.

#### **V. Free of Cost:**

The Program is free of cost. Naandi shall not charge any fees on whatsoever account/name either from the students or the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education - Telangana or its affiliated institutions, for conducting the aforesaid program.

#### **VI. Certification:**

Certificates shall be awarded by Naandi to the students on successful completion of the training and clearing of the assessment held post completion of the program.

#### **VII. General Terms**

##### **Amendments to the MoU:**

No amendment or modification of this MoU shall be valid, unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this MoU. The modifications/changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made/ executed, unless otherwise agreed to.

##### **Compliance with laws, statutes, rules and regulations of Government / local authority:**

Both the parties shall comply with all laws, statutes and rules & regulations of Central and State Governments or Local authorities that may be applicable from time to time as required under this MoU.

##### **Termination:**

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana State, shall have the right to terminate the MoU, in case if the Naandi fails to fulfil their obligations as mentioned in the MoU, or violates any of the clause mentioned in the MoU.

##### **Assignment :**

Naandi shall not be entitled to assign any of its rights, benefits or obligations under this MoU without written consent of the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Telangana State.

##### **Relationship:**

Nothing contained in this MoU will be construed as creating any agency, partnership, joint enterprise or other similar relationship between the parties. Neither party will have authority to contract for or






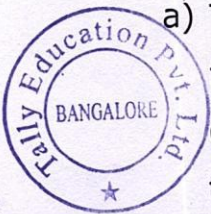

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants, terms, conditions and understandings set forth in this MoU, the Parties hereby have entered into this present MoU.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE MoU

Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, in the State of Telangana is desirous of engaging in career guidance and employability skill enhancement initiatives for the students pursuing undergraduation in Government Degree Colleges in the state. The recommended curriculum from Telangana State Council of Higher Education includes the subjects "Computerised Accounting" and "Theory and Practice of GST" for B.Com students. Tally Education Private Limited shall offer certification to students pursuing B.Com, in Tally ACE (for Computerised Accounting) and GST using Tally.ERP9 (Theory and Practice of GST) provided they fulfil the following conditions:

- a) The Education version of Tally.ERP software is offered free of cost to the Government Degree Colleges working under the purview of CCETS and their students. The students who wish to get certified in the specified Tally certifications, shall enrol themselves for an online examination conducted by Tally Education Pvt. Ltd. on payment of an

an examination fee as specified by Tally from time to time. (At present the examination fee is Rs.1168/- per course). 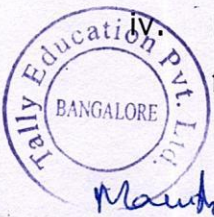
- iii) Assist CCETS/its affiliated colleges, to offer joint certification programme in Accounting and GST software in distance mode through Webinars.

v. Provide venue, logistics, infrastructural and refreshment facilities for Train the Trainer (ToT) program for faculty of Government Degree Colleges.

1. The Parties undertake to keep confidential, the contents of this MoU as well as the information disclosed to or obtained by the Parties from each other pursuant to this MoU and other information or documents that may come into the possession of the Parties in connection with performance of their obligations under this MoU. 7. Nothing contained herein shall or shall be deemed to create any partnership, agency, association, trust or joint venture between the Parties or their representatives and employees and nothing herein shall be deemed to confer on any Party, any authority to incur any obligation or liability on behalf of the other party.
8. The second party shall not be liable for any commission or omission on part of Tally Education; and the relationship between the students and the TEPL shall be governed by their mutual understanding.





Ref:- NF.No.100286/CCE-AC/TSKC/2/2019-ACADEMIC CELL/2019-2020.

The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education has established Telangana Skills and Knowledge Centers in all Government Degree Colleges with an objective to meet Human Resource requirement for state’s growth plan while fulfilling the stake holder’s aspirations. The main objective of TSKC is to enhance Life skills, Computer skills, Analytical and Aptitude skills among students pursuing graduation.

With an objective to strengthen TSKC activities, TSKCMC, O/o CCETS has collaborated with TASK to enhance employability quotient of young graduates in Government Degree Colleges and enable them to choose multiple avenues as they graduate. Hence from the academic year 2019-2020, TSKC-TASK program shall be offered to interested students pursuing graduation in all Government Degree Colleges in the state. The key aspects of this program are as follows:

- All Government Degree Colleges in Telangana shall register with payment of a nominal fee of Rs.5000/- + GST per annum, to TASK.



- The colleges shall renew the registration every year by paying the fee amount of Rs.4000/- + GST.
- Interested students shall enroll in TSKC-TASK program through an online registration process by login into TASK website, from 1st July till 31st August, 2019.
- The student registration process will be completed after the payment of a nominal one-time registration fee of Rs.500/- + GST. This registration is valid for a period of 3 years i.e., until the student completes his/her graduation.
- On successful completion of the program, students shall be evaluated and certified by TASK. TASK has partnerships with various corporates for placements like Infosys, Cognizant, Safran, Cyient etc. After the training, with their registered identification Number, students have an opportunity to directly apply for various jobs as per their choice in partnered Organizations of TASK.

In connection with this, the Principals of Government Degree Colleges are instructed to

- Register their GDC with TASK by paying the requisite fee of Rs. 5000/- +GST immediately before 15<sup>th</sup> July 2019. The expenditure towards payment of college registration fee to TASK shall be borne by the colleges from any of the available accumulated funds of the college.
- Post college registration process confirmations, TASK shall conduct an Orientation workshop for students in Government Degree Colleges. After the orientation workshop, the students can start registering themselves through an online registration process by login into TASK website, which shall be open from 1st July till 31st August, 2019.
- The program shall start in July, 2019 and based on student enrolment status the actual start date of the program shall be



finalized by the College and the same shall be communicated to TSKCMC, O/o CCE.

- The student strength per batch shall be fixed in the range 30-50. Parallel batches may be run depending on the student enrolment strength. TASK shall depute their resource persons in requisite numbers for the training. There is no upper limit on the number of students who can enroll into TSKC-TASK Program.
- The Principal shall nominate one regular faculty to coordinate the TSKC-TASK activities.
- Here-in after the services of TSKC Mentors shall be utilized in training students on technical skills through TSKC-TASK program. In colleges where TSKC Mentors are not allotted, technical skills also shall be taught by TASK resource persons at no additional charges.
- The Principals are also instructed to provide the following facilities/infrastructure in the classrooms for TSKC-TASK trainings.
  - Computer lab with internet connectivity,
  - Projector and proper sound systems
  - Class rooms with flexible seating arrangements if possible.
- Afternoon sessions on all Saturdays shall be designated for TASK Sessions by TASK Resource persons.
- The Full Time Mentors shall take TSKC-TASK classes during week days daily.

A committee with the following composition has been constituted to shortlist different modules to be taught under TSKC-TASK program which shall best serve the needs of the students. The committee shall ensure that the selected modules shall have a minimum of 40 contact hours per semester. Modules on Basic IT Skills, Functional English, Interview Skills and Life skills & Communication skills are compulsory.

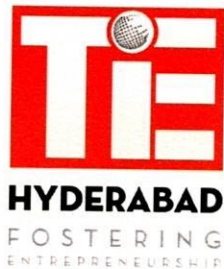

This Memorandum of understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is entered into by and between

**Commissionerate of Collegiate Education**, Hyderabad having its office at 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, Prof. Jayashankar Vidya Bhavan, Nampally, Hyderabad-500001 and herein after unless the context otherwise requires be referred to as "CCETS"

As FIRST PARTY

And

The Indus Entrepreneurs Hyderabad, founded in 1992 in Silicon Valley by a group of successful entrepreneurs, corporate executives and senior professionals with roots in the Indus region. Their office is located at #102, KADIRIS APURUPA URBAN, Laxmi Nagar, Kondapur, Hyderabad, Telangana-500084 and herein after unless the context otherwise requires be referred to as "TiE Hyderabad"

As SECOND PARTY

(Both Parties are hereinafter jointly referred to as "Parties" and individually as a "Party")

### **Introduction**

A. Whereas CCETS is a non-profit department created by the Government of Telangana to promote education, giving special attention to backward and rural areas. It aims to strengthen education at undergraduate level especially for underprivileged sections of the society.





- B. TiE Hyderabad is one of the happening chapters within TiE Global, working with a mission to foster entrepreneurship through mentoring, networking, education, funding and incubation with a focus on generating and nurturing the next generation of entrepreneurs.
- C. Whereas TiE Hyderabad, in furtherance of its mission, engages in establishing "TiE Grad", an initiative run by entrepreneurs, for students aspiring to be entrepreneurs. It is a top-class global entrepreneurship program which enables young students pursuing graduation to develop entrepreneurial mindset and encourages them to build their own business ideas.
- D. Whereas Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, in the State of Telangana is desirous of engaging in career guidance, employability and entrepreneurial skill development initiatives for the students pursuing graduation in Government Degree Colleges in the state.
- E. The parties share the common interest of engaging in entrepreneurial skill-building programs for students pursuing under graduation in Government Degree Colleges in Telangana.

TiE Hyderabad and CCETS desire to enter into this Memorandum setting out the terms and conditions under which the purpose and scope of this MoU will be achieved.

**Article 1**  
**Effective Date**

The parties hereby agree that the effective date of this MoU shall be the date on which it is signed. The Preamble to this agreement constitutes an integral part thereof.





## **Article 2**


### **Purpose and Scope**

**Purpose:** This MoU outlines mutual cooperation between the two parties in the space of entrepreneurial skill enhancement initiatives and creation of a platform for students to interact with global forums to showcase their skills and knowledge.

**Roles and Scope of cooperation:** The parties agree to, in the spirit of mutual cooperation, use the best efforts towards fulfilment of their respective obligations in achieving the purpose of this MoU.

#### **2.1 Responsibilities of CCETS**

- Will recommend and encourage all Government Degree Colleges working under its ambit to motivate their students to participate and make use of the TiE Grad entrepreneurship program.
- Ensure payment of requisite One-time initiation fee (Rs. 1 Lakh + GST) and Annual membership fee (Rs. 1 Lakh +GST, to be paid every year towards the renewal on 1st of April) to TiE Hyderabad chapter.
- Identify 50-100 students (I, II & III yr) from Government Degree Colleges and register them for the program.
- Identify and nominate one student champion and one faculty champion to coordinate the program.
- Provide a common venue (with flexible seating arrangement) at Hyderabad for conduct of orientation-kick-off session and monthly meetings.
- Provide the following for the meetings:
  - 3 Banners, 2 Standees, 1 Hoarding and 1 backdrop.
  - A lean canvas (equal in number to the number of students registered) printed on A2 Sheets.
  - A/V facilities, projector and computers.





- Confirm calendar for TiE Grad team to conduct workshop/seminar on the college campus.

## 2.2 Responsibilities of TiE Hyderabad

TiE Hyderabad will:

- Share all relevant details of their programs & competitions with O/o CCE.
- Provide know how to permit smooth and effective technology and knowledge transfer.
- Assist registered student entrepreneurs and startups from Government Degree Colleges, Telangana state to solve their business or technical challenges and building mentor connections.
- Nominate 5 student members for BizHack Bootcamps.
- Extend speaker/resource person support for workshops/seminars organised by Commissionerate of Collegiate Education (prior intimation of 15 days is required).
- Assist student entrepreneurs in networking with top entrepreneurs.
- Assign business coach and idea coach to train the registered students on the program for the entire year.
- Conduct competitions to select at least 2 teams and nominate the same for semi-finals - Inter collegiate competitions, the winners of semi-finals (if any) to TiE Grad Business Idea Tournament (Inter-college) and the winners at finals (if any) to global competitions.
- Explain the current needs of the market every year to CCETS and make them understand the changes that may incur in the course of the program.
- Submit a monthly report on the status of the program to CCETS and also a final consolidated report on the program towards the end of the academic year.





### **ARTICLE 3**

#### **Term**

- 3.1 The MoU will be effective from the date of signing and applicable upto the end of the academic year 2019-2020.
- 3.2 The MoU may be extended on mutually agreed terms for a further period of one year or for such other period as mutually agreed by the parties. If extended, the renewal shall be done on 1<sup>st</sup> April of every year.

### **ARTICLE 4**

#### **Financial liabilities**

- 4.1 The program is offered for a fee which involves
- One-Time setup fee = Rs. 1, 00,000/- + GST@18%
- Annual membership fee = Rs. 1, 00,000/- + GST@18% (to be renewed every year in April).
- Total payable fee for first year = Rs. 2, 36,000/- (inclusive of GST@18%).
- Renewal fee from 2nd year (April-March) = Rs. 1, 00,000/- + GST (18%)
- 4.2 The expenses incurred towards provision of venue, food and accommodation for the meetings held at colleges shall be the liability of CCETS (except for finals, hosted by TiE Grad).
- 4.3 The registration fee towards student nominations for global competitions only (if any) shall be borne by TiE Hyderabad. However the expenses incurred towards travel and logistics shall be the responsibility of nominees/team members.



**Article 5**  
**Confidentiality**

- 5.1 This document is confidential. Both the parties agree to maintain in confidence, and not reveal to any person or body, rights and obligations of the parties or any information or data which it receives through the other pursuant to this Agreement. The provision of Confidentiality shall survive the termination of this MoU and continue to bind the parties.
- 5.2 Both parties hereby declare that they know that this undertaking will be in force during the validity of this MoU, as well as at any time after this MoU is terminated.
- 5.3 Both parties declare that they know that the undertaking pursuant to this agreement is a pre- requisite for each party to enter into this MoU with the other, and that without this declaration each would not be willing to enter into an agreement with the other.

**Article 6**  
**Intellectual Property**

- 6.1 Intellectual property means all systems, processes, procedures, propositions, descriptions, models, copyrights, trademarks, trade secrets, and patents, utility models, methods and other intellectual property rights recognized in any jurisdiction worldwide, including all applications and registrations.
- 6.2 The materials provided by TiE Hyderabad are protected by copyright, including without limitation by copyright Law and other applicable laws in India





6.3 CCETS & TiE Hyderabad will not reveal, make use of or commercialize any of the confidential information provided by TiE Hyderabad/CCETS either during the currency or after termination of the related Agreement for a period of five years.

6.4 TiE Hyderabad will retain the right of ownership to all the Intellectual Property Rights. CCETS shall not use intellectual property that is in any way based on the systems, processes, protocols, propositions and models of TiE Hyderabad, even though CCETS may have amended and added to the foundation Intellectual Property.

6.5 The data of the students shall not be shared with anyone without the permission of CCETS other than for the project for which the students have registered.

- 7.6 This MoU supersedes all prior oral or written communications, discussions and representations communicated between the parties hereto in respect of the subject matter of this MoU.
- 7.7 Any notice under this MoU will be in writing and delivered by hand or by registered post acknowledgement due to the other party at the registered office or as may be substituted by the notice. Any notice sent by e-mail/ post will be effective on the date of receipt.
- 7.8 Severability: Should any portion of this MoU be judicially determined to be illegal or unenforceable, the remainder of the MoU shall continue in full force and effect, and either party may renegotiate the terms affected by the Severance.
- 7.9 Third Party Beneficiary Rights: The parties do not intend to create in any other individual or entity the status of a third party beneficiary, and this MoU shall not be construed so as to create such status. The rights, duties and obligations contained in this MoU shall operate only between the parties to this MoU, and shall inure solely to the benefit of the parties to this MoU. The provisions of this MoU are intended only to assist the parties in determining and performing their obligations under this MoU. The parties to this MoU intend and expressly agree that only parties signatory to this MoU shall have any legal or equitable right to seek to enforce this MoU to seek any








The Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Government of Telangana's mandate is to promote Collegiate Education, giving special attention to the areas located in Backward and Rural areas, to strengthen Women education at undergraduate and post-graduate levels to create educational opportunities for weaker sections of the society and to introduce need-based vocational courses replacing the conventional courses in a phased manner. The Government's initiative of Telangana Skills & Knowledge Centre (TSKC) addresses help students learn and practice employability skills as a dependable solution to the problem of unemployment faced by students studying non- professional courses in Government Degree Colleges.

Through this Letter of Understanding (LOU), UNDP and the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Government of Telangana wish to explore areas of collaboration in the framework of the UNDP implemented Project, 'Creating Opportunities for Employment and Entrepreneurship for Women in India'. This initiative seeks to leverage the needs for skilled personnel and other inputs in the business sector (as well as their financial and institutional capacity) and to create opportunities for skill development, employment and entrepreneurship for women. This multi-state initiative is funded by the IKEA Foundation and is supported by Xynteo, an international advisory firm which will help build partnerships with the business sector as well as the India Development Foundation (iDF) which is responsible for concurrent monitoring and research. The project has been duly endorsed by the Department of Economic Affairs, Union Ministry of Finance.

**This LOU is aimed at harnessing the initiatives of the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, government of Telangana to make the students of non- professional courses in Government Degree Colleges employable. The core of this partnership will be to bridge the information gap that college students particularly the women confront with regard to information on opportunities for skill development and employment as well as public programmes created to serve these needs.**



**This LoU will facilitate collaboration in the following areas:**

Strengthen the Government Degree Colleges in their efforts as career guidance, counselling & skills centres in the form of Telangana Skills & Knowledge Centres (TSKC) to :

- » Provide information, Psychometric profiling & career guidance to girl students.
- Facilitate establishment of close linkages with the businesses / private sector to open up a range of internship and job opportunities for girls.
- « Facilitate linkages with the government & private training providers to promote employability and entrepreneurship among students.
- Train & build capacity of select college teachers as trainers & counsellor for Career guidance & counselling so as to sustain the initiative.

The joint programme will be piloted initially in 40 government degree colleges across Hyderabad, Ranga Reddy, Medak, Mahbubnagar, Warangal, Adilabad and Khammam districts.

The LoU will be operational from the date of signing till 31 October, 2018.

A brief project outline is attached for reference (Annex-1). To ensure smooth implementation of the project, a detailed action plan with specific deliverables, timelines and responsibilities will be mutually worked out within a month of signing of the partnership LOU.

### AGREEMENT FOR V-FEEHIVE FACILITY

This agreement is made at Hyderabad on this 27<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2019.

Vijaya Bank, a Body Corporate under the Banking Companies (Acquisition and Transfer of Undertaking Act, 1980 having its Head Office at 41/2, M.G.Road, Bangalore and having its Regional office at Hyderabad hereinafter referred to as the "**Bank**" which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context be deemed to include its successors and assigns.

#### AND

The Government of Telangana represented by its Commissioner, Department of College Education, Telangana State having its Office at Commissioner, Collegiate Education, Vidya Bhavan, Nampally, Hyderabad, Telangana, herein after referred as "**Department**" which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context be deemed to include its successors and assigns.

The Bank and Department are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually as the "Party".

1. Whereas Department is a State Government entity and headed by commissioner of College Education, Telangana state which provides licensing and other requisite permissions to Institutions to start educational services to students/apprentice/learner in the State of Telangana. The List of the institutions coming under the purview of the Department is given in "**Annexure A**".
2. Whereas Bank is in the business of providing Banking services to its customers, which inter alia include opening and operating Current Accounts by its customers. Further, Bank is also providing Electronic Payment Services to its Customers such as Educational Institution through itself or by engaging the services of the third party and also developed product Electronic Payment Fees Collection software application which is called and named as "V-FeeHive".

Whereas complete details and process flow of "V-FeeHive" software application product are given herein in "**Annexure B**"

3. Whereas Institutions under the Department has desired for calling application online from its students/apprentice/learner for various admission & related ancillary activities and for collection of online fee from students/apprentice/learner, who are situated all over India and also abroad and already banking with other Banks, requested the Vijaya Bank to provide Electronic Payment collection service by "V-FeeHive" product/application facility.
4. Whereas Institutions under the Department and Bank agreed to work together for linking Electronic Payment collection "V-FeeHive" software application facility.
5. Whereas Department agreed to open Savings Bank Account pertaining to each Institution in Bank for collection of deposit of funds remitted by students/apprentice/learner through Electronic Payment Services. Accordingly the Department authorizes the Bank to provide the Electronic Payment Gateway services by itself or engage the third party for providing Electronic Payment Services by providing "V-FeeHive" facility to Institution for collection of online fees and accordingly remit the same to the Collection Account of Institution maintained with branches of Vijaya Bank (Please refer Annexure-C).

Accordingly the Department vide its letter \_\_\_\_\_, dated \_\_\_\_\_ has instructed the institutions list in Annexure A authorizing them to open the account at Branches of Vijaya Bank for the services of providing "V-FeeHive" facility for collection of online fees and remitting the same to Collection Account of Institution.

**NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:**

7. Definitions :-

- i. Acquiring Bank, means Bank who offer various facilities through the internet, including net banking facilities and providing authorization (from third party clearing house networks) and settlement facilities in respect of payment instructions initiated by the Customers on certain websites of different client using valid credit card /debit card /online banking account. These facilities will be hereinafter be referred to as the "Net Banking Facilities" and/or "Acquiring Bank's Services".
  - ii. "Charge back" means approved and settled credit/debit card or net banking transactions which are at any time refused, debited or charged back to Institution account (shall also include similar debits to pay accounts, if any) by the Acquiring Bank or credit card Company for any.
  - iii. Student - means any person who desires to avail educational Services from the Institution and provided with Student Identification Number and makes or intends to make a payment by using Electronic Payment collection "V-FeeHive" software.
  - iv. "Student Account" shall mean a bank account of the Student with the Acquiring Bank.
  - v. "Facility Providers" means various banks, financial institutions and various software providers who are in the business of providing information technology services, including but not limited to, internet based electronic commerce, internet payment gateway and electronic software distribution services and who have an arrangement with Bank Pay to enable use of internet payment gateways developed by them to route internet based credit/charge/ debit card transactions.
  - vi. "Services" means any service that the Institution offers to the Students, the payment for which is to be made on through a Students Bank Account.
  - vii. "SID" means the Student Identification Number provided by the Bank.
8. Institutions (mentioned in Annexure -A) have opened Savings Bank account with the branches of Vijaya Bank, (details of Branch and Account Numbers are mentioned in Annexure -C) for the purpose of crediting the entire online fee collected through Electronic payment services by "V-FeeHive" software application. The said account is called as Institution's Collection account.
9. Institutions under the Department authorizes the Bank to collect the amount from the Institution's students/apprentice/learner and the Institutions undertakes to intimate to its students/apprentice/learner to make payment by Electronic Payment fees collection service through "V-FeeHive" application facility of Vijaya Bank.
10. The Bank shall process and accept the payment made by the students /apprentice /learner on the Website in respect of the transactions and accordingly transfer funds received from the students/apprentice/learner account through Payment gateway and shall further transfer this amount to the Institution.

Institutions under the Department agrees that online fee remitted through Electronic Payment of "V-FeeHive" software application through the third party service provider will be credited to the Institution's Collection account maintained by Institution with respective Branch of Vijaya Bank, after two business days from the date of Transaction date (T + 2) .
12. Institutions under the Department agrees that online fee remitted through Electronic Payment of "V-FeeHive" software application through Vijaya Bank's Net banking facility will be credited on the same day, to the Institution's Collection account maintained by Institution with respective Branch of Vijaya Bank.
13. Institutions under the Department agrees that fee payments made through NEFT or RTGS from other Banks branches will be credited to the Institution's Collection account maintained by Institution with respective Branch of Vijaya Bank, as per RBI's NEFT/RTGS schedules.
14. Transaction Charge(s)/commission:-Bank & Institution agrees that, Institution shall not be required to pay any Transaction Charges for Electronic Payment fees collection service for use of "V-FeeHive" facility provided by the Bank. However Institution agrees that, for online payment of fees through Payment Gateway for Net banking/Debit card/Credit Card/UPI etc., there are additional charges over and above the fees which shall be borne by the students. Institution shall inform accordingly to students about the levy of charges for online payment of fees through Payment Gateway for Net banking/Debit Card/Credit Card/UPI. In case of any surge of payment gateway charges, revised rates will be intimated to the institution.
15. Institution agrees that the Bank will deduct the agreed online payment gateway transaction charges with applicable taxes in respect of providing Electronic Payment fees collection service by offering "V-FeeHive" facility out of total amount (i.e. Fee + Transaction charges) paid by the students/apprentice/learner and Fee amount will be credited to the Collection account maintained by Institution with respective Branch of Vijaya Bank as mentioned in above para. Institution also agrees to provide the necessary proof to defend any chargeback raised.

**16. Roles and obligations of the Institution :**

**Institution has explicitly agreed to comply with Roles and obligations and the terms and conditions stated herein below:-**

- a. Institution Agrees that, it is the responsibility of the Institution to fed / provide correct and complete details in "Admin Module" of "V-FeeHive" software application which are mandatory such as

- Name of Student
- Registration No.
- Fees amount to be collected
- Course Name
- Batch
- Instalment Structure
- Fine structure

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So as to populate the correct details in "Student Module" of "V-FeeHive" application to make online fees by Students/apprentice/learner. Institution agrees that, institution will inform Correct Student Identification Number [SID No.] generated in V-FeeHive application to students/apprentice/learner. Institution agrees that, due to wrong SID No written by any student while making payment in offline mode of payment and amount has been paid to any other institution bank will not be liable for the same. However, on providing the requisite documents, bank will take up the matter on good faith basis with the concerned bank for refund /re-credit. Further Institution agrees that, in case of incorrect data fed/provided by the Institution in "Admin Module" and due to the same, wrong amount of fee remitted by the Students/apprentice/learner, Bank is not responsible for the same once the said amount credited to collection account. Institution agrees that, dispute about incorrect amount of fee paid by the student to Institution , refund of excess fee, will be resolved by Institution and Student and bank will not liable for the same.

- b. Institution shall duly fulfill all transactions in accordance with the instructions of the Students/apprentice/learner and as mutually decided between the Institution and its Students/apprentice/learner.
- c. Institution shall prior to accepting any instructions from the Students/apprentice/learner ensure that appropriate instructions have been provided to the Students/apprentice/learner in accordance with the requirements of applicable law and regulations, and appropriate disclosures/disclaimers are displayed conspicuously on the website of the Institution / Institution notice board in relation to the same.
- d. Institution shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations while offering the educational service or any ancillary services to the Students/apprentice/learner. The Institution shall not offer any educational service or any ancillary services or anything to the Students/apprentice/learner, which is illegal or offensive and is not in compliance with applicable laws, and regulations whether Central, State, local or international of all jurisdiction from where the Students/apprentice/learner avails the services.
- e. Institution agrees to put up such notices, disclaimers or warranties as may be requested by the Bank, the Facility Providers or the Acquiring Banks and the Students/apprentice/learner shall comply with the aforesaid requests forthwith.
- f. Institution shall be solely responsible for the accuracy of all information and fees and any other charges fed/provided in "Admin Module" of V-FeeHive facility provided by Bank.
- g. Institution shall take all precautions as may be feasible or as may be directed by the Bank, facility providers and acquiring Banks to ensure that there is no breach of security and that the integrity of the link between the website of the Institution and Bank.
- h. Institution agrees that the Bank reserves a right to suspend the Electronic Payment fees collection service by providing "V-FeeHive" herein in event the Institution fails to observe the covenants specified in this agreement.
- i. Institution shall provide are as on able level of service support to the Students/apprentice/learner. Such support shall include appropriate notice to Students/apprentice/learner of means of contacting the Institution in the event the Students/apprentice/learner has questions regarding the nature of educational services and the procedures for resolving disputes.

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- j. Institution agrees that all risks associated with educational Services provided by Institution are solely of the Institution. Any and all disputes regarding quality of educational services, facility otherwise will be resolved directly between the Institution and the Students/apprentice/learner without making the Bank or the facility Providers and the Acquiring Banks a party to such disputes. Institution is aware that, in "Admin Module" of "V-FeeHive" facility is provided with details of account statement and amount credited by Students/apprentice/learner and thus Institution agrees that, it is duty of the Institution to verify in Admin Module on day to day basis for verification of amount Credited by Students/apprentice/learner by using Electronic Payment fees collection service". Institution agrees that, it is duty of Institution to inform if any difference with regard amount remitted by Students/apprentice/learner to amount credited in Collection account of Institution within Seven (7) days of transaction and on failure to inform the same, Bank is discharged from its liability.
- l. Institution agrees that Bank will maintain data/details of transaction for the academic year 2018-19 subsequent to the end of the academic year in which the relevant transaction of payment of fee is generated, hence institution should reconcile difference in amount remitted by Students/apprentice/learner to amount credited in Collection account and inform any difference to the Bank within next academic year after the completion of academic year in which relevant transaction of payment of fee is generated, failing which bank will be discharged from its liability.
- m. Institution hereby grants to Bank or the third party authorized by the Bank for collection and the Acquiring Banks an on-exclusive, royalty-free, limited license to use, display and reproduce the trademarks, service marks and logos of the Institution solely in connection to publicity of above services to the public. Institution hereby confirms for having requisite right to use the said marks and logos and to grant permission to use the same by Bank or the third party authorized by the Bank for collection and Acquiring Bank as stated above. The Institution shall retain all intellectual property rights in such marks.
- n. Institution agrees that nothing contained herein shall authorize the Institution to use or in any manner exploit the intellectual property rights of Bank or the third party authorized by the Bank for collection/Facility Providers or the Acquiring Bank without prior written consent of respective entities.
- o. Institution shall use "V-FeeHive" application only for the purposes of availing the Electronic Payment Services. The Institution, its employees or its agents shall not use the "V-FeeHive" Software Application, in any form whatsoever, so as to design, realize, distribute or market a similar or equivalent software program/application. The Institution, its employees or its agents shall not adapt, modify, transform or rearrange the "V-FeeHive" Software Application for any reason whatsoever, including for the purpose, among other things, of creating a new software program or a derivative software program. In particular, but without limitation, the Institution undertakes, not to allow unauthorized use of or access to the "V-FeeHive" Software Application and not to disassemble, reverse engineer, decompile, decode or attempt to decode the "V-FeeHive" Software Application, or allow the "V-FeeHive" Software Application to be disassembled, reverse engineered, decompiled or decoded, or to in anyway override or break down any protection system integrated into the "V-FeeHive" Software Application.

Institution fully understands that due to access of the students/apprentice/learner to the Website, the Bank or the third party authorized by the Bank for collection may create or generate database in respect of such students/apprentice/learner.
- q. Notwithstanding anything contained in the agreement the Bank shall not be liable to the Institution for any loss or damage whatsoever or howsoever caused or arising, directly or indirectly, including without limitation, as a result interruption or stoppage, loss of data access or interruption or stoppage Electronic Payment Services-V-FeeHive interruption or stoppage of the Bank's website; non-availability of connectivity between the Institution's website and Electronic Payment Services-V-FeeHive website etc.
- r. Institution acknowledges that the Bank's and Institution's sole and exclusive remedy in the event of interruption in the Payment Gateway Services shall be to use all reasonable endeavor to restore the said services as soon as reasonably possible.

**17. Roles and obligations of Bank:**

- a. Bank agrees that, bank will provide the Electronic Payment fees collection service by providing "V-FeeHive" Software application.
- b. Bank reserves the right to set-off any amounts by way of: (a) debit to Institution Collection Account and/or (b) deduct and set off from Collection funds due to Institution; and/or (c) invoice/raise a debit note to recover from Institution separately, for any of the following amounts:
- funds credited to Institutions account in error, mistake;
  - the amount of any refunds issued (if not already deducted from sums paid by Bank to Institution);
  - invalid transactions (including Charge backs and our related losses);
  - fees or penalties or fines imposed by the regulatory / competent authority resulting from card associations and/or banks or Institution Charge backs or from required compliances and / or violation of applicable Rules and Regulations or Institution acts or omissions;
  - government charges; and
  - any other amounts then due from Institution to Bank, arising out of or in relation to the terms of the Transaction Documents; deducted by the Acquiring Banks or Facility Providers due to a valid Charge Back request raised by the Customer, before making payment of the Customer Charge, provided that, the Charge Back request is not resolved within 7 days.
  - In case of Refund or Chargeback event.
  - The transaction is doubtful or erroneously paid to the Institution.
  - Transaction is posted more than once to Institution's account.
- c. Bank agrees that any other software, upgrades or new versions for facilitating fee collection developed or acquired by the bank which is compatible with Institution's fee collection system, will be made available to Institution from time to time after having obtained the written concurrence from the institute
- d. **Confidentiality:** -The Bank agree to keep in confidence and not to disclose to others all knowledge, information and data furnished, acquired knowledge from the transaction and claimed by either party to be proprietary. 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Bank shall ensure to keep confidential all information submitted by the Students/apprentice/learner on the "V-FeeHive" Software application. The Institution and Bank shall ensure that there are proper encryption and robust security measures to prevent any hacking of the information of the students/apprentice/learner. The Institution and Bank shall not be required or asked to disclose any confidential or personal data, which may be prejudicial to interests of the Student/Customer. The Institution and Bank shall use the Students/apprentice/learner data only for the purpose of completing the Transaction for which it was furnished, and shall not sell or otherwise furnish such information to any third party.

18. **Indemnification clause:** Both the parties agree to indemnify and hereby keeps the other party indemnified against all actions, claims, loss, damages, Costs, Charges, expenses (including Attorney / Advocate fees and legal expenses) which either party may suffer or incur on account of breach of any of the provisions of this agreement. In the event of a breach or threatened breach by the either party, monetary damages may not be an adequate remedy; therefore, the either party shall be entitled to injunctive relief to restrain the other party from any such breach, threatened or actual.

Further, the above said indemnity clause be extended in the event of excess credit made to the collection account and the Institution authorizes the Bank to reverse the said excess amount credited to the said account out of future collection. Further, after the said reversal of the excess credit, the same shall be intimated by the Bank to the Institution for their records. Further, in case the funds are not sufficient in the collection account of the Institution, the Institution undertakes to indemnify the Bank. However, in the event of any issue to be resolved between either of the parties pertaining to the said reversal of credit or insufficiency of the funds in the collection account, both the parties shall make a claim on the other party and the same must be resolved out of mutual consent and agreement in writing.

19. **Force Majeure:** Bank and the Institution shall not be liable for their failure to perform their respective obligations under this agreement as a result of any Force Majeure event. For the purpose of this clause Force Majeure Event shall include acts of god, fire, wars, sabotage, civil unrest, labour unrest, action of statutory authorities or local or central governments, change in laws, rules and regulations and failure to perform duties and obligations on the part of Acquiring Banks and Facility Providers.

20. **Jurisdiction and Arbitration Clause:-**

This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India and both parties hereby agrees that in respect of dispute arising upon, over or in respect of any terms of this Agreement, only the Courts in Telangana State shall have jurisdiction to try and adjudicate such dispute to the exclusion of all other Courts.

In the event of dispute, controversy or claims arising out of or relating to this Agreement or this breach, termination or invalidity thereof, the parties shall first endeavor to settle such dispute, difference, claim or question by mutual discussion, failing which the same shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996.

The arbitral tribunal shall be composed of three arbitrators, one arbitrator to be appointed by each party and third arbitrator appointed mutually by such arbitrator.

21. **Term and Termination, Merger & Acquisition**-Both the parties can terminate this agreement by giving one month prior notice to each other.

Institution agrees that in the event of a merger, acquisition or consolidation of the Bank, the licenses/services that are currently used by the Bank will be transferred to the other entity with all rights to its usage.

Institution agrees that in the event of a merger, acquisition or consolidation with an entity that is using a solution/services which is different from the one currently deployed at the Bank and if the successor entity chooses to use a solution which is different from the one currently deployed at the Bank, Institution will have to come in for a negotiation with the Bank for a one time settlement and the same will be mutually agreed upon by the Institution and the Bank at that point of time.

22. **Severability** -If any provision of this agreement is held to be illegal, invalid, or unenforceable under any present or future law such provision will be severable and this agreement will be construed and enforced as if such illegal, invalid, or unenforceable provision had never comprised a part hereof and the remaining provisions of this agreement shall remain in full force and effect and will not be affected by the illegal, invalid, or unenforceable provision or by its severance here from.

23. On any other matters related to this agreement that are not covered explicitly or implicitly in any part of this Agreement shall mutually be settled between head of the Institution, or any person deputed on his/her behalf and General Manager, Department of Information Technology, Vijaya bank.

24. This agreement comes into effect immediately upon execution by both the parties and will be valid from 1st July, 2018 till terminated by any of the parties.

Complete details and process flow of "V-FeeHive" software application product are given herein in below:-

V-FeeHive Software is developed by the in-house Software Development team of Vijaya Bank to facilitate fee payment electronically without visiting College Premises. V-FeeHive provides completely secured payment channel. Any type of fee can be paid through this using any Bank/any card. V-FeeHive provides the feature of instant payment and acknowledgement. It comes with plenty of additional features like customized MIS reporting and export to various formats, easy reconciliation, Email and SMS alert facility etc.

The Application, for the student, will be made available at Institution's website. In addition to the Fee Payment Module published in these websites, the institution will be provided with an Admin module.

**1. APPLICATION MODULES AND PROCESS FLOW:**

**1.1. Admin Module:**

The Admin user will be the identified staff from the Institution. The admin user will have all privileges to maintain the data. Batch wise Students data is to be uploaded/ fed to the application as and when they join the Institution. The entire applicable Fee Structure (Fee amount, fine amount, fee start date, fine start date, installment details, bifurcation of fee amount, concessions etc.) should be fed in by the admin user. The admin user is also privileged to do any modification on any data at any point of time. Hence data correctness can be controlled and maintained by the admin user. Admin user privilege will be allotted depend on the staff role, on the basis of the copy of resolution passed by the board of your institution.

**1.2.1. Reports**

- i. The Admin user can generate different types of MIS reports. Reports with the status of fees paid by the student and the Account statement, whether the delivery of the fees has been made or not, would be available. Other basic report types are "Date-wise report", "Batch-wise Report", "Class-wise report", "Paid-Not Paid report", "SID-wise report" etc.
- ii. Various other MIS reports based on Institution requirement can be developed after a basic feasibility analysis.

**1.2. Online Fee Payment Module:**

Students have to login using their SID Number generated by Vijaya Bank on the basis of the registration number, provided by Institution, through a proprietary algorithm. The identity of the student is validated and applicable fee structure will be displayed. All active fees will be populated and listed down in this screen. Multiple installments can be selected in a serial order. Option is also given for Part Fee Payment for the applicable students. The student can select the appropriate payment channel and proceed to the payment for the selected fee installments.

The payment request travels through secured channel (HTTPS). Payment can be done either through Vijaya Bank Net Banking, which is **free of transaction charges**, or through other Payment Channels like Debit Card/ Credit Card / Net Banking of other Banks where applicable Transaction charges are levied. Transaction charges for various payment channels are mentioned in **Annexure - B**. Students are provided with an Acknowledgement immediately after the payment, which is sent to them as an SMS/Email alert(provided, if a valid mobile number/ email id is present in our system).

The application provides additional features like view payment history, download fee receipt, step by step instructions for various payment modes other than online etc. in this module.

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## 2. Payment Options

Following are the available payment channels as of now. New methods may be integrated with the system in future, depending on the developments in banking industry:

### 2.1. IMPS/ NEFT Payment

For those students who do not hold an account with Vijaya Bank, V-FeeHive provides an option to pay their fees using their bank account with other banks. Student has to add the SID number as the beneficiary in his/her Net banking account and transfer the appropriate fees to that beneficiary. The transfer charges of their bank would apply for this transaction. IFSC and other details for beneficiary addition will be communicated when the system is live.

### 2.2. Offline Payment

For all of those who do not want to pay their fees online, V-FeeHive comes with a feature of Offline payment as well. Student has to walk into a nearest branch of any bank and deposit/transfer the money into his/her SID number account of Vijaya Bank. IFSC and other details for fund transfer will be communicated when the system is live.

### 2.3. Payment Gateway Channel

Bank has tied up with a Payment Gateway that covers all kind of online transactions including Credit Card, Debit Card and Internet Banking. Payment gateway channel is completely secured and running with "https" protocol and digital certificate. Major card holders and Banks are already tied up with Bank's Payment Gateway provider, so that the fee payment can be done through net banking of any of the Banks or Credit/Debit Card.

### 2.4. V-Net banking

For Vijaya Bank Internet Banking customers, the payment is routed through V-Net Banking according to the request raised by the customer and no charges are levied for the same.

## 3. Training and Documentation

Vijaya Bank would provide all necessary training at initial period for using the software at the Institution. Proper documentation will also be provided.
